BEWARE OF Hidden Water Dangers



Water safety is a common concern in South Florida, where we're surrounded by bodies of water. Although many are aware of the drowning dangers associated with unsecured swimming pools, there are other hazards that are often overlooked: water visibility and depth. These are among the most treacherous hidden risks related to lakes and canals.

Waterways in the City of Sunrise have varying shoreline slopes and depth, which means that some may have a steep, sudden drop-off and some may be shallower than expected. Rocks beneath the surface, animals such as snakes or alligators, as well as underwater vegetation add to the need to proceed with extreme caution. For your safety, never dive head-first into water of unknown depth.

IT'S EASY TO REGISTER FOR LEISURE SERVICES PROGRAMS!

The Leisure Services Department offers extended hours for in-person program registration. Sunrise residents may register for programs at the front desk of the Civic Center Athletic Club during normal business hours: weekdays from 6:30 am to 9:00 pm, and weekends from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm. Residents also have the option of registering online at www.sunrisefl.gov. To access this free, convenient service - available 24 hours a day – residents must have a household number as well as a Visa, Discover, MasterCard, or AmericanExpress for payment. Of course, registration by mail or fax – as well as in-person registration at the Leisure Services office – is still available.

School is out and our **summer camp** program is in full swing! Sunrise kids are enjoying enriching and educational activities – including museum field trips, swim days, arts and crafts projects and STEM workshops. With all the fun they're having, the campers may not realize they're learning, too. However, it's important to keep students engaged in order to avoid the "summer slide" – a loss of knowledge in reading and math that can happen during the school break.

SUNRISE RECEIVES \$2 MILLION FOR UTILITY INFRASTRUCTURE

In April, the City of Sunrise announced the receipt of **\$2 million in federal funding** – part of \$15 million secured through the efforts of Congresswoman Debbie Wasserman Schultz for several high-priority South Florida projects.

The funds allocated to Sunrise will be used to replace an aging City of Sunrise Utilities Department pump that manages stormwater and provides flood protection to thousands of acres of residents and businesses, including those in neighboring communities in western Broward County.

"Stormwater Pump Station #8 was nearing the end of its useful life, and Congresswoman Schultz was tremendously vigilant in helping Sunrise replace it so we can continue to reliably serve the neighborhoods and businesses that depend on our Utility infrastructure," said Sunrise Mayor Michael J. Ryan. "These funds – and the hardware they will secure – provide peace of mind to the greater Sunrise community."

We're also looking forward to the return of **Sunrise ComicCon**, happening on August 13th at the Civic Center. This amazing, family-friendly event continues to expand and excite! If you're a fan of superheroes, sci-fi and other pop culture entertainment, you'll want to participate. Make sure you purchase your tickets early, however; prices go up on August 7th!

Get To Know Your Sunrise City Commission

The City of Sunrise operates under a Commission/Manager form of government. The Sunrise City Commission, which is comprised of a Mayor and four Commissioners, is the legislative and policy-making body of the City, responsible for approving the budget and providing strategic direction to staff. The City Commission appoints the City Manager, City Attorney, City Clerk, Police Chief, Fire Chief, and members of City boards and committees.

The Mayor and City Commissioners are each elected at-large on a non-partisan basis and serve four-year terms. The City Commission represents the public interest; promotes prompt, courteous responses to citizen problems and concerns; provides clear leadership and direction; and assures the present and future fiscal integrity of the City.

The Sunrise City Commission is dedicated to serving the broad needs of the community. The Mayor and Commissioners provide careful and responsible judgment in the exercise of legislative duties, with the clear understanding that they are the people's representatives in setting policies and in determining levels and priorities of programs and expenditures.



Mayor Michael J. Ryan

Michael J. Ryan was elected Mayor of Sunrise in August 2010, and returned to office without opposition in 2012, 2016 and 2020. He earned a B.B.A., majoring in Finance, from The George Washington University, and a Juris Doctorate, summa cum laude, from The Case Western Reserve University School of Law.

