Intersection Safety Cameras Keep Sunrise Streets Safer

The City of Sunrise has implemented an intersection safety program to reduce the number of redlight violations and their potential for crashes and injuries. The program's objective is to change the behavior of drivers who choose to drive or accelerate through red lights.

Intersection safety cameras will be installed at the following 10 intersections:

- (NB) N. University Drive @ NW 25th Ct
- (WB) W. Oakland Park Blvd. @ N. University Drive
- (NB) N. Flamingo Road @ W. Oakland Park Blvd.
- (SB) N. Flamingo Road @ NW 136th Avenue
- (NB) N. Flamingo Road @ Blue Dolphin Blvd.
- (SB) N. Flamingo Road @ W. Sunrise Blvd.
- (NB) N. Nob Hill Rd @ Sunset Strip
- (NB) N. Nob Hill Rd @ W. Oakland Park Blvd.
- (SB) N. University Drive @ W. Oakland Park Blvd.
- (EB) W. Sunrise Blvd. @ Sunset Strip

Posted warning signs alert drivers to the cameras prior to entering the intersection. Starting after **April 10, 2011**, the City of Sunrise will start enforcing red light violations with this program. The fine for running a red light will be \$158.00.

Intersection safety cameras activate when a vehicle enters the intersection **AFTER** the traffic signal has turned red. The system captures two images of the vehicle and records a video. Sunrise Police officers review the violation evidence and determine whether to issue a citation to the vehicle's registered owner.
