<u>I responded to 6230 NW 18th Ct in reference to a physical domestic disturbance between a mother and her 17 year old child, involving rocks, knives and a wooden pole.</u>		
<u>On arrival I observed the subject holding a wooden pole in her right hand. I turned on my taser and pointed it in her direction and ordered her to put down the wooden pole. She complied after multiple commands were given and I holstered the taser. I ordered the subject to come to me with the intent to distance the subject from a knife on the ground and the wood pole. She refused my commands; therefore, Officer Thomas and I approached the subject to detain her. As I placed my hand on her left hand to detain the subject, she pulled away from me and jabbed her elbow in my direction. In response to her resistance, I guided the subject to the ground. While on the ground I utilized pain compliance techniques to gain control of the subject to place her in handcuffs. The subject did not suffer any injuries during this encounter.</u>		
<u>Once the subject was placed in handcuffs, [REDACTED] and I walked her to a patrol vehicle. While walking, the subject began to kick at the patrol car and twist her body in order to resist arrest.</u>

The subject kicked [REDACTED] in the leg, forcing me to conduct a leg sweep to gain control of the subject in order to place her in a hobble. While on the floor, the subject sustained an abrasion to her right knee, about the size of a quarter. The subject was then secured inside of my patrol vehicle. Sunrise Fire Rescue arrived on scene and the subject refused to be seen by Sunrise Fire Rescue. The subject was subsequently transported to BGH in my patrol vehicle. Pictures were taken of the injuries and submitted into Evidence. The subject was discharged from BGH with a scraped knee and did not suffer any further injuries.

It should be noted that the subject sustained a laceration on her face and a laceration on her chest prior to officers arrival.

On 4/22/2022, I was dispatched to 6230 NW 18th Ct, in reference a domestic disturbance involving a knife and a large wooden stick. Upon my arrival I observed a black female in the front yard of 6230 NW 18th Ct, who I later identified as Jakiria Riley. Jakiria was holding a large wooden stick above her head with an aggressive demeanor towards another black female. Officers gave multiple loud verbal commands to Jakiria to drop the stick, Jakiria then dropped the stick after multiple verbal commands. Upon approaching Jakiria to attempt to detain her, she tensed up and pushed as I grabbed her arm and continued to pull away from me. While attempting to gain control of the situation, Jakiria stated she was ready to fight all of the officers on scene while continuing to resist officers. Officers were able to gain control and detain Jakiria and place her in handcuffs. While attempting to put Jakiria inside a marked police patrol car, Jakiria continued to pull and twist and kick at officers until being placed in the marked patrol car. While in the back of the patrol car, Jakiria continued to kick her feet and scream while in custody.

I then made contact with an adult black female who I identified as Brenda Riley (Grandma) who is the legal guardian of Jakiria. Brenda stated she witnessed the entire incident unravel until the police arrived. Brenda advised that the incident started due to Jakiria disrespecting her biological mother who was identified as [REDACTED]. Brenda further advised that Jakiria began to argue with [REDACTED] about her attitude and that there was tension between the two. Brenda stated that [REDACTED] and Jakiria started to throw things at each other inside the house and proceeded to get into a verbal argument. [REDACTED] started to walk outside the house after the verbal argument started. As [REDACTED] walked outside, Jakiria followed her outside and grabbed a rock from the floor and threw it at [REDACTED] striking her in the back of the head. After [REDACTED] was hit in the head with a rock, she pulled out a knife from her purse and displayed it. On 04/22/2022 I was dispatched to 6230 NW 18th Ct in reference to a physical domestic disturbance between a mother and her 17 year old child. According to dispatch, the fight was escalated when a knife and wooden pole were being used.

I arrived on scene and saw (OF) Jakira Riley holding a wooden pole near her mother (VI) [REDACTED] I activated my taser and pointed it at Jakira. I ordered her to drop the pole which she did after commands were given. I ordered Jakira to come to me in order to distance her from the knife and pole, which she refused. Officer Thomas and I approached Jakira in order to detain her. I grabbed her left arm and she pulled away from me then jabbed her elbow in my direction. In response to her resistance I guided Jakira to the ground. I utilized pain compliance techniques in order to place Jakira in handcuffs. During this encounter, Jakira did not suffer any injuries.

