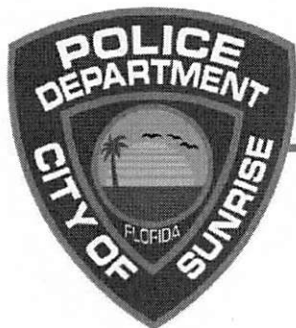

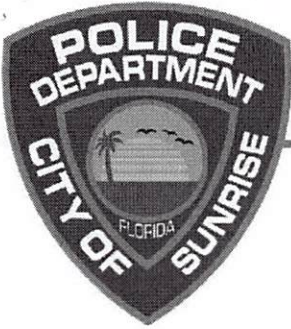

<p>On 12/13/21, I was posted on a traffic position as a back-up officer on a traffic homicide scene. During the course of the investigation, I heard OFC McCutcheon advise over police radio to 10-3 (hold radio traffic for emergency transmissions only) radio traffic. Shortly after, Ofc Morin's radio went into emergency distress signal and he stated that he had a subject resisting.</p> <p>I quickly responded to the incident location. Upon arrival, I observed Ofc McCutcheon and Ofc Morin attempting to subdue a black male on the ground. I observed the male continuously resisting by bracing, tensing and pulling. The suspect would not comply to officers countless verbal commands to stop resisting. The suspect continued to resist and was observed grabbing at his waist line.</p>

<p>I responded to 3600 N Pine Island Road at 0007hrs on 12/13/21 after Ofc B Morin activated his 10-24 button requesting emergency assistance. Shortly after this, Ofc B McCutcheon transmitted to 10-3 the air, indicating that the two were involved in a physical struggle.</p>		
<p>I arrived on scene shortly after and observed both officers struggling in a physical confrontation with a subject, later identified as Nicholas Johnson. Both officers were on the ground and I could see them wrestling with Johnson, attempting to gain control of his arms in order to place him in handcuffs. Despite officers' clear loud verbal commands to stop resisting and to give them his arms, I could see Johnson physically resisting them, clenching his arms underneath his chest, between his body and the ground. Additionally, Johnson was attempting to kick these officers.</p>		
<p>As I arrived, so did Ofc's R Rodriguez and K Krohn. Both of these officers also began to provide loud clear commands for Johnson to stop resisting, however these commands were ignored. I then observed Ofc Rodriguez and Ofc Krohn provide closed fist strikes to Johnson, while continuing to yell commands, in an</p>

effort to get Johnson to comply. Johnson continued to refuse.

I then moved to the right side of Johnson and could observe his hands clasped underneath his body. I also provided a command to stop resisting at which time I kicked Johnson one time in his right side / right arm. Through this effort, along with the efforts of Ofc's Krohn and Rodriguez, a grip was ultimately able to be established on Johnson's left hand. By removing Johnson's left hand from underneath his body, his right hand also became available shortly after, at which time Johnson was effectively placed in handcuffs.

It should be noted that Ofc's Morin and McCutcheon were initially investigating a domestic battery (42-2112-51125) when they made contact with Johnson. Johnson fit the description of the suspect of this investigation, and became confrontational when Ofc's Morin and McCutcheon attempted to speak with him.

I responded to 3700 N. Pine Island Rd. in reference to Officers' requesting for immediate assistance.		
<u>Upon this Officer's arrival, I observed Ofc. B. McCutcheon and Ofc. B. Morin struggling with a male on the ground. This Officer quickly moved in to assist with gaining control of the male. The male refused to comply with loud verbal commands from Officers' to stop resisting and continued to tuck his arms underneath his chest. This Officer then proceeded to deliver several closed-fist distraction strikes to the left side of the male's lower back in an attempt to gain compliance. The subject continued to brace and tense and proceeded to kick other Officers' on scene. This Officer then delivered an additional series of closed-fist distraction strikes to the back of the male's left, upper thigh area. Following the strikes, the male was able to be safely placed in handcuffs, ending the incident.</u>

Officers were conducting an active investigation involving a domestic physical disturbance (Sunrise case 42-2112-051125) at 3700 N Pine Island Rd. As a result of the physical altercation, the victim had to be transported to Westside Regional for a laceration to her nose and marks on her neck and chest area. A witness and involved other described the suspect as a bi-racial male wearing a purple hoodie and skinny pants. The suspect of the battery fled on foot northbound from the incident location. As I canvassed the area, I observed a male subject with a purple hoodie and skinny pants matching the exact description provided by the witness. The subject later identified as (OF) Nicholas Tyler Johnson was walking southbound from the area where the battery suspect had last been seen fleeing. As Officer Morin and I made our approach, I announced myself as Officer McCutcheon with the Sunrise Police Department and issued loud verbal commands for Johnson to walk towards us. It should be noted Officers were wearing full Sunrise Police Road Patrol Uniforms. Johnson continued to walk southbound on N Pine Island Road, ignoring officers' loud verbal commands. Officers reached Johnson, provided him with the information outlined above, and asked for his Identification.

