<p>At approximately 20:40 hours on 10/22/2021, Officers were flagged down by Hollister Loss Prevention Agents outside of Avenue 3 of the Sawgrass Mills Mall. They needed assistance with the apprehension of two shoplifters who another Agent was actively following. Loss Prevention stated two suspects were now inside the Finish Line store after having stolen merchandise from the Hollister. Officers and Loss Prevention went to the Finish Line and stopped the subjects in order for the merchandise to be recovered and the investigation to be conducted. The subjects were detained, however not immediately placed in handcuffs.</p> <p>While recovering the stolen merchandise from the subjects. Ashley Singletary dropped her shopping bags and fled from Officers in an attempt to evade arrest. During the foot chase, I unholstered my Taser from a distance of approximately 10-15 feet away from the subject and deployed one taser cartridge which was ineffective. I then deployed a second cartridge which caused Ashley to fall to the floor. Ashley actively resisted Law Enforcement Officers by fleeing on foot and after she was struck with the Taser probe, she was safely taken into custody. It should be noted that all Officers who had confronted Ashley and the co-defendant were wearing either a Class B uniform or Sunrise Police bicycle uniform. Both of these uniforms display departmental insignia and police badges.</p>

Ashley was medically cleared for the jail at Cleveland Clinic and later transported to BSO main jail for processing. At the conclusion of the investigation, Ashley was charged with one count of resisting law enforcement officers without violence, one count of petit theft, one count of use of a antishoplifting countermeasure device, one count of felony VOP, and a misdemeanor capias. My BWC was active during the events that transpired.

At 2040 hours on 10/22/2021, Loss Prevention Agent William Lehman from the Hollister store flagged down Officers at 12801 West Sunrise Blvd in reference to two shoplifters who had stolen from there store, along with multiple other stores. William advised he and Loss Prevention Agent Christos Gians, needed assistance making the apprehension inside the Finish Line store.

Upon arrival, contact was made with the defendant, (OF) Ashley Singletary and co-defendant (OF) Akeme Frederick. Both were detained outside of Finish Line. 1 stolen t-shirt was recovered from inside Akeme's personal bag and 2 articles of stolen apparel were recovered inside Ashley's shopping bags. While the merchandise was being recovered from their bags, Ashley removed a metal hook, very commonly used to defeat security sensors that are attached to clothing, from her bag and handed it over to William. While we were investigating the theft and questioning everyone, Ashley dropped her bags and took off running in the mall. Officer Cook #3774 and I gave chase, attempting to apprehend Ashley for resisting, petit theft, and possession of an antishoplifting countermeasure device. I unholstered my Taser and deployed two cartridges, because the first Taser deployment was unsuccessful. Ashley was then safely taken into custody. Once in handcuffs, she was escorted to a marked police vehicle where we waited for Fire Rescue to respond to tend to her wound from the Taser probe. It should be noted that all Officers were wearing their Sunrise Police uniforms with department insignia and badge clearly visible to Ashley and Akeme.

Once outside, I spoke more in-depth with William and Christos. William and Christos advised Ashley and Akeme entered Hollister, selected merchandise, and concealed it in their personal bags. Ashley and Akeme were observed doing this by CCTV and floor surveillance. Ashley then used the metal hook to pry the sensors off the Hollister clothing. She then concealed the clothing again and exited the store, passing all points of sale, making no attempt to pay for the selected or concealed merchandise. Akeme selected his own merchandise and also left the store, passing all points of sale, making no attempt to pay for the selected and concealed merchandise. Once they exited the store, William and Christos followed the subjects and called in the theft to 911. William separated from Christos and flagged down Police to assist with the apprehension.

Ashley did temporarily deprive Hollister of its merchandise valued at \$59.90. Akeme temporarily deprived Hollister of its clothing valued at \$29.95. The clothing was recovered with no sensors on it. William stated he desires prosecution for the thefts. It should be noted that other merchandise was found in the possession of Ashley and Akeme. These items were returned to the respective stores the following day.

A database check revealed Ashley had an outstanding misdemeanor capias for Violation of a Court Order. The capias was confirmed (WC 20211204819) and the case number for the capias was 21002193MM10A. The bond is listed as \$1,000. A further database check revealed Ashley is on felony probation (Case # N60645) for grand theft and was charged with felony Violation of Probation.

A database check of Akeme revealed he is on felony probation for Grand Theft (Case #18010181CF10A) and Robbery (Case #19014578CF10A). He was therefore charged with the felony Violation of Probation.

