**Narrative**

Sunrise Officers responded to [redacted] reference to a report of a physical domestic disturbance, with one of the parties (later identified as Brian Edward O'Neill) making threats of suicide. Upon arrival, contact was made with the subject's mother who advised Sunrise Officers that after a physical altercation with Brian, he grabbed his black pistol and made suicidal threats. His mother further advised Brian was intoxicated and was last seen going into his room while still in possession of the pistol. It was determined that Brian was still inside the home at the time and upon noticing Sunrise Officers outside of his house, Brian decided to step out the front door. Upon acknowledging Sunrise Officers, Brian walked back inside his house. With the use of a PA, Sunrise Officers called Brian back out of the house at which time he complied and walked out the front door.

As Brian exited the house, he was being given clear direct instructions to keep his hands in the air and walk towards Sunrise Officers positioned east of his home on [redacted]. As he got closer and was being instructed to turn around and drop down to one knee, Brian started to become combative and refused to follow the verbal commands being given to him by Sunrise Officers. At one point, lower his left hand and reaching

Sunrise Officers approached Brian on foot and assisted him to the ground, and he was detained.

During the take-down to the ground, Brian suffered a small laceration above the right eye and bruising on the right cheek from his skin making contact with the pavement.

Brian was transported to Florida Medical Center were he received treatment for his injuries and was [REDACTED]

Sunrise Officers responded to [redacted] reference to a report of a physical domestic disturbance, with one of the parties (later identified as Brian Edward O'Neill) making threats of suicide. Upon arrival, contact was made with the subject's mother, [redacted] who stated to Sunrise Officers that after a physical altercation with Brian, he grabbed his black pistol and made suicidal threats. She further advised that during the argument, Brian grabbed her by the hands and pulled them behind her back. She claims while doing this, Brian stated "if you call the cops, you will go down first." Each time [redacted] spoke about the physical altercation that took place, she would point at the clearly visible bruising on her left forearm near her elbow.

[redacted] advised Brian was intoxicated and was last seen going into his room while still in possession of the pistol. It was determined that Brian was still inside the home at the time and upon noticing Sunrise Officers outside of his house, Brian decided to step out the front door. Upon acknowledging Sunrise Officers, Brian walked back inside his house. With the use of a PA, Sunrise Officers called Brian back out of the house at which time he complied and walked out the front door.

As Brian exited the house, he was being given clear direct instructions to keep his hands in the air and walk towards Sunrise Officers positioned east of his home on [redacted]. As he got closer and was being instructed to turn around and drop down to one knee, Brian started to become combative and refused to follow the verbal commands being given to him by Sunrise Officers. At one point, Brian lowered his left hand and reached underneath his shirt into his waste-band. Sunrise Officers approached Brian on foot and assisted him to the ground, and he was detained.

During the take-down to the ground, Brian suffered a small laceration above the right eye and bruising on the right cheek from his skin making contact with the pavement.

<p>Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a domestic battery on a person over 65, with the suspect making suicidal threats. After the victim's initial call for service, a second call was received, stating that the suspect, Brian Edward O'neill, armed himself with a firearm and ammunition, and threatened he would "take all of you down", referring to responding officers.</p>			
<p>The victim's age was known to this officer due to my prior interactions with the family on previous calls for service. Upon arrival, the victim, [REDACTED] and her other adult son were called out of the home, and over to our staging location. [REDACTED] informed officers that Brian was intoxicated with alcohol, that he committed a simple battery upon her, that he made suicidal threats, and that he made veiled homicidal threats toward her.</p>			
<p>[REDACTED] advised that today was Brian's birthday, and that he told her today was his birthday and also going to be his death day. [REDACTED] stated that prior to her being called out of the home, Brian was last seen going into his bedroom with a small black firearm still in his possession.</p>

### Narrative - continued

Due to the circumstances of the call, the decision was made to bring the Sunrise Police BearCat to the scene to use for cover. While maneuvering the BearCat into position, Brian briefly walked outside and was given loud verbal commands to keep his hands raised and walk to the road. Brian ignored the commands, went back inside, and closed the door. Using the public address system on the BearCat, loud verbal commands were given for Brian to again step outside, which he did. Once outside, Brian was given more loud verbal commands to keep his hands raised, and walk back to where officers were positioned, down the street to the east of the residence.





While walking toward officers, Brian continually lowered his hands, took a puff from an electronic cigarette, refused to get on the ground, and lowered his left hand toward his waist, appearing to reach under his shirt. It was at this time when officers made a fast approach behind the cover of a ballistic shield, and an open-hand shove was utilized to offset Brian's balance, and we then escorted Brian to the pavement.

Due to Brian refusing to follow commands, it was unknown if he had the handgun concealed on his person at the time of the take down, making swift and decisive action absolutely necessary.

While being taken into custody, Brian continually braced and tensed his arms in an attempt to resist officers' efforts to detain him. As a result of Brian's resistance, he sustained a small laceration above his right eye, and a minor abrasion on his right cheek, from his face coming into contact with the pavement.