Mayor Ryan has long been an active resident of the City of Sunrise. Mayor Ryan served as a PTA President for two years and as an Executive Board Officer for an additional two years with the Sawgrass Elementary PTA; a volunteer coach over many years for youth soccer, baseball and flag football; volunteer coach for high school varsity girls soccer team; and two terms as Chair of the Education Advisory Board for the City of Sunrise.

In addition, Mayor Ryan is an appointed member of the Broward County Regional Planning Council; chair (and prior vice-chair) of the Broward County Consolidated Communications Committee (regional emergency 911 communications); co-chair of the Communications Working Group for Strengthening Police-Community Relations; past chair and past vice-chair of the Public Safety Committee for the Broward League of Cities; past co-chair of the Broward County League of Cities' Joint School Resource Officers Task Force; current co-chair of the Broward League of Cities' School and Community Public Safety Taskforce; and, a current member of the Broward County

Chiefs of Police Association Committee on Domestic Violence Injunction Process. He is an elected member of the Florida League of Mayors (2016-present) as well as a member of the Florida League of Cities' Transportation and Intergovernmental Relations Committee.

Mayor Ryan has received awards for his work in the community, and is a frequent author regarding matters of public importance. His work promoting scholastic and community based chess initiatives has been the subject of local, national and international news coverage. Mayor Ryan's efforts, along with that of the City Commission and City staff, led to the City of Sunrise earning the national title of "Chess City 2015" by the United States Chess Federation and the development of the Sunrise Center for Excellence in Chess. In 2014, celebrating his roots that go back to Ireland and his status as first generation American, Mike was named "Irishman of the Year" by the Emerald Society of Fort Lauderdale.

Mayor Ryan is also a lawyer and partner in the law firm of Freedman Harwin Valori Ryan in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. In 2019, Mayor Ryan was awarded the Broward County Bar Association's "Walter G. 'Skip' Campbell, Jr. Lawyer-Public Servant Award." Aside from his successful law practice, Mayor Ryan has been an active force in the lives of many in our community. He has served as a member of the Board of Directors and Secretary to the Board for Women in Distress for Broward County. His charitable works include running marathons for charity, helping gather goods and supplies to assist Haiti after the January 2010 earthquake, traveling to Haiti to volunteer after the earthquake, traveling overseas to volunteer at a U.S.O. Wounded Warrior Center, and a 900-mile bike ride to benefit, among others, wounded soldiers and their families.



Deputy Mayor Jacqueline A. Guzman

Jacqueline A. Guzman was elected to the Sunrise City Commission in November of 2020. Deputy Mayor Guzman made Sunrise election history with close to 20,000 votes and is the first Hispanic (Puerto Rican) female elected in Sunrise. ¡Muchas gracias por tu apoyo!

Deputy Mayor Guzman was born in Brooklyn, New York and has been raising her family in the City of Sunrise for almost 15 years. She attended Piper High School her freshman year and was raised in a Sunrise church during her teen years. Her three children attend Sunrise public schools and are active in Sunrise sports.

Deputy Mayor Guzman graduated in 2016 with her Associate's Degree in Healthcare from Las Vegas College in Nevada, and continued her education in Substance Abuse and Addictions Counseling.

Deputy Mayor Guzman is a two-time heart attack survivor which led her on her journey as a local spokeswoman with The American Heart Association from 2012 to 2014. For 10 years, she continues to spread awareness and currently serves as a Board Member.

Deputy Mayor Guzman and her children have volunteered with numerous organizations such as HandsOn Broward, YMCA, Habitat for Humanity, Ronald McDonald House and more. She has organized fundraisers for Jose's Hope 4 the Homeless, The American Heart

Association, Kids in Distress and Voices for Children.

Deputy Mayor Guzman has been an active member of her community with the following organizations: American Heart Association Board Member, HandsOn Broward Board Member, ESE School Board Committee Member, Child Advocate with the Guardian ad Litem Program, appointed as the Florida League of Cities Voting Delegate, Broward League of Cities-Alternate Voting Delegate and BLC Youth Leadership Committee Member, serves as the PTO President at Westpine Middle School, where she founded Panthers with a Purpose, (a volunteer program for students) and has been a volunteer coach for the City of Sunrise since 2012. She also continues to be a strong supporter of youth and teen programming in the City.