Both Ashley and Akeme were read their Miranda Warnings and said they did not wish to provide a statement.

Ashley was transported to Cleveland Clinic to have the Taser prong removed. The single Taser probe struck Ashley in her thigh. The only injury claimed by Ashley was the prob strike to her leg. Officer Richardson #3781 was with Ashley during the medical clearance. She was later transported to BSO Main jail for processing by Officer Cook.

Akeme was transported by Officer Dewese #3695 to BSO Main jail for processing for his charges.

Both Ashley and Akeme were indefinitely trespassed from the Sawgrass Mills Mall and all associated businesses (Colonades and Oasis). They were also specifically trespassed from all Hollister affiliated stores across the country.

The Evidence.com link for the CCTV footage from Hollister was emailed to their Loss Prevention Team for submission. Pictures of the stolen and recovered merchandise were uploaded to Evidence.com as well. Ashley was photographed by Officer Cook for the Taser contact and these photos were also uploaded. I submitted the hook (antishoplifting countermeasure device), the green leafy substance (that could not be field tested as cannabis at this time), and the Taser probes/cartridges into a Sunrise Police Evidence locker. The shoplifter apprehension reports and affidavit were turned over to the Sunrise Records Unit.

Sergeant Wilds #3719 responded to the scene. A Response to Resistance was filled out in accordance with agency policy and procedure for the Taser deployment.

The specific questions and statements can be obtained from the uploaded body-worn camera footage from this incident. All statements listed above are summaries of what was said during the interviews and conversations with the involved parties.

I made contact with Hollister LP, William Lehman, while myself and primary Officer C. Douglass were outside of Sawgrass Mall Avenue #3 Entrance. William notified us of a male and female shoplifter that he observed taking items from his store. After entering the mall William pointed out a black female and a black male both walking in the mall carrying shopping bags. William pointed them out to myself and Officer Douglass.

I made contact with the female while Officer C. Douglass made contact with the male. (It should be noted I had little to no contact with the male party throughout this incident) I asked the female for her name and date of birth to which she replied KEYANNA LEATHE 6-12-1990. I attempted to call SPD Teletype to run the female through NCIC/FCIC. At this time the female began running through the mall in attempts to flee from officers. I displayed my department issued Taser and yelled to the female stop running or you will be tased. At this time Officer Douglass deployed his department issued Taser striking the female with one prong in the front right thigh area. The female immediately dropped to the ground and placed her hands out in front of her on the ground. The female was ordered to place her hands behind her back, which she did. I immediately placed her under arrest.

The female was placed into the back of Officer C. Douglass' patrol vehicle when she made a comment about calling her mother because her 11 year old son was in the car. I asked her where he car was parked but she was unable to tell me. The female gave me her mothers number to call her. I made contact with the number I was provided to which she stated her daughter was not named Keyanna Leathe and her real name was ASHLEY SINGLETARY with a date of birth of 6/21/1990. It was determined the son was actually not at the mall and with a family member who dropped him off to Ashley' mothers house. Ashley admitted to Officer C. Douglass that her name is Ashley not Keyanna.

I rode with SFR to Cleveland Clinic where the Taser prong was removed. I then transported Ashley to Broward County Main Jail without further incident.

On October 22, 2021, at approximately 2040 hours, while working a detail at Brandsmart, I responded as a back up officer to a domestic disturbance in front of entrance three (3). While officers were clearing the incident, Loss Prevention (LP) Agent William Lehman from the Hollister store flagged Officers down in front of entrance 3 in reference to two shoplifters who had stolen from their store. LP Agent William advised he and LP Agent Christos Gians, needed assistance making the apprehensions.

Upon arrival, contact was made with both shoplifting suspects later identified as Ashley Singletary and Akeme Frederick. Both were detained outside of Finish Line. While the merchandise was being recovered from their bags, Ashley removed a metal hook, very commonly used to defeat security sensors that are attached to clothing, from her bag and handed it over to LP Agent Lehman.

While we were investigating the theft and questioning everyone, Ashley dropped her bags and took off running through the mall. Officers Douglass, Cook and I gave chase, attempting to apprehend Ashley for resisting, petit theft, and possession of an antishoplifting countermeasure device. Officers Douglass and Cook unholstered their Tasers and Officer Douglass deployed it on Ashley. Ashley subsequently fell to the ground and was then taken into custody. Once in handcuffs, she was escorted to a marked police vehicle where we waited for Sunrise Fire Rescue to respond to tend to her wound from the Taser probe.

No further action taken.
