<p>On Nov 3rd, 2021, I responded to 8743 NW 39th St. (The Preserves) in reference to an active physical domestic dispute between female caller and male. The male description provided was a W/M wearing a white t-shirt and grey pants. Upon arrival at the residence parking lot, myself and Ofc. M. Ryan #3786 made contact with Harlyn D. Fritz who matched the description provided. We asked Harlyn if he was okay. Harlyn advised officers to stay back 6 feet or we would have a situation. Officers inquired about the hostility. Harley stated he did not want to speak to "crackers." Harlyn went on asking officers if we had kids and added this was not worth it. At this point additional officers were requested. Harlyn continued his aggression by displaying pre-assault indicators pacing back and forth aggressively, emptying his pockets and stretching for what I perceived as he was going to physically fight officers. Officer McCarthy #3745 responded on scene and began giving Harlyn verbal commands to sit on the ground but Harlyn continued not complying and taser was successfully deployed by Ofc. McCarthy. On the ground Harlyn continued to resist officer efforts of placing him in handcuffs by tensing and pulling his arms. I used the taser to deliver drive stuns to Harlyn's back and left arm to gain compliance. Harlyn was successfully handcuffed safely allowing officers to conduct the investigation. Probable cause for arrest was established for domestic battery.</p>

Ryan were triangulated from him in a distance of about 15-20 feet. Officers asked me to go upstairs to make contact with the female caller who was still inside her apartment. As I was walking upstairs to the apartment Ofc. Blanco requested an additional officer to respond to the scene. From Ofc. Blanco's radio transmission I understood that Fritz needed to be detained due to the high probability of Fritz becoming violent. I walked up to Fritz and gave him a verbal command to sit on the ground in which he replied "I'm not sitting" and further stated that he already told the other officers that he did not need to listen to them and was letting me know he was not going to listen to any commands I was giving. I told Fritz that if he did not comply with any verbal commands to sit on the ground he would be tased. Fritz further stated that he did not need to listen to officers and continued to stand there explaining why. I took my taser out and gave out more loud verbal commands to sit on the ground to which Fritz still did not comply. Fritz shrugged his shoulders and started to take a few steps turning his body away putting his hands on his hips. I gave more verbal commands to Fritz that</p>

Officers asked me to go upstairs to make contact with the female caller who was still inside her apartment. As I was walking upstairs to the apartment Ofc. Blanco requested an additional officer to respond to the scene. At that point I knew Fritz needed to be detained based on officers request for an another officer due to the high probability of Fritz becoming violent. I walked up to Fritz and gave him a verbal command to sit on the ground in which he replied "I'm not sitting" and further stated that he already told the other officers that he did not need to listen to them and was letting me know he was not going to listen to any commands I was giving. I told Fritz that if he did not comply with any verbal commands to sit on the ground he would be tased. I took my taser out and gave out more loud verbal commands to sit on the ground to which Fritz still did not comply. I deployed one standoff cartridge from my taser which hit Fritz above the belly button and in the belt region. Fritz fell to the ground and officers attempted to put handcuffs on the subject but he was still not complying so Ofc. Blanco administered drive stuns with his taser to his midsection until Fritz was detained. Fritz was transported to Westside Regional Hospital by Sunrise Fire Rescue 59.



On 11/03/21 I was dispatched to the listed address in reference to a physical domestic disturbance.

Upon arrival, I met with the offender, later identified as Harlyn Fritz (OF), in the parking lot by his vehicle. Harlyn immediately became aggressive toward officers and stated "Putting handcuffs on me will not be easy!", in addition to advising officers to "stay out of this if you have kids." It should be noted, Harlyn started to pace around, moving his neck back and forth, and clenching his fists. Based on Harlyn's previous comments and physical actions, it was believed that he was getting ready to physically attack Officers. Due to Harlyn's behavior, an additional Officer responded to the scene. While conducting my criminal investigation, Harlyn refused to answer any questions. Harlyn escalated his hostility to Officers and then refused to comply to our verbal commands to sit on the ground after several verbal requests were made. Based on the potential of physical violence against Officers coupled with the fact that Harlyn refused to comply to our lawful commands to sit on the ground, Harlyn was tasered. Harlyn, then tensed and braced his arms and legs physically resisting our efforts to detain him with handcuffs. Sunrise Officers then gave Harlyn a Taser drive-stun into his mid-section; which Harlyn ultimately complied to our commands and was detained.

Harlyn was read his Miranda Warning via pretext card by this officer. Harlyn invoked his rights, desiring not to speak to me and stated "Go get her side of the story, that's all you need."

Contact was made with the victim (VI [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised that the Harlyn is her ex fiance and they have been separated for 6 months, but they have a 4yo son in common [REDACTED]), to which they co-parent. [REDACTED] stated at approximately 0530 hours, Harlyn arrived at the residence unexpectedly, while drinking a "4Loko" alcoholic beverage. [REDACTED] stated that Harlyn left the residence at 0700 hours with her extra house key, but returned shortly after and was consuming additional alcoholic beverages. [REDACTED] stated that Harlyn said he wanted to talk, but started to accuse of her cheating and attempted to take her cellphone. At this point [REDACTED] advised that Harlyn mounted her while on the sofa, but the altercation carried over into the bedroom. It should be noted, [REDACTED] had visible bruising to her right upper arm, a black eye (left eye), and a laceration to the inside of her upper lip (blood visible).

Sergeant Pullease (3563) arrived on scene and was debriefed on the incident.

[REDACTED] expressed to officers that she wishes to pursue charges against Harlyn, and signed an affidavit stating so. Photos of [REDACTED] injuries were taken and uploaded to Evidence.com. Officers provided [REDACTED] with a Domestic Violence Pamphlet.


Based on [REDACTED] statement and the injuries observed on her person, Harlyn was taken into custody and transported by Sunrise Rescue 59 to Westside Regional Hospital for medical clearance. Harlyn was then transported to BSO Main Jail without incident.

Fritz who matched the description provided. We asked Harlyn if he was okay. Harlyn advised officers to stay back 6 feet or we would have a situation. Officers inquired about the hostility, Harlyn stated he did not want to speak to "crackers."

Harlyn went on asking officers if we had kids and added this was not worth it. At this point additional officers were requested. Harlyn continued his aggression by pacing back and forth aggressively, emptying his pockets and stretching for what I perceived as he was going to physically fight officers. Officer McCarthy #3745 responded on scene and began giving Harlyn verbal commands to sit on the ground but Harlyn continued not complying and taser was successfully deployed by Ofc. McCarthy.

On the ground Harlyn continued to resist officer efforts of placing him in handcuffs by tensing and pulling his arms. I used the taser to deliver drive stuns to Harlyn's back and left arm to gain compliance. Harlyn was successfully handcuffed safely and were now able to investigate the incident. Probable cause for arrest was established for domestic battery.

Harlyn transported by Sunrise fire rescue #59 to westside regional hospital for medical clearance and later transported to jail for processing. I completed a department response to resistance form and a CEW use form. No further.