Deputy Mayor Guzman is a graduate of the Sunrise Residents Leadership Academy, Parent Leadership Training Institute, Community Emergency Response Team (C.E.R.T.) and currently completing the Citizens Police Academy this year.

As a daughter of a small business owner, Deputy Mayor Guzman is a supporter of Sunrise businesses. During the pandemic, she recognized a need to help business owners navigate through challenging times. In 2021, Deputy Mayor Guzman expressed her strong support for the City's new Sunrise Small Business Academy, which was unanimously approved by the City Commission.



Assistant Deputy Mayor Mark A. Douglas

Mark A. Douglas is an Attorney at Law since 2006. Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas graduated from Florida International University (FIU) College of Law and litigates throughout the State of Florida, including in all three Federal Districts. He focuses on Criminal Defense and Immigration Law, and handles matters related to unpaid minimum wage and overtime arising under the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA). He earned a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration with honors from the University of Technology Jamaica and is a licensed Realtor for over 17 years.

Before entering private practice, Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas worked as a Criminal Prosecutor in the Miami-Dade County State Attorney's Office. While in Law school, he served as a Certified Legal Intern at the Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office, worked pro bono in the Miami-Dade Public Defender's Office and participated in Student Government, serving as president of the Black Law Students Association. He also was member of the Law School's Board of Advocates, representing the school nationally in intra-mural negotiating competitions, and was named to the Dean's List of scholars.

Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas has been involved in many community activities through the years, frequently providing pro bono services to indigent clients and providing free legal advice during citizenship drives within Broward County, as well as acting as a

mentor to young law students and lawyers. He has served on the Board of four homeowners' associations, and continues to serve as President of his community association board for over 13 years.

Before being elected to the City Commission, Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas was a member of the Broward County Consumer Protection Board, the City of Sunrise Economic Development Advisory Board, the City's Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Board - which he chaired for two terms - and the City's Board of Zoning Adjustment.

Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas was first elected in 2016 and was the first minority to have been elected to or otherwise serve on the City Commission. In the November 2020 elections, he was returned to office un-opposed. He served as Deputy Mayor in 2019 and is the City's representative on the Board of the Broward League of Cities.

Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas currently serves on the Board of Trustees of the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust, a mutual insurance entity of the Florida League of Cities that provides a range of insurance coverage for over 550 public entities statewide, including the City of Sunrise, insuring over 10 billion dollars in property values. He has served on several committees of the Florida League of Cities, including the Municipal Administration Committee, and the Legislative Action Committee, and currently serves on the Finance, Taxation and Personnel Committee.

At the national level, Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas served for two terms on the National League of Cities' Finance, Administration and Intergovernmental Relations (FAIR) Federal Advocacy Committee. In November 2020, he was appointed Chairman of FAIR, and consequently to serve on the Board of the National League of Cities. He is also member of the Broward County Bar Association, serving on their Mentorship Committee.

Assistant Deputy Mayor Douglas and his family have resided in Sunrise since 2001.



Commissioner Neil C. Kerch

Neil C. Kerch was elected to the Sunrise City Commission in March of 2013, and re-elected in 2014 and 2018. Commissioner Kerch has served as Deputy Mayor in 2013, 2017, and 2021. Commissioner Kerch has three guiding principles as an elected official, which are follow your vision for the city, serve with integrity, and deliver results. Commissioner Kerch is team oriented and honored to work with his colleagues on the Commission and City staff to make Sunrise the best place to live, work, play, learn, shop, and eat.

Since being elected, Commissioner Kerch has spoken and participated in numerous community meetings and events. He is proud of the improvements to the parks and recreation facilities in neighborhoods city wide, the improvements in our Sunrise Police Department's community-based policing, improvements in Sunrise Fire Rescue, maintaining a structurally balanced budget without raising the tax millage rate, and implementing COVID-19 assistance programs, and planning for the City's future with a new city hall, infrastructure improvements, and investments throughout the city.

