#### **Old Business**

#### Past Events-

- Tunes & Trucks The March 11<sup>th</sup> concert featured country and rock music performed by The Samantha Russell Band. Approximately 1,500 people attended the event.
- Lyrical Lounge Due to Spring Break 2022, a smaller group than usual (six teens) attended the March 18<sup>th</sup> event.
- Lakeside Park Grand Opening About 100 people attended the ceremony at the small passive park at Sunrise Lakes Phase I. Residents have responded favorably to the new addition to the area.
- Earth Day- Approximately 1,200 bags were given away at the event. Feedback was positive. Attendees enjoyed the interactions with the vendors responsible for stamping the passports.

## Cultural Festival-

- Talent Show Board members were asked for input regarding the talent show (number of categories, registration, performer guidelines, etc.). Talent show winners will perform at the Cultural Festival.
   Discussion followed. Kevin Pickard stated that he would bring all suggestions back to staff to finalize the parameters.
- Live Art Board members unanimously agreed to move forward with the idea of artists creating large
  letters that spell out S\_U\_N\_R\_S\_E during the festival. The letters, with a person filling in as the letter
  "I", will be used at future events.
