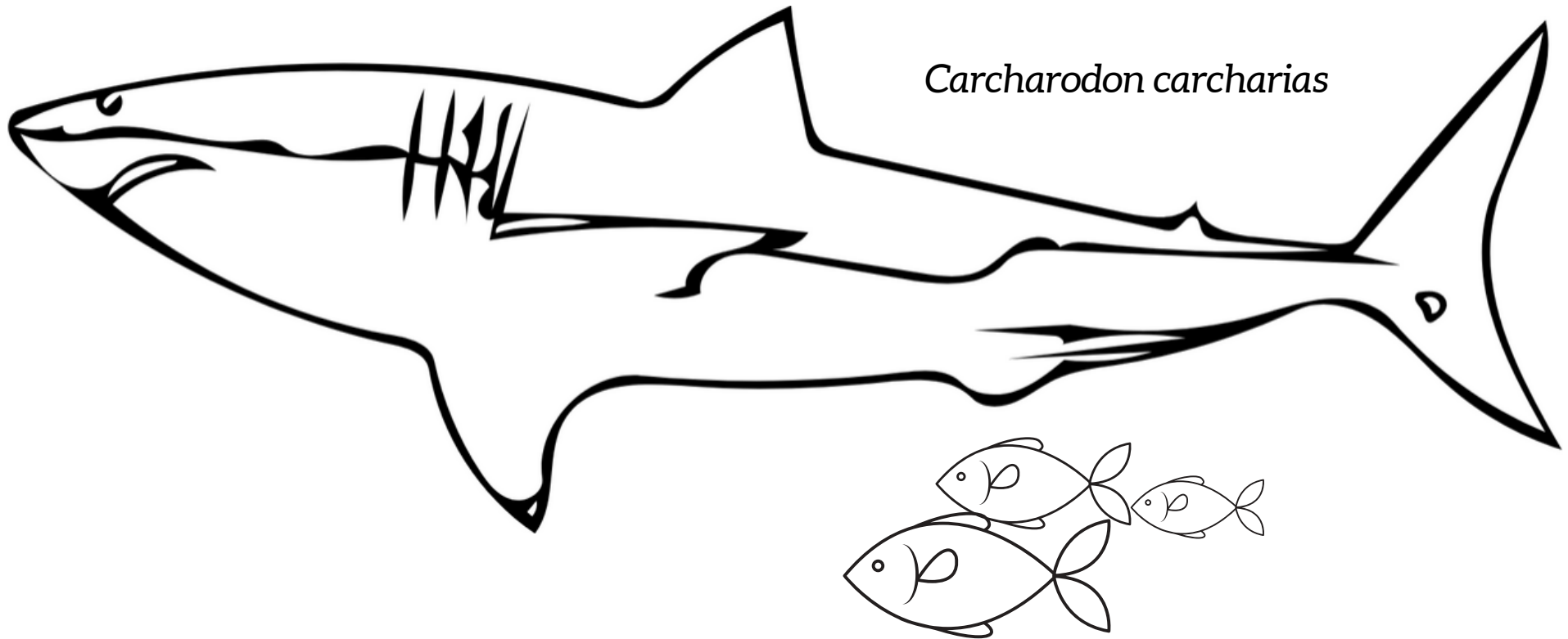


GREAT WHITE SHARK



Carcharodon carcharias

- White sharks feed on seals, fish, and even smaller sharks!
- White sharks can grow to 20 ft in length and weight about 5,000 pounds
- White sharks are counter-shaded = their topside is dark so they blend into the sea floor and their belly is white so that they blend into the sunlight from below, all making it really easy to sneak up on its prey



FUN FACT: Great White Sharks are protected throughout much of their range through different laws and protections.
