#### Narrative - continued

It should be noted that Ofc. J. Honig, while working a mall lot detail, arrived on scene first. Michael, while with Ofc. Honig, identified Zeigler and Strachan upon passing all points of sale and exiting the store. Ofc. Honig (in full Class B uniform, with corresponding SPD insignia) made contact with both, at which point Zeigler immediately fled on foot through the corridor. Ofc. Honig transmitted this over Sunrise PD Main channel, as he had Strachan in custody, after a short pursuit. (Please see Ofc. Honig's supplement for further.)

Myself and Ofc. Roberson (both in Class B uniforms), in a parallel corridor, immediately exited the corridor. Upon exiting, I observed Zeigler, matching the suspect description given over SPD Main Channel, (a B/M wearing a red shirt and red pants), running towards the Green Toad parking lot. I gave Zeigler numerous loud, audible verbal commands to stop running, however he continued to run and enter a newer model Chrysler mini-van, bearing FL Tag: BWHB21). Ofc. Roberson then opened the passenger door as Zeigler was attempting to turn the vehicle on in an attempt to flee from officers. He continued to actively resist Ofc. Roberson, bracing, tensing, pushing and pulling away. (Please see Ofc. Roberson's supplement for further)

Zeigler then exited the driver's side door and again continued to flee on foot (westbound) through the parking lot. While in foot pursuit of Zeigler, I deployed my department issued TASER, which made contact and immediately subdued Zeigler. Ofc. Roberson attempted to place Zeigler into custody, however he again resisted officers attempts to place him into custody. Zeigler continued to thrash his body, kick his legs, hide his arms underneath him and continually push and pull away from officers. While attempting to assist Ofc. Roberson, to to gain control of Zeigler, I delivered closed hand strikes to his torso, neck and head area, which resulted in me sustaining open lacerations to my right hand. Once compliance was achieved, Officers were able to place hand-cuff restraints on to Zeigler.

Upon placing him into custody, Sunrise Fire Rescue 48 responded (Run #14262) and transported to Cleveland Clinic Zeigler due to the TASER deployment and the facial lacerations he sustained during the incident.

The TASER probes made contact with Zeigler at the back of the neck and mid back areas.

Upon arriving to Cleveland Clinic, Zeigler was admitted into Room 5 of the Emergency department. Medical staff successfully removed the TASER probes, which were then collected, along with the cartridge for evidence.

Zeigler was ultimately medically cleared and discharged from the hospital. Officer Lam and Officer Ellis transported him to BSO Main Jail along with the appropriate medical clearance paperwork.

I responded to the above location in reference to two shoplifters inside the store. (RP) Michael Mohammed, the loss prevention agent for Dick's, advised (OF-1) Lou'Quinn Zeigler and (OF-2) Jakira Strachan, were observed via floor and CCTV surveillance selecting merchandise from various sections of the store. Zeigler and Strachan were observed by Michael concealing the selected merchandise into a VANS bag. Both worked in concert as they acted as look-outs for each other while selecting and concealing the merchandise. Both were in possession of the selected and concealed merchandise, thus depriving Dick's of it's property. They passed all points of sale together with the selected and concealed merchandise.

It should be noted that Ofc. J. Honig, while working a mall lot detail, arrived on scene first. Michael, while with Ofc. Honig, identified Zeigler and Strachan upon passing all points of sale and exiting the store. Ofc. Honig (in full Class B uniform, with corresponding SPD insignia) made contact with both, at which point Zeigler immediately fled on foot through the corridor. Ofc. Honig transmitted this over Sunrise PD Main channel, as he had Strachan in custody, after a short foot pursuit. (Please see Ofc. Honig's supplement for further.)

