



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE AND ELECTRONICS DISPOSAL

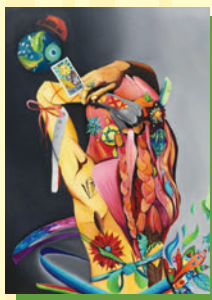
The City of Sunrise and the City of Plantation have partnered to provide residents with opportunities throughout the year to dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW) and electronics. These HHW drop-off events are free for residents of Sunrise and Plantation with **proof of residency**. Next up:

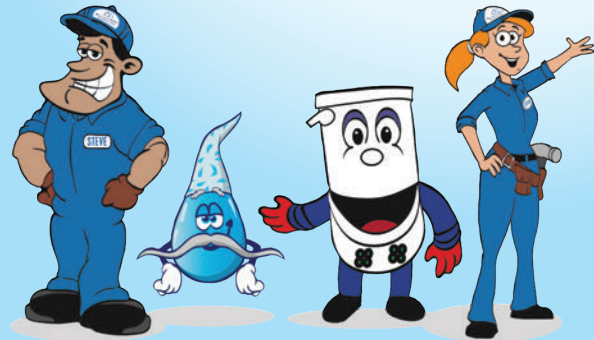
Keen on Conservation and Cash?
