I was making a right turn to turn into the SPD restricted area gate. I noticed a Hispanic male approximately 6 ft tall, 260 lbs. with medium length hair wearing a gray outfit and red shoes pacing back and forth in the roadway. As I pulled past him, he walked toward my marked police vehicle and immediately recognized me as "that bitch who arrested me". [REDACTED] then clinched his fist and began punching my driver side window repeatedly almost breaking my window. I commanded [REDACTED] to stop and to get back. I then called for a backup officer over the radio to assist me with the subject.</p> <p>[REDACTED] continued to strike my window until he noticed Ofc. Krohn behind him in vehicle [REDACTED] then took a few steps back and continued to yell obscenities at me. I exited my vehicle and created space by taking a tactical position several feet away from [REDACTED]. It should be noted that [REDACTED] is approximately 1 foot taller and 140 lbs. heavier than this officer. [REDACTED] is 6 foot tall and 260 lbs. and I am 5'1, 120 lbs.</p>

[redacted] walked toward my marked police vehicle and immediately recognized me as "that bitch who arrested me" [redacted] then clinched his fist and began punching my driver side window repeatedly almost breaking my window. I commanded [redacted] to stop and to get back. I then called for a backup officer over the radio to assist me with the subject.

[redacted] continued to strike my window until he noticed Ofc. Krohn behind him in vehicle. [redacted] then took a few steps back and continued to yell obscenities at me. I exited my vehicle and created space by taking a tactical position several feet away from [redacted]. [redacted] ignored my commands to stop advancing towards me with clinched fists. I was in fear that I would be physically over powered/attacked due to his size, aggressive demeanor with clinched fists and refusal to comply to my lawful commands. I told [redacted] if he continued towards me, I would deploy my taser and defend myself. [redacted] ignored my commands and continued advancing towards me, at which time utilized my department issued Taser 7. [redacted] was ultimately tased.

[redacted] was ultimately detained via handcuffs, leg shackles and a Sunrise Fire Rescue body restraint device.



On 9/4/2021, I was on my way to work when I was making the right turn to turn into the SPD restricted area gate I noticed a hispanic male approximately 6 ft tall, 260 lbs with medium length hair wearing a gray t-shirt, gray gym shorts and red shoes yelling and pacing back and forth in the roadway. As I pulled past him he walked toward my marked police vehicle and immediately recognized me yelling "you're that bitch who arrested me", clinched his fist and began punching my front driver side window repeatedly. I yelled at [REDACTED] through the window to stop and get back as I called for a backup officer over the radio.

[REDACTED] continued to punch my window until he noticed my backup officer (Officer K. Krohn) pull his vehicle up behind him when he then took a few steps back and continued to yell at me in an aggressive and irate manner. At this time I was able to exit my vehicle and walk backwards to create space between myself and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] began walking toward me in an aggressive manner yelling and cursing while clinching his fist and throwing his hands up. I told [REDACTED] if he kept coming toward me he was going to be tased. [REDACTED] continued taking steps toward me which resulted in deploying my department issued TASER7.

It should be noted that [REDACTED] is 6 ft and 260 lbs. I am 5'1" and 120 lbs. There was an immediate fear that due to his behavior, if [REDACTED] continued to advance toward me, I would be attacked by [REDACTED] and sustain physical injury.

[REDACTED] immediately fell to the ground and was placed in handcuffs by Officer K. Krohn, Officer C. McCarthy and myself. [REDACTED] continued to resist arrest and yell "Im ready to die, I hit rock bottom motherfucker". [REDACTED] continued to tense, brace, and kick his legs while handcuffed. At this time Rescue was requested to respond. SFR #48 responded with their Body Restraining Device and transported [REDACTED] to FMC. I rode with [REDACTED] in SFR truck #48 to FMC.

[REDACTED] continued to yell and resist even after multiple doses of medication from rescue and FMC. Baker Act paperwork was filled out for [REDACTED] as well as a Return to Law Enforcement Custody Form for resisting without violence and disorderly conduct. A PC for [REDACTED] arrest was left in the Sergeants officer awaiting his release from FMC.

It should be noted since I was off duty at the time my body worn camera was off. I was able to turn my BWC on after my taser deployed and activate my camera for the remainder of the incident. Sergeant C. Pullease was on scene.

A CEW and RRR was filled out and given to Sgt C. Pullease. An Extra Watch was created for the Public Safety Building.

Taser prongs were removed at FMC by [REDACTED] and submitted into SPD Evidence by myself.

I restrained [REDACTED] legs/ankles due to him having sporadic outbursts of anger and attempting to kick/flail his legs. I continued to do so until Sunrise Fire Rescue arrived on scene, at which time, I assisted in placing and securing [REDACTED] in the gurney. This ended my involvement in this incident.

Cook's (3774) vehicle window, as she sat inside her vehicle. Upon arrival, numerous other Sunrise Officers already had the subject, [REDACTED], detained in handcuffs.

