- Stacy S. made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting of Tuesday, April 12, 2022 with revisions. Dr. Gessika M. seconded the motion. There was no opposition from the EAB.

IV. Open Discussion: Updates/Announcements Regarding Schools

- Dr. Anelle M. inquired about the location of the *Summer Enrichment Program* and would like to know which Sunrise school is assigned to the program. Sady D. stated she would get the answer by the next meeting.
- Dr. Carolyn S. provided an update for Discovery Elementary. Discovery Elementary was approved for the <u>Cambridge AICE Diploma Program</u>. Dr. Carolyn S. also provided information on the *100 Club Induction Ceremony*. This ceremony highlights students which have made 100% on their checkpoint assessments in ELA, Math, and Science. 68% of the students were inducted into the club.
- Carolyn H. provided an update on Banyan Elementary. Carolyn H. was invited to the FSA Pep Rally which
 she was not able to attend, so she invited to ADM Guzman who was able to attend the event. Carolyn
 H. encouraged the EAB to reach out to Commissioners if they are unable to attend school events.

- Ingrid M. provided an update for Piper High School the school was recognized for participating in the Police Explorers program by the Sunrise Police Department.

- Natalia A. (EAB Vice Chair) provided an update for Horizon Elementary. Horizon Elementary is in the process of renovating their Media Center and coordinating a grand opening. The school is looking for a muralist to beautify the Media Center (supplies will be included). Dr. Anelle M. will send a contact to Sady D. (EAB Liaison).
- Erncy D. (EAB Chair) provided information on the new resolution passed by the City Commission to support autism/funding. Erncy D. has engaged with the HAAPE Foundation (Helping Autistic Adults Perform Excellence) an all-volunteer organization striving to improve the lives of young adults with autism and help find employment, through career pathways (technology, aviation, hospitality sectors etc....). The nonprofit is a 501(c)(3) that raises funds, in which 98% of funds raised are directed/allocated towards programming.
- Erncy D. (EAB Chair) also shared that Senate Bill 1054 Financial Literacy Instruction in Public Schools, passed the Florida Senate and House unanimously. He stated he met Laurie Rich Levinson (Broward County School Board Chair) at one of the EAB Meetings a few years ago and continued the connection. Erncy D. (EAB Chair) spoke with her and is scheduling a meeting to get the Charles Schwab Financial Literacy program (Schwab MoneyWise) as approved curriculum for BCPS students. He encouraged the EAB if they are passionate about an education issue to network and think creatively to tackle the challenge.