Commissioner Kerch graduated cum laude from Florida Atlantic University in 2001 with a B.A. in Finance and Management. He received his J.D. in 2005 from the Shepard Broad Law Center at Nova Southeastern University. Commissioner Kerch is admitted to the Florida Bar and the United States District Court of the Southern District of Florida. After being admitted to the Florida Bar,

Commissioner Kerch served as an Assistant Public Defender in Broward County. He currently works at his law firm as a Trial Lawyer and Counselor of Law where he represents clients with legal issues in Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach Counties. Prior to embarking on his legal career, Commissioner Kerch was employed in the Hotel/Restaurant industry.

Commissioner Kerch has been a resident of Sunrise since 2004, where he has been active throughout our community. Commissioner Kerch is a member of many professional associations and organizations. He has been a chess coach, a youth athletics coach for the children of Sunrise and, prior to being elected to the City Commission, served on the City's Leisure Services Advisory Board. Commissioner Kerch is married to Carmen, and they have one child.



Commissioner Joseph A. Scuotto

Joseph A. Scuotto - a resident of Sunrise for over 40 years - grew up playing youth sports in Sunrise, attended Bair Middle School, and graduated from St. Thomas Aquinas High School. A Sunrise business owner since 1985, Scuotto has served as a City Commissioner since 1997, and was most recently returned to office without opposition in 2020. In 2014, Commissioner Scuotto received a key to the City of Sunrise for, at that time, being the longest-serving commissioner. In 2017, the Florida League of Cities presented Commissioner Scuotto with the "John Land Years of Service" award for his 20 years of service.

Commissioner Scuotto participates in the Broward County School Board's Partners in Education program that has helped students enter the workforce, and has sponsored numerous civic organizations and charities, including the American Cancer Society, Kaitlyn's Gift for Jackson Memorial Hospital, Dan Marino Foundation, Lutz Buddy Up, Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital and the Paralyzed Veterans Association of Florida. He is the president of the Sunrise Italian-American Civic Association and has been an active member of several committees, including serving as Chair of the Florida League of Cities' Environmental Quality Committee.

Commissioner Scuotto has served as a member of several committees, including serving as Chair of the Florida League of Cities' Environmental Quality Committee, Broward County's Resource and Recovery Board, Areawide Council of Aging of Broward County,

Inc. Board of Directors, National League of Cities' Community and Economic Development Steering Committee, past Chair of the South Florida Regional Planning Council and as a current member of the Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Commissioner Scuotto recently proposed a Free Recycled Paint program – unanimously approved by his colleagues – which would provide free exterior paint to Sunrise homeowners. He initiated the Youth Athlete of the Month program, which recognizes exemplary male and female student athletes. He also started and is a staunch supporter of expanding the City's School Resource Officer program to include grades K-12. Commissioner Scuotto is the owner of Scuotto's Pizza Café/Drive Thru restaurant in Sunrise. He and his fiancée, Allison, are the proud parents of two girls, Kaitlyn and Alyse.

HURRICANE SEASON IS UNDERWAY! ARE YOU PREPARED?

Hurricane season began on June 1st and continues through November 30th. While hurricanes can happen at any point during storm season, the most likely time for a hurricane to make landfall in Florida is mid-August through late October. As we approach the peak of hurricane season, do you have an emergency plan in place?

IS YOUR YARD READY?

Once a storm watch has been issued, it's too late to trim your trees and safely dispose of branches. For the safety of collection crews – and due to the closure of disposal sites – garbage, recycling and bulk trash collection must be suspended long before bad weather arrives. Do not put carts or debris outside before a storm!

All uncollected debris, as well as bulk trash and garbage carts, should be brought inside or safely secured next to your home. Debris that's left outside can cause serious damage to your home – or to your neighbors' homes – when the wind rises. It can also block roadways and slow the response of emergency personnel.

IS YOUR HOME READY?

Be sure that your homeowners (or renters) insurance is up to date, and that you have the shutters, hardware, and installation tools necessary to protect your windows and doors should a storm threaten our community.

IS YOUR FAMILY READY?

