**Narrative**

On 3/28/2022 I came into contact with a subject, Wyatt A. Yeager who was involved in multiple felonies involving a firearm. Shortly before I came into contact with Wyatt, Sunrise Road Patrol Officers made contact with two victims who provided the following information.

The Victims were traveling on W. Sunrise Blvd when they observed a pink Mercedes SUV (FL Tag 28AIXX) stopped in the middle of the road. They engaged in a verbal argument with the driver who they described as a skinny white male with a blonde mullet and tattoos (later identified as Wyatt Yeager). [redacted] pulled into the Chik-Eil-A parking lot (12600 W. Sunrise Blvd) and were aggressively followed by Wyatt. The argument continued outside of the vehicles when Wyatt pulled out a handgun and pointed it at both [redacted] while continuing to make threats. As [redacted] were attempting to leave the scene in their vehicle, Wyatt approached [redacted] from behind and hit him in the back of the head with the handgun, creating a swollen hematoma. It should be noted there is an independent witness to the entire incident who provided a statement on scene to Officers, corroborating the victim's allegations.

**Narrative - continued**

Wyatt fled the scene in his pink Mercedes causing other drivers on the road to call 911 due to his erratic and aggressive driving.

At 1905 hours, Wyatt called 911 and stated he was at NW 11th Ct. and Silver Palm Blvd and that he has the gun in his car.

Detective Duvall and I located Wyatt's Pink Mercedes parked inside the garage at his residence in Weston. He got in the vehicle shortly thereafter and a felony stop was conducted in conjunction with BSO Weston.

During the traffic stop, he refused commands to place his hands outside the window of the vehicle after being instructed to do so multiple times. Instead he continued to reach around in the vehicle and stated "yall don't know who I am?" After exiting the vehicle, he also refused commands to lay down on the ground to which he replied "I know my rights." He then leaned back into the vehicle where the firearm was located and continued to ignore commands. Wyatt eventually came back out of the vehicle with his cell phone and stated he was going to call his lawyer. Based on the fact that Wyatt was uncooperative with commands and the high likelihood of a firearm being inside the vehicle within arms reach, a decision was made to approach Wyatt and attempt to take him into custody.

An opportunity presented itself to take Wyatt into custody once he stepped out of the vehicle for the second time so I walked toward him from behind, guided his body to the ground and he was successfully taken into custody. Wyatt sustained an abrasion above his left eye as a result of the arrest and refused medical treatment.

A consensual search of the vehicle was conducted and a black and silver handgun was located in the glove compartment that matched the description provided by the victims. It should be noted the firearm had one round in the chamber, was in arms reach of the driver and was ready for immediate use.

It should be noted that while attempting to adjust Wyatt's handcuffs at the Sunrise PSB, he became combative and kicked [REDACTED] in the upper thigh. He resisted our attempts to place him back into the Police vehicle and was uncooperative once again. Due to his combative nature, Wyatt was transported straight to BSO Main Jail in lieu of medical clearance.

The entire Police encounter with Wyatt was captured on BWC and uploaded to Evidence.com.

On March 28, 2022 around 1849 hours I started receiving calls about a white male driver in a pink Mercedes SUV. The first call (case#12887) was from an anonymous caller stating a pink Mercedes SUV was driving recklessly in the parking lot of Chik-fil-A at 12600 W Sunrise Blvd, almost hitting other cars. The caller left no contact information.

At the same time a second call came in from [REDACTED] and his father [REDACTED]. Both men were in their vehicle (silver pickup truck) when they observed a pink Mercedes SUV stopped in the middle of Sunrise Blvd. [REDACTED] stated he tried to yell to the driver to move his vehicle, at which point the driver (later identified as Wyatt Yeager) became irate and the two argued verbally. [REDACTED] stated he pulled into the parking lot of Chik-fil-A at 12600 W Sunrise Blvd and Wyatt followed him. Right after they pulled in the lot, Wyatt threw a drink and a Chik-fil-A bag at [REDACTED]'s car. [REDACTED] stated he and [REDACTED] exited their vehicle and Wyatt exited his vehicle. The three men argued verbally, and during this argument Wyatt stated he had a gun.

[REDACTED] stated that Wyatt then went back to the pink Mercedes and took a black gun out of the glove box. He says Wyatt pointed the gun at his face and threatened him. [REDACTED] stated that Wyatt also pointed the gun directly into his face in a threatening manner. Both men stated they were in fear when Wyatt pointed the gun at them. [REDACTED] said he turned to leave the area and Wyatt rushed up behind him and struck him in the back of his head, close to his ear, with the gun. [REDACTED] got back into their vehicle and attempted to leave, but Wyatt continued to follow them around the parking lot recklessly. Eventually Wyatt left, heading westbound on W Sunrise Blvd.

