These events, which will take place at the Sunrise Civic Center (10610 West Oakland Park Boulevard, Sunrise 33351), are made possible through funding from the Community Foundation of Broward.

### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

**Write Your Dream** is a creative and intensive poetry-writing workshop that integrates the arts and civic responsibility. This hands-on session for Broward County high school students age 13 to 19 will be facilitated by playwright and educator Darius Daughtry.

Each workshop participant will receive a copy of "A Time to Break Silence: The Essential Works of Martin Luther King, Jr., for Students." Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Prospective participants should note these key dates and times:
