To apply for a rebate at the workshop, please bring your utility account number. You'll also need to know how many gallons of water per flush the toilet(s) you are replacing uses.

To qualify for rebates on WaterSense® certified High-Efficiency Toilets that use 1.28 gallons per flush or less, you must reside in one of the following municipalities:

City of Coconut Creek City of Fort Lauderdale City of Pembroke Pines

City of Coral Springs City of Hallendale Beach City of Plantation
City of Dania Beach Town of Hillsboro Beach City of Sunrise

Town of Davie City of Lauderhill
City of Deerfield Beach City of Margate

Funding is limited, so hurry while supplies last.

To be eligible for a rebate, you **must apply and be pre-approved before** purchasing your toilets or you will not be reimbursed. You also must be replacing a toilet(s) that uses more than 1.6 gallons per flush with a WaterSense® certified High-Efficiency Toilet(s) that uses 1.28 gallons per flush or less. WaterSense® certified Dual Flush Toilets must also use under 1.28 gallons per flush for both flush options. Single-family, townhouse and condo owners who reside in the home at which they are replacing the toilet(s) may receive up to (2) two rebates of up to \$100 each, or the cost of the toilet, whichever is less. Property owners, and property managers who are authorized by property owners, of multi-family housing units, not-for-profit agencies, commercial buildings and institutional facilities may receive up to five (5) rebates of up to \$100 each, or the cost of the toilet, whichever is less. Or may submit a request to receive additional rebates.