[REDACTED] had some video after the incident of the pink Mercedes leaving the area, and the tag (28A IXX) is clearly visible. [REDACTED] also had a clearly visible bloody lump on his head from the pistol strike. He refused rescue on scene. [REDACTED] both advised they wish to pursue charges against Wyatt.

Around 1851 hours I received another call from a man called Ivan (754-715-2882) stating that he was at W Sunrise Blvd and NW 136th Av. He observed a white male with long blonde hair and tattoo driving a pink Mercedes SUV recklessly. He stated he saw this male harassing an elderly woman in a vehicle and was "hitting" her car. After the male fled westbound, Ivan told dispatch he asked the woman if she was okay and she said she was afraid. She left the area without leaving contact information or contacting PD herself.

Then around 1856 hours Wyatt called 911 himself. He stated to dispatch that men in a silver pickup truck were "brake checking" him, then they stopped in front of his vehicle and he almost hit him. In the call to dispatch Wyatt said he had a gun in his glove box with a lock and key. He told dispatch that he showed the men in the pickup his gun and they left him alone. He then changed his story and said he never showed them the gun. Wyatt then became uncooperative with dispatch, refusing to give a location of where he was. He began cursing out the dispatchers and refused to give any other information.

While I was on scene talking to [REDACTED] units circulated the area looking for Wyatt and the pink SUV. While talking to [REDACTED] I was approached by another man, Roberto Cobucci. Roberto doesn't know [REDACTED] or

Wyatt. He stated he was in the parking lot when the incident occurred and he observed the whole thing. He stated he saw Wyatt point a gun at both men and stated he saw Wyatt strike [REDACTED] on the head with the gun. He then started recording after the hit and showed me video of Wyatt driving recklessly around the Chik-fil-A parking lot attempting to chase down [REDACTED] vehicle. In this video at one point the pink Mercedes drives right by Roberto with the windows down and there is a clear view of Wyatt in the driver's seat. Both Roberto and [REDACTED] were sent evidence.com links to upload the video they took along with any photos.

I put out a BOLO on the radio for the pink Mercedes (which was bearing a FL tag 28A IXX). Through this tag it was discovered the vehicle might be registered to Wyatt Yeagar, who matched the physical description given by the victims and witness. It was discovered that Wyatt might have an address in Weston at 204 Cameron Dr. I contacted Sunrise Police Teletype requesting an AOA with BSO Weston to see if they could drive by and see if the Mercedes was there.

At the same time I contacted Wyatt via telephone. I stated that I wanted to talk to him about the incident that occurred and asked him to tell me his location so I could meet with him. He then asked for my personal cell phone number and when I refused to give it to him, he refused to give me his location.

Sunrise Police Detectives A. McMahon and J. Duvall drove by the residence at 204 Cameron Dr. and saw the pink Mercedes in front of the house. Along with Sgt. R. Morlock and Ofc. A.J. Romero, I responded to the residence. While waiting for a BSO Weston unit to meet with us, Detectives Duvall and McMahon saw Wyatt enter the pink Mercedes and start driving out of the area. At that point we conducted a felony stop on the vehicle.

As soon as the vehicle got close, I recognized Wyatt as the driver from the video Roberto showed me. He also fully matched the description given by all of the callers and the victims. Wyatt was uncooperative and did not exit the vehicle upon command. He also did not show his hands upon multiple commands. I could see Wyatt looking around inside his vehicle for something, ignoring commands to show his hands and exit the vehicle. Wyatt then pulled out his phone and let us know he was recording. After several more commands, he did exit the vehicle. He was commanded multiple times to lay down on the ground which he ignored and continued to play with his phone. At this point he was approached from behind by Detectives Duvall and McMahon and taken to the ground. See their supplements for further information. While being taken to the ground Wyatt suffered some small abrasions on his face and hands/arms. Wyatt refused rescue on scene and stated he did not want to go the hospital.

He was read Miranda by Ofc. McMahon which he understood and waived. Post Miranda he admitted to getting in to an altercation with "some hillbilly men" but he did not give any other information. He did agree to let us search his vehicle and stated there would be a gun in the car. A search of the vehicle showed an unlocked and opened glove box with a black handgun inside. There was no sign of a lockbox or key, the gun was in the open. Detectives McMahon and Duvall took possession of the firearm. See their supplements for further.

Wyatt was taken in to custody around 2054 hours. Due to the time delay between initially talking to [REDACTED] and tracking down and taking Wyatt into custody, I was unable to do a show-up with the victims. However, I recognized Wyatt from the videos where I could clearly see his face.