Myself and Ofc. Roberson (both in Class B uniforms, also with corresponding SPD insignia), in a parallel corridor, immediately exited the corridor. Upon exiting, I observed Zeigler, matching the suspect description given over SPD Main Channel, (a B/M wearing a red shirt and red pants), running toward the Green Toad parking lot. I gave Zeigler numerous loud, audible verbal commands to stop running, however he continued to run and enter a newer model Chrysler mini-van bearing FL Tag: BWHB21. Ofc. Roberson then opened the passenger door as Zeigler was attempting to turn the vehicle on in an attempt to flee from officers. He continued to actively resist Ofc. Roberson by bracing, tensing, pushing and pulling away. (Please see Ofc. Roberson's supplement for further)

Zeigler then exited the driver's side door and again continued to flee on foot (westbound) through the parking lot. While in foot pursuit of Zeigler, I deployed my department issued TASER, which made contact and immediately subdued Zeigler. Ofc. Roberson attempted to place Zeigler into custody, however he again physically resisted officers' attempts to place him into custody. Zeigler continued to thrash his body, kick his legs, hide his arms underneath himself and continually push and pull away from officers. While attempting to assist Ofc. Roberson, to gain control of Zeigler, I delivered closed handed strikes to his torso, neck and head area, which resulted in me sustaining open lacerations to my right hand. Once compliance was achieved, Officers were able to place handcuff restraints on to Zeigler.

Upon placing him into custody, Sunrise Fire Rescue 48 responded (Run #14262) and transported Zeigler due to the TASER deployment and the facial lacerations he sustained during the incident. He was transported to Cleveland Clinic Hospital in Weston. The TASER probes made contact with Zeigler at the back of the neck and mid back areas.

The recovered stolen merchandise was valued at a total of \$761.00. Michael desires prosecution on behalf of Dick's for the theft and as such Zeigler and Strachan were placed under arrest. Note: Ofc. Roberson authored the PC affidavit for Strachan, SN659.

A routine FCIC/NCIC check revealed that Zeigler is currently on Felony probation for grand theft, with an expiration of 2/3/2028. It should also be noted that Zeigler has an extensive criminal history to include Theft and Fraud. He currently has a total of 16 Felony charges, 3 Felony convictions and 8 Misdemeanor charges with 3 Misdemeanor convictions. Please see below for details on the Violation of Probation:

Contact with Zeigler's Parole Officer, Antonio Rodgers 305-629-7170, yielded negative results.

The vehicle Zeigler was attempting to flee in, newer model Chrysler mini-van, bearing FL Tag: BWHB21, was inventoried and towed by Ofc. Honig. Inside the vehicle numerous clothing items, with sensors still attached, were recovered. Also located in the vehicle was cash with an approximate total of \$1960.00, which was verified by Sgt. Fernandez. The cash was submitted into SPD Evidence by Ofc. Roberson. Also submitted were Zeigler's personal's effects, such as his cellphone and Florida DL.

Upon arriving to Cleveland Clinic, Zeigler was admitted into Room 5 of the Emergency department. Medical staff successfully removed the TASER probes, which were then collected, along with the cartridge for evidence.

Zeigler was ultimately medically cleared and discharged from the hospital. Officer Lam and Officer Ellis transported him to BSO Main Jail along with the appropriate medical clearance paperwork.

Officer Lam submitted the TASER cartridge and probes into SPD Evidence.

I also was registered as a patient to treat the open lacerations to my hand as well as a check of possible communicable diseases. I was medically cleared and discharged from the hospital.

Michael provided the SPD Shoplifters Apprehension Report, submitted into SPD Records and corresponding CCTV footage, store receipt and photograph of the stolen/recovered merchandise via Evidence.com

The CEW and Response to Resistance Forms were also completed and submitted via the chain of command.

On 11/23/2021, at approximately 18:08 hours, while working an off-duty detail at the Sawgrass Mills Mall, located at 12801 W. Upon arrival, I made entry into the rear of business via the customer pick up doors, and made contact with a female associate, along with Dick's Sporting Goods Loss Prevention Agent (LPA) Michael Mohammed (RP). LPA Mohammed advised he had 2 subjects, later identified as Lou'quinn Zeigler (OF) and Jakira Strachan (OF) via their Florida ID's, actively concealing merchandise inside the business.

