****BWC IN USE****

On 01/18/22, I responded to 2915 NW 60th Av in reference to a call of a suspicious person. According to the anonymous caller, there was an unknown person who was later identified as Edsonne Jaochin that attempted to sell narcotics to his daughter. The caller additionally stated that the subject was sitting in a white Chevy Equinox and has a handgun on his waistband. The caller stated that the subject has been known to threaten kids in the nearby area with the firearm.

As Officers arrived on scene they made contact with Edsonne standing by a white Chevy Equinox on the northside of the parking lot. As Officers attempted to conduct an investigatory stop Edsonne immediately raised his hands up in the air which revealed a firearm to be tucked in his waistband. Officer [REDACTED] and Officer [REDACTED] attempted to detain Edsonne for a weapons patdown but were immediately met with physical resistance (refer to Officer [REDACTED] supplement for further). As Officers were attempting to gain control Edsonne was actively pushing and tensing in an attempt to physically resist detention. I then arrived on scene and began to assist Officers in detaining the defendant when Officer [REDACTED] shouted "he`s got a gun!" I then observed a black handgun in Edsonne`s waistband and removed it immediately for officer safety concerns. [REDACTED] then arrived on scene and began to assist Officer [REDACTED] and Officer [REDACTED] in detaining Edsonne while I secured the firearm.

At this point, the defendant was still actively resisting and was able to free himself from the grip of officers. As the defendant was attempting to flee, he pushed [REDACTED] causing her to fall to the ground and strike her head against the asphalt. Edsonne then continued to flee on foot and Officer [REDACTED] and I continued to follow behind him. As we were chasing behind Edsonne, Officer [REDACTED] and I continually issued loud verbal commands to stop. Edsonne disregarded our commands and continued to run away from officers. Officer [REDACTED] ultimately had to deploy his department-issued Taser to gain compliance from Edsonne (refer to Officer [REDACTED] supplement for further). I then immediately took Edsonne into custody.

Edsonne was found to be in possession of a Sig Sauer P250 with ten 40mm rounds loaded into the magazine. A records check of Edsonne revealed that he does not possess a concealed firearm license. The firearm was ran through NCIC/FCIC with yeilded negative results for stolen/wanted.

Edsonne was read Miranda Warning via department-issued card in which he waived desiring to speak to officers. Edsonne stated that [REDACTED] Edsonne stated that approximately one year ago he [REDACTED] Edsonne also admitted [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] had a large swollen area on the top of her head as a result of being pushed to the ground. [REDACTED] was transported by Sunrise Fire Rescue to Cleveland Clinic for medical treatment.

I then made contact with Charles Appolon (WI) who was a witness to the incident that just occurred. Sunrise Detectives responded to the scene took a sworn statement from Charles and also interviewed Edsonne. It should be noted that Charles's account of events was consistent with Officers' observations. Sunrise Crime Scene also responded to the scene and took overall photos. Crime scene collected The firearm along with the ammunition and the Taser Cartridges. Refer to the crime scene report for further details.

A reocrds check of the white Chevy Equinox previously described by the anonymous caller revealed Edsonne to be the registered owner. The vehicle was towed by Westway Towing and an inventory search was conducted. Refer to Officer [REDACTED] supplement for further details on the towing of the vehicle.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, Edsonne's actions and statements taken on scene probable cause was developed and Edsonne was placed under arrest and transported to BSO Main Jail after receiving medical treatment for the Taser deployment.

On 01/18/2022, I responded to 2915 NW 60th Av reference a male selling narcotics in the neighborhood. Dispatch advised the male was driving a white, Chevrolet Equinox and carrying a firearm on his waistband. Upon my arrival, I observed the aforementioned vehicle that matched the description given by dispatch on the north end of the parking lot. At least 4 males were observed around the vehicle. Ofc. [REDACTED] and I approached the males, and I noticed a black male later identified as Edsonne Joachin (6/6/1994) with a gun holster clipped onto the front of his waistband. Based on the nature of the call and officer safety, Ofc. [REDACTED] and I ordered Edsonne to drop the cigarette that was in his hand, and for him to have his hands raised above his head. When approaching Edsonne to detain him, Edsonne took off on foot trying to flee northbound. Edsonne was immediately apprehended by Ofc. [REDACTED] and I. I trapped Edsonne's arms above his head, while Ofc. Pincus arrived and retrieved the firearm from his waistband.

While attempting to place handcuffs on Edsonne for arrest, Edsonne began to tense, brace, and forcefully pull from officers to avoid being handcuffed. As Edsonne fled southbound, he forcefully pushed [REDACTED] causing her to fall and hit her head on the pavement.

