**Narrative**

On 10/24/2021 at approximately 20:44 hours, Sunrise Police Officers were dispatched to NW 91st Ln and NW 26th Pl, in reference to a suspicious incident where it was reported that multiple individuals were screaming at each other in front of a residence. While enroute, dispatch provided updates advising that the caller was now stating that they heard a possible gunshot coming from the incident location and a female screaming "bloody murder." Prior to Officer's arrival in the area, an additional 911 call was received from the involved female party confirming that her boyfriend and another involved male were actively engaged in a physical fight. The female told the call taker that her boyfriend was bleeding and that an intoxicated male was throwing rocks and pounding at their front door.

Upon arrival, Officers made a rapid approach due to the circumstances of the call. At this time, Officers encountered suspect Mark Waite. I drew my department issued Taser 7 and conducted a laser display towards the suspect, as other Officers provided lethal coverage. The suspect appeared to be bleeding from his face and had a running water hose in his hands on the side of the listed residence. Officers were wearing full Sunrise Police Road Patrol Uniforms and issued loud verbal commands for the suspect to walk towards us,

to which he refused. Other Officers and I then attempted to physically restrain the suspect. He immediately began to actively resist by tensing and pulling away from Officers who were trying to establish physical control. At this time, the suspect was taken to the ground. The suspect then braced both his arms underneath his stomach in an effort to avoid being placed in handcuffs. I proceeded to deliver several closed-fist distraction strikes to the right side of the suspects face in an attempt to stun him so Officers could pry his arms out from underneath him. Officers continued to issue loud verbal commands to the suspect who continued to resist Officers. I then delivered several strikes to the suspect's lower back in another attempt to gain compliance. After a brief struggle, Officers were able to place the suspect in hand restraints successfully. It should be noted that the suspect sustained lacerations to his face during a physical altercation prior to Police arrival. The suspect did not sustain injury from the strikes I delivered. Sunrise-Fire Rescue responded to the scene. After assessment, the suspect was transported to Plantation General Hospital by Officers for medical clearance.

I responded to 9181 NW 26th Pl in reference to a reported physical disturbance.

Upon arrival, myself and other officers contact with a male, later identified as (OF) Mark Waite, on the west side of the residence. Officers observed Waite to have a bloodied face and hands. It seemed that he was attempting to wash the blood off with a garden hose on the side of the house. Sgt. D. Rodriguez began to give loud, verbal commands to Waite to come toward officers. Waite disregarded Sgt. Rodriguez's commands. Officers then attempted to physically detain Waite. Waite then began to brace, tense and even pulled away as officers attempted to place on handcuffs. Officers then escorted the defendant to the ground where he continued to tense up and pinned his hands under his chest in an attempt to avoid being placed in handcuffs. The defendant continued to resist for approximately one minute but was eventually restrained and placed into handcuffs.

Contact was made with (IO) Austin Faulk who is the homeowner. Faulk stated Waite is a friend of his and they were drinking earlier in the night at his residence. Waite had consumed too much alcohol and was attempting to drive himself home. Faulk was trying to prevent Waite from driving at which point Waite became agitated. An argument ensued and Waite initiated a physical altercation with Faulk. Faulk defended himself and at some point received a laceration to his right hand. Sunrise fire rescue responded and treated Faulk on scene. Faulk wishes to not pursue charges.

Waite was then placed under arrest for crime of resisting officers w/o violence and transported to Plantation General Hospital for medical clearance. At the hospital, officers attempted to restrain Waite to a hospital bed after being in a wheel chair while medical exams were performed. While attempting to transition one of the handcuffs from Waite's hand to secure it on the hospital bed, Waite once again braced and tensed. It should be noted, at this time of transition, only one handcuff was on Waite. He then pushed forward forcefully with his arms and chest in an attempt to break away from officers' physical control. In fear of Waite breaking away and possibly attempting to flee, Ofc. C. Cubides performed a leg sweep to bring him to the ground to regain control. Once on the ground, Waite continued to tense up and pinned his hands under his chest to prevent officers from gaining control. Waite was successfully restrained once again shortly after.

Waite was then transported to BSO main jail for processing without further incident.

At this time, Officers encountered suspect Mark WAITE, a white male wearing a dark colored shirt, dark colored shorts and baseball hat. The suspect appeared to be bleeding from his face and had a running water hose in his hands on the side of the listed residence. Officers were wearing full Sunrise Police Road Patrol Uniforms. Officers issued loud verbal commands for the suspect to walk towards us, to which he refused. Other Officers and I then approached and attempted to physically detain the suspect. Once I grabbed the suspect's left arm, he immediately tensed his arm and tried to pull away from me. I proceeded to assist in taking the suspect to the ground. Once we were on the ground, I assumed a dominant full mount position on the suspect, while other Officers attempted to pry the suspect's arms from underneath him. I issued numerous loud verbal commands to the suspect to stop resisting. The suspect ignored my commands and continued to actively resist by bracing his arms underneath his stomach in an effort to prevent Officers from placing him in handcuffs. The suspect was eventually detained.

Later, I assisted in conducting a protective sweep of the involved residence and gathering information from parties on scene. This concludes my involvement in this case.



On the listed date and time, I responded as a back up officer. Upon arrival, I assisted officers in putting handcuffs on the defendant as he was actively resisting and pulling away from officers who were trying to detain the subject. I continued to observe the defendant trying to tuck his arm underneath his body to avoid handcuffs. After the subject was restrained, I assisted in placing the defendant inside my patrol vehicle which was the closest unit. Due to the defendant having injuries from the altercation, a decision for medical clearance was made. I transported the defendant to Plantation General Hospital to be medically cleared.