Johnson stated "I don't have to give you shit." At this point, Johnson took a fighting position by balling up both of his fists and raising them in the air. Due to his aggressive actions and officers safety concerns, officers went hands on and attempted to subdue Johnson. He immediately began to actively resist by tensing and pulling away from Officers who were trying to establish physical control. At this time, Johnson was taken to the ground. Johnson then braced both his arms underneath his stomach in an effort to avoid being placed in handcuffs. Johnson continued to resist by tensing, pulling, and bracing. Johnson started to kick Officer Morin and attempted to grab him with his legs. Other officers arrived on the scene and it took the physical efforts of another four officers to subdue Johnson and stop him from physically fighting. Johnson never complied with lawful commands to stop resisting and was only placed in custody due to the physical efforts of all officers on scene. Johnson was then placed under arrest for Resisting an Officer- With Violence. Sunrise-Fire Rescue 59 responded to the scene and transported Johnson to Florida Medical Center for medical clearance for intake. Johnson was then transported to BSO Jail and released to the custody of Corrections Deputies.

On 12/13/21, I was posted on a traffic position as a back-up officer on a traffic homicide scene. During the course of the investigation, I heard OFC McCutcheon advise over police radio to 10-3 (hold radio traffic for emergency transmissions only) radio traffic. Shortly after, Ofc Morin's radio went into emergency distress signal and he stated that he had a subject resisting.

I quickly responded to the incident location. Upon arrival I observed Ofc McCutcheon and Ofc Morin attempting to subdue a black male on the ground. I observed the male continuously resisting by bracing, tensing and pulling. The suspect would not comply to officers countless verbal commands to stop resisting. The suspect continued to resist and was observed grabbing at his waist line.

I gave multiple verbal commands to the suspect to place his hands behind his back, to which the suspect did not comply. I conducted closed fist strikes to his face to gain compliance. The suspect began to comply and the strikes were stopped. The suspect stopped resisting and officers were able to handcuff the suspect and take him into custody.

It should be noted that my BWC was not active during this incident. When this incident occurred, my overhead lights were already activated while on the previous call, and I was responding urgently to help officers on scene. Due to the nature of the call I did not have adequate time to activate my BWC.

On 12/12/2021, I responded to 3700 N Pine Island Rd. [REDACTED] located in the Sunrise Springs Condominiums complex, in reference to the report of a battery that had just occurred. (Ref Case 42-2112-051125)

It should be noted that when being initially dispatched to this incident, the suspect description was provided of a 20-year old bi-racial male last seen wearing a purple hoodie, which was documented by the call-taker in the CAD notes.

As a result of the investigation on scene, probable cause was established for the arrest of the suspect involved on the charge of felony battery, however, he had fled from the scene on foot nothbound along N Pine Island Rd. The description of the suspect was confirmed by Ofc. McCutcheon as was provided to dispatch and it was added that the suspect was also wearing tight pants.

Upon concluding the on scene investigation and preparing to circulate the area for the suspect, a male was observed walking southbound on the sidewalk from the north passing directly in front of the Sunrise Springs Condominiums complex wearing a purple hoodie, tight pants, with the hood up over his head. The male appeared to be in his early 20s and was of slender build. SNPD Ofc. McCutcheon (3780) and I attempted to obtain the subject's attention from a distance but he continued walking southbound on the sidewalk.

Having established reasonable suspicion to detain the subject due to having matched the suspect description of the felony battery, Ofc. McCutcheon and I caught up to the subject at approximately the 3600 block on N Pine Island Rd. to initiate an investigatory stop. It should be noted Ofc. McCutcheon and I were dressed on our department issued City of Sunrise Police class B uniforms and were making contact in a well lit area where we were easily identifiable as law enforcement officers. I proceeded to obtain the subject's attention by tapping him on the left shoulder to which he reacted by spinning around to face us, balling up his fists, raising his arms to about chest level, and assuming a fighting stance. I took control of the subject's right arm while Ofc. McCutchen took control of the subject's left arm. It should be noted the subject's arms were tensed throughout the encounter.

