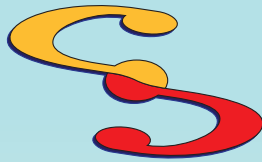

# FEATURING



## JON BAILEY

Voiceover actor and YouTube personality Jon Bailey is best known as the voice of *Honest Game Trailers* on Smosh Games and Epic Movie Trailer voice pranks. He started doing impressions when he was five years old and many years later his wife Amanda, with whom he has four wonderful children, pushed him to pursue a career in voiceover.



Jon was signed by a production studio in January of 2009 and has since expanded his resume to the web, radio and TV commercials, network promos, video game characters, trailers, and so much more. He is also well known for voicing *Captain Rex* and *Anakin Skywalker* for the *Clone Wars* toy series as well as a John Grisham-authored audiobook.

## ALLEN BELLMAN

Allen was born in Manhattan and studied at the High School of Industrial Arts, eventually becoming a staff artist at Timely during the Golden Age of comics. While still a teenager, he did the backgrounds for Syd Shores' *Captain America* in 1942, and eventually worked on titles such as: *The Patriot*, *The Destroyer*, *The Human Torch*, *Jap Buster Johnson* and *Jet Dixon of the Space Squadron*, *All Winners Comics*, *Marvel Mystery*, *Sub Mariner Comics*, *Young Allies* and so much more.



Allen also contributed to pre-Code horror, crime, war and western tales for *Atlas* and the self-created back-up crime feature *Let's Play Detective*. He is a former art department contributor of the South Florida *Sun-Sentinel* as well as a nationally recognized and published photographer.

## CAPTAIN CARTOON

Dick Kulpa is best known for his work with *Cracked* and *Weekly World News* (as the creator of *Bat Boy*) in the 1990s and early 2000s, as well as on the *Star Trek* and *Bruce Lee* newspaper strips in the 1980s.



For over 10 years, he served as Art Director for the nationally distributed supermarket tabloid, *Weekly World News*. Kulpa created the now-famous *Bat Boy* character which first appeared in *Weekly World News* on June 23, 1992. From 2000-2005, Kulpa served as publisher and editor of *Cracked*, the national humor magazine. Kulpa's anti-gang comic book classic "*Gangbuster*" is currently being circulated by police departments.

## SILVERBACK

Artist, author, and animator Glaister "Silverback" Ormsby has gone from victim to victor through his approach to life. His autobiography *Silverback: My Life & Journey in Comics*, follows the journey and evolution of an independent comic book artist as he reminisces on the trials and tribulations leading up to the debut of his first independent title. His memoirs provide advice for kids and parents through an unfiltered journey from a little boy in New York ducking bullies to learning self-confidence.



Through his art and achievements, Silverback now stands tall, barreling through roadblocks, conquering adversities, and unveiling his own *Silverback Publishing Company*.

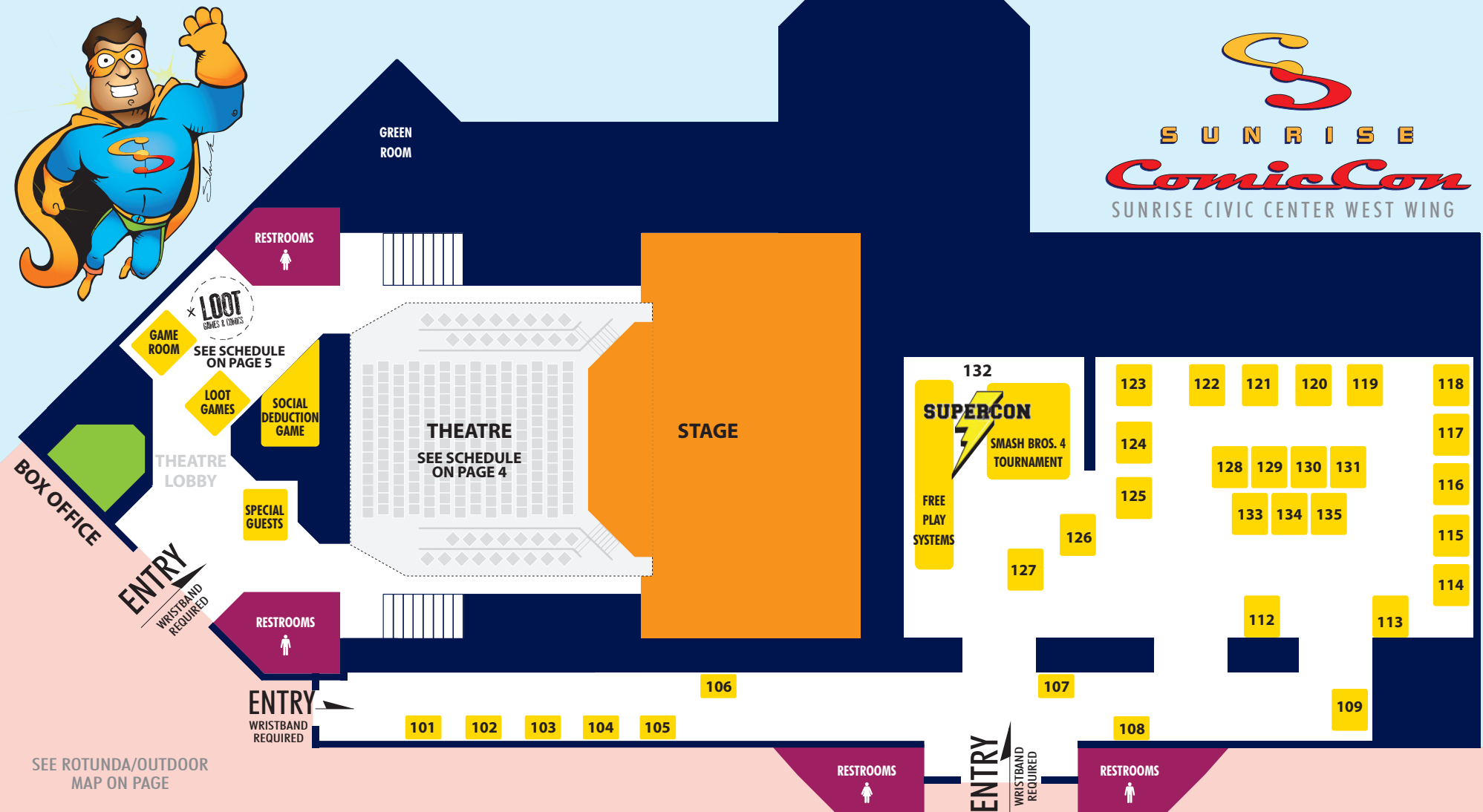

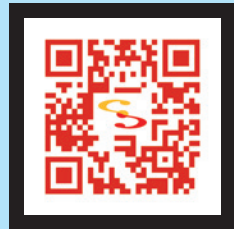

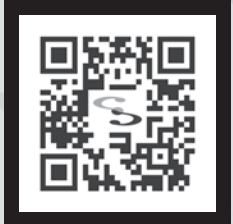
