GO GREEN THIS HOLIDAY SEASON!

There are a *Ho Ho Whole* Lot of Ways to Reduce Holiday Waste

Did you know that 25% more waste is created each year between Thanksgiving and New Year's Eve across the U.S.? That's about one million tons more per week during the holiday season.

This year, make your holidays joyous in spirit and gentle on the environment. Here's how:

Green Your Gift-giving Habits

- Shop Sunrise! When you buy local, you help support our local economy. You also cut down on gas by driving shorter distances. And you can save money: See page 4 of this issue for details on our new Shop Sunrise incentive program for merchants and customers!
- Make It. Bake a cake or cookies, or jar homemade jam or pickles. You could also knit, sew, build, or create art. Use the holidays to spark your creativity – and have some fun!
- Go with Experience. Give experiences as gifts such as dinner certificates, tickets to the movies or a show, or passes to a local museum instead of things. You can also give your time and skill by volunteering, or donate to a charity or service organization in the name of a friend of relative who supports that cause.



Rethink Your Lights

LED holiday lights are 80% more energy efficient than incandescent lights, and they last longer. You can even find solar-powered holiday lights that you can use outdoors to save on your electric bill, and eliminate the need for extension cords.

Pass Up Plastics

Today, wrapping paper is often laminated, and may contain additives such as gold and silver coloring, synthetic glitter, and plastics – making it non-recyclable.

If every American family wrapped just three presents in recycled or reusable materials, it would save enough paper to cover 45,000 football fields

Want more ways to cut down on holiday waste? Visit www.sunrisefl.gov/passupplastics to take the Sunrise Pledge to **Pass Up Plastics**, and try out these plastic-free tips:

- Choose a real tree and check for local tree recycling programs that will turn used trees into chip mulch. (Markham Park is typically a Broward County Chip-a-Tree site. Visit https://www.broward.org/Parks/ThingsToDo/Pages/Chip-a-TreeProgram.aspx for details.) If you do purchase an artificial tree, be sure to use it for at least 10 years to minimize its environmental impact.
- Remember to bring **reusable bags** on shopping trips. They also make great gift bags or gifts!
- Skip the plastic straws at holiday parties.
- Invest in a **reusable advent calendar** you can refill each year, instead of a disposable version.
- Pack holiday leftovers (and food gifts) in reusable containers.

Sunrise is proud to be a partner in Broward County's Conservation Pays program, which provides rebates and other water conservation resources. To maximize your savings of water and dollars, be sure to take advantage of the following benefits:

Toilet Rebates.

While supplies last, eligible Sunrise Water Utility customers can receive rebates of up to \$100 per toilet (two per household) for replacing qualifying pre-1994 toilets with WaterSense® certified toilets. You must apply and be ap-

proved for your rebate BEFORE purchasing a new toilet: Register online at www.conservationpays.com or call (800) 270-9794.

Free Shower Heads and Faucet Aerators.
Sunrise Water Utility cus-

Sunrise Water Utility customers can receive free shower heads and kitchen and bathroom faucet aerators that help reduce water and energy costs. Pro tip: If you own a commercial kitchen, we also offer free restaurant pre-rinse spray valves that are easy to install. These items

are available at the City of Sunrise Utility Administration Building (777 Sawgrass Corporate Parkway) weekdays between 9:00 a.m. to 5:00

p.m. Please call (954) 888-6000 to schedule a pick-up time, and bring your water bill and a photo ID with your address. (If you're not direct-billed for water service, only proof of address is needed.)


SUNRISE SPORTS STARS

Patrick Doyle, Sunrise Swimming

Patrick has been a City of Sunrise lifeguard since 2019, and a member of the Sunrise Swimming team since he was eight years old. He qualified for the 2021 Speedo Summer Championships in North Carolina – a national meet for elite 18 & Under swimmers – where he competed in the 100-meter and 200-meter backstroke events against some of the fastest swimmers in the U.S. Patrick is currently attending McKendree University on academic/athletic scholarship.

CITY HALL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The new Sunrise City Hall is rising at the intersection of West Oakland Park Boulevard and Josh Lee Boulevard. This modern building is part of Sunrise's Municipal Campus Improvement Project, which also includes the demolition of the current City Hall; construction of a free-standing, 500-space parking garage; upgrades to and expansion of the existing Civic Center Amphitheater – including a Great Lawn for concerts and other events; covered walkways; and landscaping and other site enhancements.