Once Jakira was in handcuffs, I lifted her off the ground and walked her toward a patrol vehicle to pace her inside. While walking to the vehicle, Jakira abruptly kicked and began to pull away. At one point she kicked [REDACTED] who was assisting me with detaining Jakira. I conducted a leg sweep and guided Jakira to the ground in order to place hobbles around her legs. While on the ground, Jakira suffered a quarter size abrasion to her right knee. She was placed in my patrol vehicle and was seen by Sunrise Fire Rescue. Jakira refused to cooperate with Sunrise Fire Rescue. I took pictures of the injury to her knee.

Prior to officers arrival, Jakira sustained a laceration to her upper chest and a laceration to the left side of her face. I took pictures of these injuries and submitted them into evidence.

I transported Jakira to BGH. She was tended to by staff at the hospital and did not sustain any further injuries other than the previously stated injuries.

Jakira was discharged from the hospital and transported to JAC.

I responded to 6230 NW 18TH CT as a back up Officer. When I arrived on scene I observed Jakiria holding a long wooden stick which was dropped after Officers made commands to Jakiria to drop it. Officers Maristany and Thomas attempted to handcuff Jakaria when she began to pull her arms away and resist. Jakiria was escorted to the ground where I assisted in attempting to gain control of Jakirias right arm to place her under arrest. Jakiria continued to resist by bracing, tensing, and pulling her arms away until she was successfully placed into handcuffs.

While walking Jakiria to place her in a marked patrol vehicle she attempted to kick one of the patrol vehicles. Jakiria was escorted to the ground again. Jakiria began kicking and I placed my knee on the back of her leg to gain control of her legs to prevent being kicked. Jakaira looked at me and stated "let me out of these cuffs, let me out of these cuffs so me and you can fight, I wanna fight let me out of these cuffs so me and you can fight".

Jakiria was then placed in hobbles by Officer Maristany. Jakiria was assisted to her feet then walked to Officer Maristany's marked patrol vehicle. I read Jakiria Miranda from my department issued Miranda card. Jakiria did not respond when I asked her if she wanted to talk or not.

[REDACTED] (Jakiria's biological mother) was placed under arrest for trespass (see my original report case #42-2204-016769). [REDACTED] was checked out by Sunrise Fire Rescue on scene. I read [REDACTED] Miranda from my department issued Miranda card to which she stated she wanted to talk. [REDACTED] stated she was hit in the back of the head by Jakiria with a rock. Jakiria had a lump on the back and side of her head (above her left ear). [REDACTED] stated she grabbed a knife out of self-defense but never used it.

I transported [REDACTED] to BSO Main Jail for trespassing under case #42-2204-016769 without any incident.

I observed [REDACTED] on scene, who I could identify as the biological mother of Jakiria and I knew she was trespassed from the property. I advised Ofc. Thomas that she needed to be detained for trespassing on the property which led to her detainment.

On 04/22/2022, Officer J. Thomas arrested the Jakiria Riley in reference to an aggravate battery. I was assigned this case for further follow-up.

After conducting a complete review of this investigation, it was determined that taped statements were necessary from both the witness and victim. I attempted to contact the witness, Brenda Riley (954-826-6143), in reference to the incident, but was met with negative results. A voicemail was left with my contact information. Although I was unable to make contact with Brenda, Officer Larin's Body Worn Camera footage uploaded on Apr 22, 2022 6:32 PM, revealed all witnesses giving their account of the incident prior to the arrival of Sunrise Police. This includes Brenda Riley stating she did wish to prosecute against [REDACTED] on behalf of Jakiria Riley.

[REDACTED] was released from BSO main jail on 04/30/2022. I attempted to contact her by phone (954-754-2347) on 05/22/2022, but was met with negative results as that phone number is disconnected. At this time, she does not have an established residence. [REDACTED] also refused to provide a statement after being read Miranda rights the day of the incident which was captured on Body Worn Camera.

All the necessary documents for case filling to include all officer supplements have been submitted to Evidence.com. It should be noted that this case is also related to Sunrise Police Department case 42-2204-016769. A copy of that case has also been submitted with this case file.

This case is CLEARED BY ARREST and will be sent to the State Attorney's Office for Final Review and Disposition.
