<p>On February 23, 2022 I responded to 3622 NW 82ND AV in reference to a vehicle burglary. Upon arrival, I met with the primary officer who advised a witness observed an unknown black male burglarizing his neighbors vehicle. The witness then asked the unknown male what he was doing inside of the vehicle to which he fled the area on foot. Further investigation resulted in making contact with the victim who desired prosecution.</p> <p>Based on the above information, I deployed K-9 Hakon in an attempt to locate the outstanding suspect. During my search, I was notified by the BSO Aviation Unit that a male matching the description of the outstanding suspect (later identified as Uziel Castillo) was walking southbound in front of 2834 N University Dr. (Skyline Chili). Both myself and additional units responded to the above listed location and attempted to make contact with the Castillo. Upon attempting contact with Castillo, he proceeded to flee eastbound through the plaza, ignoring numerous loud verbal commands to surrender himself.</p>

<p>Castillo continued to flee eastbound behind 2850 N Sunrise Lakes Dr. While fleeing, Castillo was observed by Davie K-9 Ofc. R. Shannon discarding a blue in color backpack (SEE DAVIE PD REPORT) Further investigation of the contents of the backpack revealed a loaded, black in color, Taurus 9mm handgun with a 30 round extended magazine, inside of it. This information was provided over Sunrise Police Dispatch notifying officers Castillo may still be armed.</p>	
<p>Based on the above information coupled with Castillo actively fleeing into a residential neighborhood while in possession of a firearm, it was determined he posed an immediate threat to the safety of the surrounding community. I deployed K-9 Hakon to search for Castillo. During my search, Castillo was located on the 2nd floor of 2850 N Sunrise Lakes Dr. As I was walking upstairs to the 2nd floor to attempt contact with Castillo, he proceeded to conceal himself behind a wall hindering my ability to see him. I issued multiple loud verbal commands to "COME OUT TO ME, SHOW ME YOUR HANDS!" Castillo verbally resisted my commands and refused to reveal himself to me. **NARRATIVE**

On February 23, 2022, at approximately 2245 hours, Sunrise PD K-9 Officers requested my assistance at 3636 NW 82nd Ave. in Sunrise regarding a burglary that just occurred.

Upon arrival on scene, I was informed the suspect was a black male in his late teens to early 20s last seen wearing a gray hoodie. As Sunrise K-9 officers searched, a suspect matching the description was observed southbound on N. University Dr.

I responded to the 2700 block of N. University Dr. where I observed several Sunrise officers giving verbal commands to the suspect in an attempt to detain him. The suspect initially acted compliant and began to get down on his knees. He then suddenly jumped back to his feet and fled from officers eastbound through the plaza.

I drove to the rear of the plaza and observed the suspect continue running eastbound into an apartment complex along the 2700 block of Sunrise Lakes Dr. W. I continued following behind him in my marked police vehicle with overhead lights activated as he ran behind the apartment buildings and continued fleeing northbound. While following behind him, I gave several announcements to stop running and get on the ground. At the rear of the apartment building at 2750 Sunrise Lakes Dr. W., he threw a blue bag in an apparent attempt to throw it in the lake.

He continued running as I continued giving commands for him to stop and get on the ground. He suddenly stopped to the rear of the 2800 block of Sunrise Lakes Dr. W. where he dropped to his knees and raised his hands once again. I exit my marked police vehicle drew my service weapon and commanded him to the ground again. After several commands, he again jumped to his feet and began fleeing northbound from me where I lost visual of him around apartment buildings.

I communicated to Sunrise K-9 Ofc. E. Plunkse where I last saw the suspect running. I then returned to where he threw the bag. I retrieved the bag on the lakeshore which contained a loaded Taurus 9mm handgun, a loaded extended handgun magazine, and what appeared to be a bag of cannabis. I relayed the information over the radio to officers still in search of the suspect. I maintained my position until the suspect was taken into custody by Sunrise K-9.

After the suspect was apprehended, I transferred custody of the bag (containing the firearm) to Sunrise Ofc. M. Ryan (#3786). Sunrise PD Case # 42-22-02-007943.

While investigating a vehicle burglary (Case #42-2202-007943) the suspect that fled the area on foot was said to be a black male wearing a gray hoodie and black pants. Sunrise officers and Davie K9 responded to the area. Sunrise Lt. Gordon advised that he observed a black male wearing a gray hoodie, green shorts, and a blue book bag walking in the median of N University Drive. The BSO Aviation Unit also advised the same individual was "walking with a purpose". Lt. Gordon made contact with the suspect around the 2600 block of University Drive at which time he fled eastbound into an occupied residential building located in Sunrise Lakes Phase 1. A perimeter was quickly established. The BSO Aviation Unit, Sunrise K9, and Davie K9 responded to search for the suspect. As the suspect continued fleeing on foot to a residential area (Sunrise Lakes), Davie K9 Ofc. Shannon advised over the police radio that the unknown subject threw the blue book bag he was carrying, attempting to discard and conceal the book bag. The book bag was immediately recovered by Davie K9 Ofc. Shannon (Davie Case #22-016760) and a loaded black Taurus PT 24/7 DS 9mm handgun (Serial #TCX47020), a green leafy substance (Field-tested positive with NIK Test Kit), and rolling papers (drug paraphernalia used to roll and smoke cannabis). Ofc. Shannon transferred the bag with its contents to Sunrise Ofc. Ryan. The subject was later apprehended by K9 Officers (See their supplement for additional information).

The subject was then identified as (OF) Uziel Castillo (05/11/2006). A show-up was conducted with the witness from the original vehicle burglary. A Show-up form was completed, the witness was transported to the Sunrise Lakes location, and was uncertain if he was the subject who committed the vehicle burglary.

Castillo was then transported to Coral Springs Medical Center for medical clearance due to K9 contact. Sunrise Fire-Rescue transported Castillo from the scene to the hospital. Post Miranda, which was read via prepared text by myself, Castillo stated h

Based on Castillo`s actions and statements, he was arrested and advised of his charges.

He was later medically cleared with minor injuries and transported to JAC by Ofc. Wong without incident.

The firearm, Marijuana, and rolling papers were entered into evidence by Ofc. Ryan ( See Supplement). Photographs were taken and uploaded to the Axon evidence server. The witness show-up form was turned into Sunrise Records.

### PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

Before me this day personally appeared DELEON, PAUL (3794) who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on the 24 day of February, 2022 at 2800 W SUNRISE LAKES DR, SUNRISE, FL 33322 above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause believe same are as follows:

While investigating an in-progress vehicle burglary, the defendant matched the description of the possible suspect, who was said to be a black male wearing a gray hoodie and black pants. The defendant was observed walking in the median along University Drive wearing a gray hoodie and green shorts, which is in the proximity and time of the vehicle burglary. As Lt. Gordon & other Officers were dressed in Sunrise Police Uniforms, they attempted to make contact with the defendant at which time he immediately fled on foot into a nearby shopping plaza. As several additional officers responded, including Sunrise and the City of Davie PD K9 units, the defendant continued to flee, ignoring verbal commands to stop. As the defendant continued to flee into a residential apartment area (Sunrise Lakes), a Davie K9 officer observed the defendant intentionally discard and conceal the blue stringed book bag. The book bag was immediately retrieved and a loaded black Taurus PT 24/7 DS 9mm handgun with an extended magazine containing 18 9mm rounds was located inside, along with rolling papers and 1.9 grams of marijuana (Field-tested positive with NIK Test Kit). Sunrise K9 Ofc. Plunске also responded and apprehended the defendant at 2830 Sunrise Lakes Drive. Post Miranda, the defendant stated