On 04/16/2022, at approximately 19:35 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] Sunrise, Florida 33322, in reference to [REDACTED] (VI), stating that her adult son, Brian O`neill (OF), was intoxicated with alcohol, that he struck her, and that he was threatening to kill himself. Additionally, the caller`s husband, [REDACTED] (IO - who was not on scene), also called police and advised that Brian armed himself with a handgun and ammunition, and that he threatened he would "take all of you down".

Upon arrival, contact was made with [REDACTED] and her other adult son, [REDACTED] (IO), down the street to the east of the residence. [REDACTED] stated he did not witness the altercation, but did hear a loud verbal altercation between his mother and brother. [REDACTED] stated that Brian had been drinking alcohol since yesterday, 04/15/2022, and that he told her today was his birthday and also going to be his death day. [REDACTED] stated that Brian somehow gained access to a small black handgun that was locked in a safe, and was recklessly waving it around while intoxicated. [REDACTED] stated that Brian then grabbed her by her arms, held her arms behind her back, and told her that if she called police she would be the first person to go down. [REDACTED] stated that Brian was last seen going into his bedroom, with the firearm still in his possession.

When asked if Brian threatened her with the firearm, [REDACTED] said no. When asked if Brian was still armed with the firearm when he grabbed her arms, [REDACTED] again said no. While speaking to [REDACTED] I observed dark purple contusions on her left arm. I pointed to the bruises on [REDACTED] arm, asked if they were the result of Brian grabbing her, and she said yes. It should be noted, [REDACTED] years old, admitted to consuming alcohol today, and has crepey skin (skin that is thin and looks finely wrinkled like crepe paper, and noticeably more fragile and thin). These combined factors made it feasible to believe that the bruises I observed on [REDACTED] arm were in fact caused by Brian grabbing her.

Due to the circumstances of the call, the decision was made to bring the Sunrise Police BearCat to the scene to use for cover. While maneuvering the BearCat into position, Brian briefly walked outside and was given loud verbal commands to keep his hands raised and walk to the road. Brian ignored the commands, went back inside, and closed the door. Using the public address system on the BearCat, loud verbal commands were given for Brian to again step outside, which he did. Once outside, Brian was given more loud verbal commands to keep his hands raised, and walk back to where officers were positioned, down the street to the east of the residence.

While walking toward officers, Brian continually lowered his hands, took a puff from an electronic cigarette, refused to get on the ground, and lowered his left hand toward his waist, appearing to reach under his shirt. It was at this time when officers made a fast approach behind the cover of a ballistic shield, and an open-hand shove was utilized to offset Brian`s balance, and we then escorted Brian to the pavement. Due to Brian refusing to follow commands, it was unknown if he had the handgun concealed on his person at the time of the take down, making swift and decisive action absolutely necessary.

While being taken into custody, Brian continually braced and tensed his arms in an attempt to resist officers` efforts

to detain him. As a result of Brian's resistance, he sustained a small laceration above his right eye, and a minor abrasion on his right cheek, from his face coming into contact with the pavement.

While securing Brian in the prisoner compartment of Ofc. Morin's marked Sunrise Police vehicle, I detected a strong odor of alcoholic beverage emanating from his person. Once seated inside the vehicle, I read Brian his Miranda rights via prepared text, which he stated he understood. I then stood by with Brian while officers conducted a protective sweep of the residence, finding no one else inside. Sgt. McGovern notified Sunrise CIS, who advised they would be responding out. While I remained at the incident location, Brian was transported to the Sunrise Police Department, where he spoke to detectives (see supplements).

After speaking to detectives, Brian was transported to Florida Medical Center to address his injuries. SPD CIS Sgt. L. Fernandez, Detective K. Fernandez, and Detective J. Duvall then responded to the incident location, where I briefed them on the call. I was later advised by Detective Duvall that [REDACTED] signed a Sunrise Police consent to enter and search form, and that 6 firearms and assorted live ammunition were recovered from the residence by Ofc. P. Hormann (see supplements). Detective Duvall further advised that [REDACTED] recanted her original statements as to how she sustained the contusions on her arm, telling him that she fell while visiting her husband at the hospital. Detective Duvall stated he would follow up with the state attorney's office on Monday, 04/18/2022, to see if any criminal charges would be filed.

While being medically cleared at the hospital, Brian told Officer M. Deweese that he wanted officers to fill him with lead, meaning he wanted officers to shoot and kill him. Based on my training and experience, my personal interactions with the family during previous calls for service, and combined with my observations on this day, it is this officer's opinion that without immediate medical attention, Brian poses a serious risk of injury or death to both himself and others. I responded to Florida Medical Center, documented Brian's injuries with my department-issued tablet, and Brian was then released to the care and custody of hospital staff, along with my completed [REDACTED] form.

Upon returning to the police department, I assisted Officer Hormann with entering the seized firearms and ammunition into SPD Evidence, completed a Response to Resistance Report and an RPO packet, and uploaded the photos of Brian's injuries to Evidence.com.

Under penalties of perjury I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