Wyatt was transported back to Sunrise PD. While at the PD he moved his handcuffs from the back to the front. When he was removed from the vehicle to fix the handcuffs, Wyatt became very upset. He started pulling away once the cuffs were off. While trying to put the cuffs back on, Wyatt was trying to pull his arms away, making it very difficult to get them back on. When the handcuffs were back on, he resisted getting back into the vehicle. As he was

Supplement: Resisting w/out Violence, Battery LEO

On 3/28/22 at 2217hrs Ofc Ellis and Sgt Morlock were completing arrest paperwork in reference to the listed case in preparation to transport Wyatt Yeager to BSO Main Jail. I observed Sgt Morlock in the report writing area when I began to have a conversation with him about topics unrelated to the listed case. Sgt Morlock then walked outside to provide Ofc Ellis with paperwork that had just printed and I followed Sgt Morlock outside, continuing our conversation. Due to the fact that I was not involved in this investigation, was not planning on having communication with Yeager and met Sgt Morlock by chance in the report writing area before accompanying him outside for purposes that were not causing or intended to cause me to be engaged in patrol or field activities, I was not wearing my BWC at the time I walked outside, into the secure parking lot.

At 22:19:25 (according to Ofc Ellis' BWC) Ofc Ellis and Sgt Morlock discussed whether she should transport Yeager's jewelry with him to BSO Jail, or if it should remain at the Sunrise Police Department for safekeeping. The decision was made to keep the jewelry at the Sunrise Police Department and Ofc Ellis advised that she would return in a minute to remove Yeager's jewelry and to change the handcuffs that he was wearing. Ofc Ellis returned at 22:20:39. During the time that Ofc Ellis was away from Yeager, he remained inside her patrol vehicle. Sgt Morlock and I remained approximately 8 feet away from Ofc Ellis' vehicle. During this time, we continued to quietly continue our previous, unrelated conversation. None of this conversation was in regards to Yeager, no part of the conversation was directed towards him, and there was no exchange of dialogue between Yeager and myself or Sgt Morlock.

At 22:20:50 Ofc Ellis went back inside for additional paperwork / items and returned at 22:23:43. During this time, there was no change and Sgt Morlock and I continued our unrelated conversation, which we can be observed having when Ofc Ellis returns.

At 22:24:25 Ofc Ellis asked Yeager to come out of the vehicle and it was explained to him that his handcuffs were going to be changed and that his jewelry was going to be taken for safekeeping so that there were no issues with it at BSO Jail. Yeager then became confrontational / argumentative and walked away from Ofc Ellis when she was trying to remove his handcuffs and jewelry. Ofc Ellis remained calm with Yeager, continuing to explain to him that she was going to take his jewelry for safekeeping. At this time, Yeager advised Ofc Ellis that she was a "bitch" and a "cunt" and it was determined that his jewelry would remain with him.

Ofc Ellis then removed Yeager's handcuffs, to replace them with her own handcuffs. After Yeager's handcuffs were removed, he began walking away from Ofc Ellis who was able to maintain control. As Ofc Ellis was placing handcuffs

on Yeager, he moved his right arm away and began pointing at Sgt Morlock, while attempting to insult officers present. I then began to instruct Yeager to not move his arm away again however before I could finish this command, Yeager pointed his right arm at me, stating "shut up" in a defiant manner. I then took a hold of Yeager's left, handcuffed hand. Yeager immediately tensed his body and pulled his right hand away from Ofc Ellis at which time I pushed Yeager into the side of Ofc Ellis's patrol vehicle, to assist in gaining leverage on Yeager who was continuing to pull his right hand away from Ofc Ellis. Commands were then given to Yeager to stop resisting, however he continued to tense his body and pull his right arm up and away from his left hand, making it difficult for the other handcuff to be placed on his right hand.

After the second handcuff was placed on Yeager, he continued to tense and move his body, making it difficult for Ofc Ellis to double lock his handcuffs. Yeager then began to complain that the actions in response to his resistance were going to damage his "\$80,000 necklace," part of the same jewelry which he previously refused to allow us to remove and place in evidence for safekeeping for him, and part of the same collective jewelry that he was wearing that he previously stated was worth between \$30,000 and \$40,000.

Once the handcuffs were successfully applied, Yeager was escorted to the back seat of Ofc Ellis' patrol vehicle. Yeager was then told to sit in the vehicle at which time he replied "I aint gonna sit down in no fuckin car," pushed himself backwards away from the vehicle and pulled his arms away from Ofc Ellis' and my grasp. This caused me to have to forcefully push Yeager into the backseat of the vehicle.