Ofc. McCutcheon and I asked the subject numerous times to provide his name and notified him several times that he perfectly matched the description of a suspect we were looking for. The subject persistently refused to identify himself, stating "No, I'm not telling you my name, for what?", "Let me go", and "What's going on". Throughout the initial encounter, the subject had his cellphone gripped in his right hand and began recording the audio on his personal device. Having raised the level of suspicion by refusing to identify himself, the decision was made to detain the subject in handcuffs pending his identification.

At that time, the subject began pushing and pulling to free himself in an attempt to flee. A struggle ensued in an attempt to escort the subject to the ground. The subject persistently stated, "I ain't do nothing wrong" and "Y'all not finna put me on the fuckin floor dawg". During the course of the struggle, Ofc. McCutcheon was able to advise over the radio to stop all radio transmissions (10-3 the air). Once on the ground, I pinned the subject's right arm/right side of his torso to the ground while Ofc. McCutcheon pinned the left side.

The subject continued his resistance, having kicked/kneed Ofc. McCutcheon and I several times, and wrapped his legs around my lower torso on several occasions as if he were attempting to mount himself on top of me. All the while, the subject repeatedly stated, "Let me go bruh", "I aint do shit wrong bruh", and also stated, "Y'all see this shit?! I ain't do shit wrong, and y'all come up and grab me for no fuckin reason!" The subject had yet to simply provide his name in order to identify himself.

I had the ability to activate the emergency distress signal (10-24 activation) from my department issued bluetooth microphone which notified other officers to make an expedited response to our location (code 3). Ofc. McCutcheon and I kept the subject pinned to the ground until the arrival of other officers. It took the abilities of all officers that responded to overpower the subject using compliance tactics and ultimately detain him in handcuffs. It was not until that point that the subject finally identified himself as Nicholas Johnson, which was confirmed by FL ID that was in his possession throughout the encounter.

Nicholas was taken into custody by Ofc. McCutcheon and charged with Resist Officer - Obstruct w/ Violence. Nicholas was transported by Sunrise Rescue 59 to Florida Medical Center for medical clearance prior to being transported to BSO Main Jail.

I responded to 3700 N. Pine Island Rd. in reference to officers requesting for immediate assistance.

Upon my arrival, I observed Ofc. B. McCutcheon and Ofc. B. Morin struggling with a male on the ground. I quickly moved in to assist with gaining control of the male. The male refused to comply with loud verbal commands from officers to stop resisting and continued to tuck his arms underneath his chest. I then proceeded to deliver ten (10) closed-fist distraction strikes to the left side of the male's lower back in an attempt to gain compliance. The subject continued to brace and tense and proceeded to kick other officers on scene. I then delivered an additional three (3) closed-fist distraction strikes to the back of the male's left, upper thigh area. Following the strikes, the male was able to be safely placed in handcuffs, ending the incident.


I completed and submitted a Response to Resistance Report.

No further action.

I responded to 3600 N Pine Island Road at 0007hrs on 12/13/21 after Ofc B Morin activated his 10-24 button requesting emergency assistance. Shortly after this, Ofc B McCutcheon transmitted to 10-3 the air, indicating that the two were involved in a physical struggle.

I arrived on scene shortly after and observed both officers struggling in a physical confrontation with a subject, later identified as Nicholas Johnson. Both officers were on the ground and I could see them wrestling with Johnson, attempting to gain control of his arms in order to place him in handcuffs. Despite officers` clear loud verbal commands to stop resisting and to give them his arms, I could see Johnson physically resisting them, clenching his arms underneath his chest, between his body and the ground. Additionally, Johnson was attempting to kick these officers.

As I arrived, so did Ofc`s R Rodriguez and K Krohn. Both of these officers also began to provide loud clear commands for Johnson to stop resisting, however these commands were ignored. I then observed Ofc Rodriguez and Ofc Krohn provide closed fist strikes to Johnson, while continuing to yell commands, in an effort to get Johnson to comply. Johnson continued to refuse.

I then moved to the right side of Johnson and could observe his hands clasped underneath his body. I also provided a command to stop resisting. Johnson refused to comply with this command as well, at which time I kicked Johnson one time in his right side / right arm. Through this effort, along with the efforts of Ofc`s Krohn and Rodriguez, a grip was ultimately able to be established on Johnson`s left hand. By removing Johnson`s left hand from underneath his body, his right hand also became available shortly after, at which time Johnson was effectively placed in handcuffs.

This concluded my involvement in this incident.
