The Department plans to use overtime funding from this grant to create partnerships and address neighborhood problems through the use of statistical analysis and our Department's S.A.R.A (Scanning, Analysis, Response and Assessment) problem solving model. Since 1998, the Sunrise Police Department has utilized funding awarded from Block Grants to subsidize expenses related to community policing activities.
