

APRIL IS SAFE DIGGING MONTH Call 811 Before You Dig!

The City of Sunrise Gas Division reminds residents and contractors to make a free call to 811 at least three business days before digging to know what's below.

Every six minutes an underground utility line is damaged because someone decided to dig without first calling 811.

When calling 811, homeowners and contractors are connected to Florida's Sunshine State One-Call center, which notifies the appropriate utility companies of the intent to dig. Professional locators are then sent to the requested digging site to mark the approximate locations of underground lines with flags, spray paint or both. This service is FREE.

The cost of not calling can be steep: Striking a single line can cause injury, as well as cause the homeowner to incur repair costs, fines and inconvenient outages. Every digging project, no matter how large or small, warrants a call to 811. Installing a mailbox, building a deck, planting a tree and laying a patio are all examples of digging projects that require a call to 811 before starting.

The City's new Stunning Sunrise awards program is intended to recognize owners of single-family homes, townhomes, and businesses who take extra care to maintain their properties.

Well-maintained properties not only look great – they can also increase property values, inspire neighbors to maintain their property to higher standards, and help elevate the overall quality of life in our City.

WE'RE HONORED TO RECOGNIZE PROPERTY OWNERS IN THREE CATEGORIES:

STUNNING SUNRISE HOME AWARD

This award recognizes owner-occupied single-family homes and townhomes for upgrading and maintaining their front façade and landscaping; displaying uniqueness, beauty, appeal, and compliance with City standards; and demonstrating exceptional care and pride of ownership.

STUNNING SUNRISE BUSINESS AWARD

This award recognizes businesses for upgrading and maintaining their façade and landscaping; displaying uniqueness, beauty, appeal, and compliance with City standards; and demonstrating exceptional care and community pride.

STUNNING SUNRISE TRANSFORMATION AWARD

This award recognizes owner-occupied single-family homes and townhomes that have undergone exterior remodeling and/or landscaping improvements over the past three years that comply with City standards, demonstrating exceptional care and community pride. The improvements do not need to be expensive or elaborate; however, they substantially improve or enhance the overall property.

Homes and businesses must be within Sunrise city limits and meet other eligibility criteria to qualify for award consideration.

Winners will be selected quarterly by the City's Economic Development Advisory Board from a pool of nominees recommended by members of our community. All winners will be recognized at a City Commission Meeting and will receive a decorative yard sign and a gift card, and be featured on the City's website and social media.