The new City Hall will unite most Sunrise departments under one roof, and puts residents' needs at the forefront. The main floor will provide a convenient "one-stop shop" where customers can receive assistance with building permits, code compliance, and business tax receipts, as well as open utility accounts and pay bills. Large TV screens will display your spot in the queue if you experience a wait for service; showcase current and upcoming City programs and events; and provide entertainment.

The 95,000-square-foot, five-story building will also feature a larger City Commission chamber for public meetings, as well as a small museum to highlight Sunrise's history.

Construction is progressing as scheduled, with occupancy of the new City Hall expected at the end of 2022. After demolition of the existing City Hall, anticipated in early 2023, construction will begin on the parking garage and amphitheater improvements – which are anticipated to be completed in early 2024.

GO Bond Update:

Improvements to Parks and Recreation Facilities Continue



On Election Day in 2014, more than 70% of Sunrise voters approved the City's general obligation (GO) bond referendum. Thanks to this overwhelming resident support, Sunrise is able to fund improvements to parks and recreation facilities in neighborhoods citywide.

The map shown here provides a quick visual overview of work funded by GO Bonds. On the following two pages, you'll find more in-depth information about projects recently completed and currently under construction.

We will continue to update you on our progress in upcoming issues of Horizons. We also invite you to visit www.sunrisefl.gov/parkbonds for additional information - including photos and renderings - for all of our projects. (Please keep in mind that renderings are conceptual, and that design details may change over the course of a project.)

You can find project information – and knowledgeable staff members – at City events, too. Look for our GO Bond team at the Sunrise Civic Center Amphitheater during Tunes 'N Trucks concerts on October 8 and November 5, and at the Fall Harvest Festival at the Sunrise Sportsplex on October 16.

The fully-reimagined City Park is the crown jewel of Sunrise's original neighborhoods! Re-opened in November 2020 after a complete renovation, the park now features a lush green lawn surrounded by a walking path and fitness stations. Other amenities include a shaded playground, a soccer-themed splash pad, an amphitheater stage, covered basketball courts, and picnic pavilions.

COMPLETED

12th Street Park — a new neighborhood green space — was constructed on formerly vacant land.

Plamingo Park was renovated to add a new meeting hall, shaded basketball courts, fitness stations, a splash pad, and a second batting cage. The existing meeting facility was renovated and the playground was improved.

3 Bicycle lanes were constructed along NW 44th Street from Pine Island Road to the SAC entrance at NW 117th Avenue.

Nob Hill Soccer Club Park re-opened in November 2019 following a complete renovation. The facility now features two new synthetic turf fields, an improved natural turf field, and a music-themed tot

lot. Nob Hill Clubhouse received a new roof and HVAC system.

Sunrise Sportsplex opened in December 2019. The park features a pinwheel of youth baseball/softball fields, warmup areas, a concession stand/scorer's tower, a multi-purpose field, and a large playground.

The **Civic Center** was expanded and refreshed, and reopened in July 2020. The facility now includes a second indoor gymnasium with basketball courts and an elevated walking track; a bi-level fitness center, updated locker rooms and bathrooms, a new game room, and additional program space.

City Park was completely renovated, and reopened in November 2020. It now features a multiuse green space surrounded by a walking path with

exercise stations; a splash pad; shaded basketball courts; a new playground; resurfaced tennis courts; and a covered outdoor stage for events.

The **Senior Center**, reopened in June 2021, was expanded to accommodate new and enhanced programming. An additional parking lot was also constructed.

UNDER CONTRACT/CONSTRUCTION

Expand **Welleby Park** to add a dog park, a "Safety Town" play-learn area, a splash pad, a new playground, and a lakeside promenade, and enlarge and renovate the existing Community Building.



Create a **Veterans Park** with an accessible playground, a meditation labyrinth, a small pavilion, and monuments in tribute to the U.S. Military Service Branches.

Improve **Roarke Hall** facilities to include new windows, interior remodeling, and exterior lighting (completed); fence replacement (completed); landscape upgrades (completed); and a new splash pad. Completion in Fall 2021.

Renovate **Sunrise Athletic Complex** (SAC) to include a multipurpose building and gymnasium, covered basketball courts, added parking, and a new concession stand and scorers' tower. In addition, improvements will be made to the multipurpose field.