Once Yeager was seated in the back of Ofc Ellis' patrol vehicle, he immediately turned his body, facing outwards. Yeager then aggressively and intentionally kicked me with his left foot and yelled "get the fuck off me," although at this moment neither Ofc Ellis nor I were touching Yeager whatsoever. Yeager's kick with his left foot struck me in the upper joint area of my left knee, contacting my knee and thigh.

At this time, Yeager was secured in the back of Ofc Ellis' patrol vehicle. Yeager was subsequently charged with resisting an officer without violence, and battery on a law enforcement officer.

Although I initially responded outside with Sgt Morlock for unrelated purposes, where I did not intend on being engaged in patrol or other field activities, I did become involved in this incident when Yeager became confrontational with Ofc Ellis. At this time, retrieving my BWC would have been unsafe, impossible or impractical, therefore my interaction with Yeager was not captured on my BWC, however it was captured on Ofc Ellis' BWC. After Yeager was secured in the back of Ofc Ellis' patrol vehicle, the first reasonable opportunity to begin recording with my BWC was presented at which time I retrieved my BWC and recorded the remainder of any interaction with Yeager, concluding upon his transport to BSO Jail.

On 3/28/2022 I was notified by Sgt. Morlock to respond to 12600 W. Sunrise Blvd. to assist with an ongoing Aggravated Battery investigation.

The Victims [redacted] were traveling on W. Sunrise Blvd when they observed a pink Mercedes SUV (FL Tag 28A1XX) stopped in the middle of the road. They engaged in a verbal argument with the driver who they described as a skinny white male with a blonde mullet and tattoos (later identified as Wyatt Yeager) [redacted] pulled into the Chik-Fil-A parking lot (12600 W. Sunrise Blvd) and were aggressively followed by Wyatt. The argument continued outside of the vehicles when Wyatt pulled out a handgun and pointed it at both [redacted] while continuing to make threats. A [redacted] were attempting to leave the scene in their vehicle, Wyatt approached [redacted] from behind and hit him in the back of the head with the handgun, creating a swollen hematoma. It should be noted there is an independent witness to the entire incident who provided a statement on scene to Officers, corroborating the victim's allegations. Wyatt fled the scene in his pink Mercedes.

It should be noted that four different 911 calls were placed by other citizens during this incident due to Wyatt's erratic and aggressive driving.

At 1905 hours, Wyatt called 911 and stated he was at NW 11th Ct. and Silver Palm Blvd and that he has the gun in his car, then he got defensive and hung up.

All 911 calls were uploaded to Evidence.com.

Detective Duvall and I located Wyatt's Pink Mercedes parked inside the garage at his residence in Weston (204 Cameron Dr.). He got in the vehicle shortly thereafter and a felony stop was conducted in conjunction with BSO Weston.

During the traffic stop, Wyatt refused commands to place his hands outside the window of the vehicle after being instructed to do so multiple times. Instead he continued to reach around in the vehicle and stated "yall don't know who I am?" After exiting the vehicle, he refused commands to lay down on the ground to which he replied "I know my rights." He then leaned back into the vehicle where the firearm was located and continued to ignore commands. Wyatt eventually came back out of the vehicle with his cell phone and stated he was going to call his lawyer. Based on the

fact that Wyatt was uncooperative with commands and the high likelihood of a firearm being inside the vehicle within arm's reach, a decision was made to approach Wyatt and attempt to take him into custody.

An opportunity presented itself to take Wyatt into custody once he stepped out of the vehicle for the second time so I walked toward him from behind, guided his body to the ground and he was successfully taken into custody. Wyatt sustained an abrasion above his left eye and a bloody nose as a result of the arrest and refused medical treatment.

A consensual search of the vehicle was conducted where a black and silver handgun (SCCY Serial #C145601) was located in the glove compartment that matched the description provided by the victims. It should be noted the firearm had one round in the chamber and was ready for immediate use. The firearm was submitted to evidence.

Wyatt was transported back to the Sunrise PSB by Officer Ellis.

Prior to being transported to BSO Main Jail, Wyatt had moved his handcuffs in front of his body. Officer Ellis and [redacted] removed him from the vehicle to fix the handcuffs when he became irate and started pulling away. He resisted getting back into the police car and ultimately kicked out his legs striking [redacted] in the upper thigh. Due to his combative nature, Wyatt was transported straight to BSO Main Jail in lieu of medical clearance.

Officer Ellis completed the original Offense / Incident Report and [redacted] completed a supplement with further details regarding their involvement.

Wyatt Yeager was charged with two counts of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, one count of Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon, Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer, and resisting without violence.







I had no further involvement in this case.