I advised LPA Mohammed to continue observing Strachan and Zeigler, while I remained out of sight in the rear of the business with the female associate. A short time later, LPA Mohammed communicated via walkie talkie headset to the female associate, who then communicated to me that Strachan and Zeigler were making their way toward the mall-side entry/exit doors of the business with the concealed merchandise.

I then made my way toward the entry/exit doors of the business, where I made contact with LPA Mohammed in the interior of the mall, passed all points of sale for the business. LPA Mohammed pointed out Strachan and Zeigler, who were already approximately 15-25 yards ahead of me. Immediately upon seeing me, Strachan and Zeigler took flight on foot into the mall corridor nearest the business. It should be noted, I was dressed in my full road patrol uniform, with badge and department insignia affixed.

While chasing Strachan and Zeigler through the corridor, I advised I was "10-31" and provided Strachan's and Zeigler's physical description over the radio. Upon exiting the corridor into the Green Toad Parking Lot, I immediately observed Strachan standing between 2 City of Sunrise Police vehicles, pointed my department-issued taser at her, and ordered her surrender. Strachan surrendered without me having to discharge my taser, and was taken into custody without further incident.

While taking Strachan into custody, I observed Zeigler still taking flight through the parking lot, followed by Sunrise Officers Malave and Roberson. As I advised over the radio that I had the female in custody, I heard the distinct sound of a taser being fired come from the area where I last observed Zeigler being pursued by Officers. Moments later, Ofc. Malave got on the radio and advised "taser deployed". A short time later, Sunrise Officer Cubides arrived on scene, and I had him secure Strachan in his marked police vehicle. Approximately 97 seconds after Ofc. Malave advised "taser deployed", a passerby flagged me down and motioned toward where I last saw Officers Malave and Roberson.

While running toward where the passerby was directing my attention to, Officer Malave got on the radio and requested an additional unit. As I rounded the parking aisle, the passerby was pointing down, I observed Officers Malave and Roberson struggling on the ground with Zeigler. I ran over to where Officers Malave and Roberson were wrestling with Zeigler, and together we were able to successfully detain Zeigler in handcuffs.

While fleeing from Officers Malave and Roberson, Zeigler made entry into a gray 2020 Chrysler Voyager minivan (FL Tag: BWHB21) in an attempt to flee the area. However, Zeigler abandoned his efforts to flee in the vehicle, exited the vehicle, and continued to flee on foot. After Zeigler was detained, and the scene secured, officers observed numerous clothing items through the untinted windows of Zeigler's vehicle, all with store security sensors still attached.

A record check revealed that Zeigler's vehicle was a rental vehicle owned by EAN Holdings. Due to the fact that the vehicle was used during the commission of a felony, the fact that a large amount of stolen merchandise was in plain view from outside the vehicle, and the fact the vehicle belonged to EAN Holdings, the decision was made to tow the vehicle from the arrest location.

I inventoried the vehicle incident to arrest and tow, and discovered Zeigler's FL ID card in the center console, a small pouch of suspected cannabis in the driver's door, various suspected cannabis paraphernalia items between the driver and front passenger seats, a black cross-body style bag containing a large sum of cash, and numerous articles of clothing and other merchandise with store security sensors still attached.

The cash was counted on scene by Sunrise Police Sgt. L. Fernandez, sealed in a SPD Cash Evidence bag, and turned over to Ofc. Roberson for entry into SPD Evidence. All suspect contraband was collected and turned over to Ofc. Roberson for entry into SPD Evidence for destruction. The suspected stolen merchandise was collected and turned over to Ofc. Roberson, pending follow-up investigation with the various victim businesses.