While chasing Edsonne southbound through the parking lot, I gave him verbal orders to stop running and warned him that he would be tased. Edsonne disobeyed orders and continued fleeing southbound. I withdrew my department issued taser, and deployed it towards Edsonne, but I only made contact with 1 probe. I deployed my second cartridge making contact which caused him to lose motor functions and fall to the ground. Both taser probes made contact on his upper left and lower left back area.

Edsonne was subsequently handcuffed by Ofc. Pincus. Other than the taser probe punctures, Edsonne did not suffer any injuries.

Sunrise Rescue 39 responded and transported [REDACTED] to Cleveland Clinic for a head injury. Sunrise Rescue 59 Responded and transported Edsonne to Florida Medical Center for medical clearance. After being medically cleared, I transported Edsonne to the Sunrise Police East Substation, where custody was handed over to Ofc. Pincus for transport to Main Jail.

On 01/18/22 at approximately 12:50 pm I responded to 2901 NW 60th Ave as back up to Officer Pincus in reference to the sale of narcotics.

Upon arrival, Officer [REDACTED] and I saw the listed vehicle in question from the reporter located on the North East corner of the parking lot area.

Officer [REDACTED] and I approached the vehicle where 3 black male subjects were standing. I asked the subjects if the listed vehicle was theirs, which all the subjects replied "No sir".

Officer [REDACTED] alerted me to the defendant, who was later identified as EDSONNE JOAHIN, carrying a firearm in his waistband.

I advised JOAHIN to place his arms above his head and don't move, which he complied. Once Officers went hands on with JOAHIN, he tensed, braced, and pushed officers away in an attempt to get away.

Officer [REDACTED] and I was able to grab JOAHIN to prevent him from fleeing [REDACTED] rushed over to assist, placing handcuffs on JOAHIN's left wrist. Officer Pincus rushed over and retrieve the firearm from JOAHIN's waistband and secure it. I attempted to place handcuffs on his right wrist.

Officer [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and I was detaining JOAHIN, when he struck [REDACTED] causing her to fall to the ground, pushed Officer [REDACTED] and I away from him and he was able to flee from us.

Officer [REDACTED] and Officer Pincus pursued the defendant for several yards and later apprehended. (SEE Officer [REDACTED] Supplement Report)

I remained with the vehicle and I conducted a record check of the license plate "NETP37" White Chevy Equinox, which belongs to JOAHIN.

Further investigation revealed JOAHIN did not reside at the listed location. An inventory search of the vehicle revealed a blue back pack containing several zip lock bags containing green leafy substance, which Crime Scene Investigator Smigelski removed the cannabis and placed it into evidence. The vehicle was towed to Westway tow yard.

I responded to 2915 NW 60 Ave (Boardwalk) reference to a suspicious person. A description of a black male next to a white Chevrolet Equinox, possibly armed, was selling drugs in the parking lot of the listed location. Ofc. [Redacted] and Ofc. [Redacted] made contact with the subject who attempted to flee but was detained. Ofc. [Redacted] advised Ofc, Pincus, also on scene, the subject had a concealed firearm in the waistband of his person. Ofc. Pincus removed the weapon at which time officers attempted to handcuff the subject, Edsonne Joachin. Joachin was up against a yellow truck and I was on the left side of him, but as Ofc. [Redacted] attempted to put the first handcuff on, Joachin responded by lifting his left arm away and hitting me in the chest with it. Joachin then pushed me to the ground, causing the back of my head to slam on the concrete parking lot. My left wrist also hit the ground, as it was still grabbing at Joachin's black shirt when he pushed me.

Joachin then fled southbound through the parking lot toward the entrance to building 2915 while Ofc. [Redacted] and Ofc. Pincus pursued close behind. I was able to gain my bearings, as I did not lose consciousness however, I was stunned for quite a bit. I was able to give out a description on the radio of Joachin and also requested Rescue for my injury. While waiting for Rescue, I was able to stand up and retreat to my marked police unit, at which time I saw Joachin being put in the back of another police unit, at which time he looked at me and said, "I am so sorry miss, I really am sorry."

As I entered the police vehicle to wait for Rescue, I felt the back of my head and realized there was a large softball sized bump forming. Sunrise Rescue transported me to Cleveland Clinic, where I was given a CATSCAN to determine if my skull was fractured or brain bleed had occurred. The scan showed negative for both but did show a large hemotoma had formed in the area where my head hit the pavement. I was discharged with instructions to watch for any symptoms or signs of a delayed concussion. I was also instructed not to return to Full Duty until seen by a neurologist to determine if any nerve damage had been caused as a result of the fall, which would be done at a later date.