Here are a few important steps you can take now in order to stay safe:

Assemble an Emergency Kit

If a storm hits, you may need to survive independently for several days. Prepare by placing your family's necessities in plastic bins or bags that will keep them dry and portable. A basic emergency kit should contain a minimum three-day supply of water and non-perishable food for each household member (including pets), as well as medicine, a first aid kit, personal hygiene items, a radio and flashlights with extra batteries, and copies of important documents. Create a Communication Plan

It's important to maintain an up-to-date list of contact information and share it with family members and friends. Visit www.ready.gov/plan to create a customized Family Emergency Communication Plan.

Consider Your Medical Needs

The City of Sunrise is not in a hurricane evacuation zone. This means that healthy, non-vulnerable residents can remain in their home during a storm. If you are dependent on electricity for your medical needs, or if you have a medical condition that requires special care (but not hospitalization), a Broward County Special Needs Shelter may be appropriate for you. Pre-registration is strongly encouraged; visit www.broward.org/atrisk for an application, or call (954) 831-3902.

Residents who are at-risk due to frailty or disability, but who decide to stay home during a storm, are encouraged provide their contact information to Broward County's Vulnerable Population Registry. This tool is not a guarantee of assistance; however, it helps the County and the City better plan for emergencies. To register, visit www.broward.org/atrisk or call 311.

Stay Informed

Sunrise uses the **CodeRED** notification system to alert residents in the event of a hurricane, boil water order or other emergency. You can decide how you want to be contacted: by phone, by text and/or by email. The only way to be sure you're in our database is to register. Visit www.sunrisefl.gov/codered to sign up online, or text AlertSunrise to 99411.

The City's sustainability team is hosting a **Sunrise "Parks for Pollinators" BioBlitz Bingo event** in September – part of a fun, nationwide challenge to discover and document pollinator species!

"Bio" means "life" and "blitz" means "to do something quickly and intensively." Together they make BioBlitz – a collaborative race against the clock to find as many species as possible within a set location during a defined time period. Join us!

Sunrise "Parks for Pollinators" BioBlitz Bingo

Saturday, September 17th 10:00 am to 2:00 pm Oak Hammock Park, 9220 NW 44th Street

Start by picking up a Sunrise BioBlitz Bingo card at the Pigeon Plum Pavilion. All ages are welcome. This is a great activity for families and school groups; no experience is necessary!

The protection of pollinators and other insects is vital to sustaining healthy communities – and parks play a key role in preserving pollinators and their habitats. This event is designed to engage residents in pollinator awareness and education while also collecting local pollinator data for a genuine scientific survey.

The "Parks for Pollinators" BioBlitz uses the free iNaturalist smartphone app, which enables local results to be shared and calculated up to the national level to show the program's broader impact. (In order to collect data for this event, you'll be asked to log in or create an iNaturalist account and join the **Parks for Pollinators 2022: Sunrise BioBlitz** project.)

On September 17th, BioBlitz Bingo participants will learn how to use iNaturalist to help collect data while participating in a family-friendly, naturalistled nature walk. Attendees can also complete a Sunrise BioBlitz Bingo card to win an eco-friendly prize!

Extend the fun by visiting other Sunrise parks throughout September and uploading photos of the trees, plants, flowers, bugs, and birds you see. The iNaturalist app will identify the species, and then experts will review your photos – which are automatically linked to our project page.

GO Bond Update:

Improvements to Parks and Recreation Facilities Continue



On Election Day in 2014, more than 70% of Sunrise voters approved the City's general obligation (GO) bond referendum. Thanks to this overwhelming resident support, Sunrise was able to fund improvements to parks and recreation facilities in neighborhoods citywide. The map shown here provides a quick visual overview of work funded by GO Bonds. On the following page, you'll find more in-depth information about projects currently under construction.

We will continue to update you on our progress in upcoming issues of Horizons. We also invite you to visit www.sunrisefl.gov/parkbonds for additional information - including photos and renderings - for all of our projects. (Please keep in mind that renderings are conceptual, and that design details may change over the course of a project.)

COMPLETED

12th Street Park — a new neighborhood green space — was constructed on formerly vacant land.

2 Flamingo Park was renovated to add a new meeting hall, shaded basketball courts, fitness stations, a splash pad, and a second batting cage. The existing meeting facility was renovated and the playground was improved.