While at the hospital, Officers attempted to restrain the defendant to a hospital bed after being in a wheel chair while medical exams were being performed. Officers requested for the defendant to assist him self onto the hospital bed which he denied the order. Officers continued give commands but the defendant continued to disobey. While attempting to transition one of the handcuffs from the defendant's hand to secure it on the hospital bed, the defendant once again braced and tensed. It should be noted that at that time of transition, only one handcuff was on the defendant's right wrist. He then pushed forward forcefully with his chest and was observed trying to turn towards Ofc. K. Krohn in an aggressive manner and trying to break away of physical control of officers. In fear of the suspect breaking away and possibly fleeing or hurting other civilians or Ofc. Krohn, a takedown was performed to bring the defendant to the ground to regain physical control. Once on the ground, the defendant continued to actively resist by pulling his arms away until he was subdued and successfully restrained. Leg shackles were then applied. It should be noted that through the while at the hospital, the intoxicated defendant was belligerent not only towards Officers, but also the doctors, nurses, and other medical staff. The defendant was medically cleared and transported to BSO main jail for processing without further incident.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

Resisting Arrest W/O Violence

On 10/24/2021 at approximately 20:44 hours, I responded to the 9100 block of NW 26th Pl, in reference to a suspicious incident. Dispatch advised several individuals were screaming and fighting with each other in front of a residence. As other units responded, dispatched advised that the caller heard to what they believed was a gunshot. As I arrived on scene, we heard screaming coming from 9181 NW 26 Pl. As we walked towards the front of the house, we were directed by a neighbor to the side of the house, where we then encountered a white male, who was later identified as Mark Waite. Waite was bleeding from his face and was holding a running water hose. At this time I issued Waite clear and loud verbal commandos to walk towards officers, to no avail. Let it be known myself and other officers were wearing full Sunrise Police Road Patrol Uniforms with badge and police insignias. After Waite did not respond to our verbal commands, we approached him in tactical manner with both lethal and less lethal weapons. Once we were close enough to Waite, I attempted to guide him towards officers, at which time he immediately tensed his arm and tried to pull away from me. At this time, I assisted taking Waite to the ground. Once we were on the ground, I disengaged and provided cover to my officers as they attempted to place Waite in hand cuffs. Once Waite was placed in hand cuffs, he was properly secured in the back of a marked patrol unit, and had an officer monitoring him until Sunrise Rescue arrived on scene.

On 10/24/2021 at approximately 20:44 hours, Sunrise Police Officers were dispatched to NW 91st Ln and NW 26th Pl, in reference to a suspicious incident where it was reported that multiple individuals were screaming at each other in front of a residence. While enroute, dispatch provided updates advising that the caller was now stating that they heard a possible gunshot coming from the incident location and a female screaming "bloody murder." Prior to Officer's arrival in the area, an additional 911 call was received from the involved female party confirming that her boyfriend and another involved male were actively engaged in a physical fight. The female told the call taker that her boyfriend was bleeding and that an intoxicated male was throwing rocks and pounding at their front door.

Upon arrival, Officers made a rapid approach due to the circumstances of the call. At this time, Officers encountered suspect Mark Waite. I drew my department issued Taser 7 and conducted a laser display towards the suspect, as other Officers provided lethal coverage. The suspect appeared to be bleeding from his face and had a running water hose in his hands on the side of the listed residence. Officers were wearing full Sunrise Police Road Patrol Uniforms and issued loud verbal commands for the suspect to walk towards us, to which he refused. Other Officers and I then attempted to physically restrain the suspect. He immediately began to actively resist by tensing and pulling away from Officers who were trying to establish physical control. At this time, the suspect was taken to the ground. The suspect then braced both his arms underneath his stomach in an effort to avoid being placed in handcuffs. I proceeded to deliver several closed-fist distraction strikes to the right side of the suspects face in an attempt to stun him so Officers could pry his arms out from underneath him. Officers continued to issue loud verbal commands to the suspect who continued to resist Officers. I then delivered several strikes to the suspect's lower back in another attempt to gain compliance. After a brief struggle, Officers were able to place the suspect in hand restraints successfully. It should be noted that the suspect sustained lacerations to his face during a physical altercation prior to Police arrival. The suspect did not sustain injury from the strikes I delivered. Sunrise-Fire Rescue responded to the scene. After assessment, the suspect was transported to Plantation General Hospital by Officers for medical clearance.



Before me this date personally appeared KROHN, KYLE G. (3776) who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on 24 day of October, (year) 2021 at 9181 NW 26TH PL, SUNRISE, FL 33322 (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows:

bloodied face and hands. Officers began to give loud, verbal commands to the defendant to come toward officers. The defendant disregarded officers commands. Officers then attempted to go hands on with the defendant to gain control of him. The defendant then began to brace and tense as officers attempted to place on handcuffs. Officers then escorted the defendant to the ground where he continued to tense up and pinned his hands under his chest in an attempt to avoid being placed in handcuffs. The defendant continued to resist for approximately one minute but was eventually restrained and placed into handcuffs.

The defendant was then placed under arrest and transported to Plantation General Hospital for medical clearance. At the hospital, officers attempted to restrain the defendant to a hospital bed after being in a wheel chair while medical exams were performed. While attempting to transition the one of the handcuffs from the defendants hand to secure it on the hospital bed, the defendant once again braced and tensed. It should be noted, at this time of transition, only one handcuff was on the defendant. He then pushed forward forcefully with his chest in an attempt to break away from officers' physical control. In fear of the suspect breaking away and possibly attempting to flee, Ofc. C. Cubides performed a leg sweep to bring the defendant to the ground to regain control. Once on the ground, the defendant continued to tense up and pinned his hands under his chest to prevent officers from gaining control. The defendant was successfully restrained once again shortly after.

The defendant was then transported to BSO main jail for processing without further incident.