[REDACTED] appeared to be in a state of excited delirium, and most likely under the influence of narcotic(s). [REDACTED] was screaming "take me to jail" and rambling unintelligibly. [REDACTED] was writhing on the ground as he continued to yell and shout, requiring numerous officers to keep him under control.

Sunrise Fire Rescue responded to our location, at which time I utilized leg restraints on [REDACTED] and assisted in restraining him in fire rescue's full-body restraint device. Once [REDACTED] was secured and loaded into the rescue, I went back in service.

On the listed date and time, I assisted as a backup Officer in this case.

While arriving to the Sunrise Public Safety Complex to begin my daily patrol shift, I observe Officers struggling to detain an adult Hispanic male. The male was screaming at Officers, kicking his legs and violently moving his body around on the ground. I proceeded to assist by holding the subject's legs down with my hands and knee so he would not kick other Officers on scene. Further, I assisted in transferring the subject to a restraint wrap provided by Sunrise Fire-Rescue, so the male subject could be safely transported to a hospital. I had no further involvement in this case.

It should be noted that my Body Worn Camera (BWC) was not recording during this incident as I had not yet activated it before arriving on scene. I had not yet begun my regularly scheduled shift, had unknowingly stumbled upon the developing incident, and did not have a chance to activate it as I rapidly emerged from my marked unit to assist my fellow Officers.

BWC NOT IN USE

I responded to the main entry gate of 10440 W Oakland Park Blvd. (Sunrise Police Department) in reference to a male causing a disturbance in front of the gate.

Upon my arrival, I observed a male banging his fist against the window of Ofc. A. Cook's marked patrol vehicle while she was inside the vehicle. I proceeded to exit my vehicle to make contact with the male. The male then noticed me walking toward him and backed away from Ofc. Cook's vehicle. Ofc. Cook then exited her vehicle at which point the male began to approach her in an aggressive manner. Ofc. Cook then deployed her department issued taser and utilized it against the male. The male then fell to the ground at which point myself and Ofc. C. McCarthy took control of the male and detained him.

I then made contact with (IO) Eric Rath who was on scene and claimed he knows the male. Rath identified the male as [REDACTED] who is a friend of Rath's brother. Rath currently works at the Sunrise Civic Center and observed [REDACTED] walking up to the Civic Center to workout. Rath stopped to speak to [REDACTED] to let him know that the Civic Center was closing soon. [REDACTED] then began speaking about how he's at the lowest point of his life after being arrested. [REDACTED] became more and more agitated as the conversation continued. According to Rath, [REDACTED] then "snapped." Rath observed [REDACTED] walk over to gate of the police department where he proceeded to start yelling. Rath further observed [REDACTED] walk up to Ofc. Cook's car and proceed to start banging on her vehicle window. Rath does not believe this is normal behavior for [REDACTED].

It should be noted, my BWC was not activated at first contact with [REDACTED] because I was not yet in-service and was reporting for briefing.

No further action taken by this officer.

On 9/4/21 Ofc. A Williams and I were in the back of the Sunrise Police Department just outside of the sally port typing up arrest paperwork with a prisoner in the back of my vehicle. Ofc. Williams and I both started hearing a loud male voice screaming on the other side of the west gate of the police department. I left Ofc. A. Williams to monitor the prisoner while I walked over to the gate to try to get a visual of the male. It should be noted that my BWC was inside my vehicle pointed on the prisoner so I did not have it on me. As I got closer, I could hear the male voice getting louder and yelling "come arrest me" over and over. I could not see the male because I was still inside the gate but I notified dispatch of a disturbance/possible mentally ill individual outside of the west gate and to have officers respond. Moments later Ofc. A. Cook came over police radio and advised that a male was trying to break her car window outside of the gate. I ran outside of the west gate and saw Ofc. A Cook walking back from her vehicle with her taser in hand pointed at a large hispanic male that was aggressively moving toward her. The male appeared to be about six feet tall and approximately 250 pounds with long brown hair and a gray shirt. The male had his fists clenched as he was walking toward Ofc. Cook and he appeared agitated. I observed Ofc. A. Cook deploy her taser and the male went to the ground. I ran over and assisted Ofc. Krohn in placing the male into handcuffs. It took multiple officers to restrain the male who continued to resist while he was detained and kept yelling obscenities to officers. The male continued to try to get up off the ground and resist officers so leg shackles were placed on him. Sgt. Pullease arrived on scene and assisted in restraining the male. The male was also screaming and spitting at the same time which caused this officer to get the male's spit on my face and vest, even after a spit mask was placed on him. The male's pupils were also dilated and it appeared he was having a mental breakdown or under the influence of an unknown substance. I assisted in keeping the male restrained until Sunrise Fire Rescue arrived. Officers and fire rescue worked together to put the male in a body restraining device before Sunrise Fire Rescue 48 transported the male to the hospital.