3 Bicycle lanes were constructed along NW 44th Street from Pine Island Road to the SAC entrance at NW 117th Avenue.

Nob Hill Soccer Club Park re-opened in November 2019 following a complete renovation. The facility now features two new synthetic turf fields, an improved natural turf field, and a music-themed tot

lot. Nob Hill Clubhouse received a new roof and HVAC system.

5 Sunrise Sportsplex opened in December 2019. The park features a pinwheel of youth baseball/softball fields, warmup areas, a concession stand/scorer's tower, a multi-purpose field, and a large playground.


The **Civic Center** was expanded and refreshed, and reopened in July 2020. The facility now includes a second indoor gymnasium with basketball courts and an elevated walking track; a bi-level fitness center, updated locker rooms and bathrooms, a new game room, and additional program space.

City Park was completely renovated, and reopened in November 2020. It now features a multiuse green space surrounded by a walking path with

exercise stations; a splash pad; shaded basketball courts; a new playground; resurfaced tennis courts; and a covered outdoor stage for events.

The **Senior Center**, reopened in June 2021, was expanded to accommodate new and enhanced programming. An additional parking lot was also constructed.

9 Village Beach Club was renovated to include a new lightning protection system; window, door and fence replacement, and pool renovation; restroom, exterior lighting and landscaping upgrades; and concession building renovation and new signage.



UNDER CONTRACT/CONSTRUCTION

Expand **Welleby Park** to add a dog park, a "Safety Town" play-learn area, a splash pad, a new playground, and a lakeside promenade, and enlarge and renovate the existing Community Building.

Create a **Veterans Park** with an accessible playground, a meditation labyrinth, a small pavilion, and monuments in tribute to the U.S. Military Service Branches.

Improve **Roarke Hall** facilities to include new windows, interior remodeling, and exterior lighting (completed); fence replacement (completed); landscape upgrades (completed); and a new splash pad.

Renovate **Sunrise Athletic Complex** (SAC) to include a multipurpose building and gymnasium,

covered basketball courts, added parking, and a new concession stand and scorers' tower. In addition, improvements will be made to the multipurpose field.

The scope at **Oscar Wind Park** (Intermediate Phase) is to demolish the remaining portable class-rooms on the old Cypress Bay Annex property, replace the playground with a new playground and shade structure, replace the chain link fence on North New River Circle with a decorative fence, and then construct an outdoor fitness circuit, a connector road between Oscar Wind Park and Sawgrass Sanctuary Park, walking paths, parking lot improvements, and landscaping/irrigation improvements.

IN DESIGN

(5) Convert vacant land at Sunset Strip/109th

Avenue into a green space with walking paths, new landscaping, irrigation, and security improvements.

FUTURE

Renovate and expand **Oscar Wind Park** (Phase II) to include a multi-purpose building and gymnasium, a new sprayground, and dedicated parking.

Convert vacant land at 9525 West Oakland Park Boulevard into a new neighborhood park.

GO BOND UPDATE

PROJECT SPOTLIGHT: Parks Enhancements Near Completion!

SUNRISE ATHLETIC COMPLEX (SAC)

Work is wrapping up on the expansion of SAC! The project includes the renovation of the park's existing playground, full-size multipurpose fields, meeting hall, and restroom facilities, and the resurfacing of tennis courts. In addition, a 15,000-square-foot multipurpose building is being constructed, along with five new, covered outdoor basketball courts, a concession building with scorers' tower, and additional parking. SAC's sports lighting and security features are also being enhanced. Several fields and a new playground are already open for use.













WELLEBY PARK

In the existing portion of the park, improvements include an 800-square-foot meeting room expansion, as well as the construction of a nature-themed splash pad, a new playground, a "Safety Town" play/learn area, a boardwalk along the water's edge, new Flexi-Pave pathways, supplemental parking, and lighting and security enhancements. In addition, an adjacent four-acre parcel is being developed as Sunrise's first municipal dog park, with areas for large, small, and tiny dogs.

In March 2022, the Sunrise City Commission awarded a bid to a new contractor to take over the Welleby Park enhancement project. Work is well underway and nearing completion!