Renovate **Village Beach Club** to include a new lightning protection system (completed); window, door and fence replacement (completed), and pool renovation (completed); restroom (completed), exterior lighting (completed) and landscaping upgrades (nearing contract); and concession building renovation and new signage (completed).

IN DESIGN

The scope at **Oscar Wind Park** (Intermediate Phase) is to demolish the remaining portable classrooms on the old Cypress Bay Annex property, replace the playground with a new playground and shade structure, replace the chain link fence on North New River Circle with a decorative fence, and then

construct an outdoor fitness circuit, a connector road between Oscar Wind Park and Sawgrass Sanctuary Park, walking paths, parking lot improvements, and landscaping/irrigation improvements.

Convert vacant land at Sunset Strip/109th Avenue into a new neighborhood park with a playground.

FUTURE

Renovate and expand **Oscar Wind Park** (Phase II) to include a multi-purpose building and gymnasium, a new sprayground, and dedicated parking.

Convert vacant land at 9525 West Oakland Park Boulevard into a new neighborhood park.

PROJECT SPOTLIGHT: Several GO Bond projects are nearing completion, and others are well underway!









SUNRISE ATHLETIC COMPLEX (SAC)

Work is well underway on the expansion of SAC. The project includes the renovation of the park's existing playground, full-size multipurpose fields, meeting hall, and restroom facilities, and the resurfacing of tennis courts. In addition, a 15,000-square-foot multipurpose building is under construction, along with five new, covered outdoor basketball courts, a concession building with scorers' tower, and additional parking. SAC's sports lighting and security features will also be enhanced. Several fields and a new playground are already open for use; the entire project is expected to be completed in spring 2022.

ROARKE HALL

Work is continuing on the renovation of Roarke Hall and its grounds. The building is receiving interior upgrades, as well as a new roof and hurricane protection improvements. The pool is being refinished and a new splash pad is being constructed. Enhancements also include a poolside gas grill. Some elements of the project have already been completed, and the facility is expected to reopen in fall 2021.

GO BOND UPDATE







VETERANS PARK

Much of the work is finished on a new Veterans Park with flags and monuments that pay tribute to all U.S. military branches of service. Additional features include a boundless playground for children of all abilities, a meditation labyrinth for quiet contemplation, a memorial tree with a paver plaza, and a remembrance pavilion. The park will also offer reserved parking for combat-wounded Veterans. Veterans Park is expected to be completed in fall 2021.

WELLEBY PARK

The City purchased five acres of adjacent land to facilitate the expansion and renovation Welleby Park – which is nearly complete. Once the project is finished, Welleby Park will be the site of Sunrise's first municipal dog park, with areas for large, small, and tiny dogs. Also new to Welleby Park will be a Safety Town play/learn area (with concrete pads already in place and miniature buildings now being fabricated), a nature-themed splash pad, a boardwalk plaza, and a new playground. The existing community building has been expanded to accommodate programs and rentals for up to 50 people.

Additional Flexi-Pave pathways are being constructed and there will be additional parking available, as well as enhanced lighting and security features. Welleby Park is expected to be finished by the end of 2021.

LIGHTNING PREDICTION SYSTEM

The City has taken certain precautions to minimize the potential for lightning related injuries. The Thor Guard Lightning Prediction and Warning System has been installed to provide protection from lightning disasters for the public. When the Thor Guard system sounds (15 second horn blast), the outdoor facility must be cleared of all patrons, who must seek and remain in buildings or vehicles until the all clear signal sounds (3 short horn blasts).

It is recommended that park patrons seek a sheltered area, such as buildings, vehicles or other fully enclosed structures. Patrons should not seek refuge in or near dugouts, trees, fences, tot lot equipment, light and telephone poles, umbrellas, metal objects, etc. This policy shall apply to all programs and facilities operated by the City of Sunrise. Individuals who disregard this policy may be subject to arrest for trespassing.

The Thor Guard system is in operation Monday through Sunday, 8:00 am to 10:00 pm at the following locations: Sunrise Civic Center, SAC Park, Welleby Park, City Park, Roarke Hall, Nob Hill Soccer Club, Flamingo Park, Oscar Wind Park, Sawgrass Sanctuary Park, Sunrise Tennis Club, Springtree Golf Club, Piper Field and Welleby Pool.