While I followed Ofc. Roberson to the SPD mall substation, Westway Towing responded and removed the vehicle from the arrest location. I remained with Ofc. Roberson until he completed Strachan's probable cause affidavit, at

On the stated date and time, I was dispatched to the incident location in reference to two shoplifters inside Dicks Sporting Goods. (WI) Michael Mohammed, the loss prevention agent (LPA) for Dick's, advised the two suspects, later identified as Lou'Quinn Zeigler and Jakira Strachan, were observed via floor and CCTV surveillance selecting merchandise from various sections of the store. Zeigler and Strachan were observed by LPA Mohhamed concealing the selected merchandise into a vans shopping bag. LPA Mohhamed stated both subjects worked in concert as they acted as look outs for each other while selecting and concealing the merchandise into the vans shopping bag. Both were in possession of the selected and concealed merchandise, thus depriving Dick's of it's property. They passed all points of sale together, making no attempt to pay for the selected and concealed merchandise.

It should be noted that Ofc. J. Honig, while working a mall lot detail, arrived on scene first. LPA Mohhamed, while with Ofc. Honig, identified Zeigler and Strachan upon passing all points of sale and exiting the store. Ofc. Honig (in full Class B uniform, with corresponding SPD insignia) made contact with both, at which point Zeigler and Strachan immediately fled on foot through the mall corridor. Ofc. Honig transmitted this over Sunrise PD Main channel. After a brief foot chase, Ofc. Honig was able to detain Strachan in the mall parking lot just behind Dicks Sporting Goods while Zeigler continued to flee on foot. (Please see Ofc. Honig's supplement for further.)

Ofc. Malave and I (both in Class B uniforms), in a parallel corridor, immediately exited the corridor upon hearing Ofc. Honig's radio transmission. Upon exiting, I observed Zeigler, matching the suspect description given (a B/M wearing a red shirt and red pants), running toward the Green Toad parking lot. Officer's gave Zeigler numerous loud, audible verbal commands to stop running, however he continued to run and entered into the driver's seat of a newer model Chrysler mini-van, bearing FL Tag: BWHB21. I then opened the passenger door as Zeigler was attempting to turn the vehicle on in an attempt to flee from officers. Once inside the vehicle I grabbed Zeigler's right arm as he was attempting to turn on the vehicle. Zeigler began to brace, push, and pull away from me while ignoring commands to stop resisting.

After pulling away from my grasp, Zeigler exited the driver's side door and again continued to flee on foot (westbound) through the parking lot. While in foot pursuit of Zeigler, Ofc. Malave deployed her department issued TASER, which made contact with and immediately subdued Zeigler. I then immediately attempted to place Zeigler into custody. He again resisted Officer's attempts to place him into custody. Zeigler continued to thrash his body, hide his arms underneath him and continuously push and pull away from Officers. Officers were ultimately able to place Zeigler into custody.

The recovered stolen merchandise was valued at a total of \$761.00. Michael desires prosecution on behalf of Dick's for the theft and as such Zeigler and Strachan were placed under arrest. Note: Ofc. Malave authored the PC affidavit for Zeigler.

Strachan's actions temporarily deprived Dicks Sporting Goods of its property. All merchandise was recovered. LPA Mohammed provided me with a sworn statement regarding the theft, and the property that was stolen and recovered. Based on the totality of the circumstances, I placed Strachan under arrest. Strachan was read Miranda from a pretext card, and advised she understood her rights and decided to speak with me regarding the incident. Strachan denied having any involvement in the theft and further denied selecting and concealing any clothing into the bag. Strachan advised she ran because Zeigler told her to run and she did not know what was happening.

Strachan was charged with grand theft while coordinating with others and resisting without violence. She was later transported to BSO Main Jail for processing.

The vehicle Zeigler was attempting to flee in, a newer model Chrysler mini-van, bearing FL Tag: BWHB21, was inventoried and

towed by Ofc. Honig. Inside the vehicle were numerous clothing items with the security sensors still attached. These items were seized and returned to the stores here at Sawgrass Mills. It should be noted that no receipts for these items were found in either Zeigler or Strachan's possession. Also located in the vehicle was cash, which was counted and verified by Sgt. Fernandez. I submitted the cash into SPD Evidence, as well as Zeigler's personal effects, such as his hat, cellphone, and Florida DL. Also located in the vehicle were multiple items of drug paraphernalia and suspected marijuana, which was submitted into SPD evidence for destruction.
