D. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES – March 10, 2022

Mr. Barnett motioned to approve the minutes. Seconded by Mr. Parker. There was no further discussion. All were in favor.

E. OPEN DISCUSSION

There were no members of the public or City present at this meeting who wished to speak during open discussion.

F. OLD BUSINESS

The City Liaison provided an update on the planning of Bike Bingo. The Board selected the activities to be included with the Bike Bingo form and provided comments on the layout and design of the form. The City Liaison stated that the Board's input for Bike Bingo will be incorporated into the conceptual Bike Bingo form design and it will be presented at the June meeting for the Boards review and support.

The City Liaison provided an update on the budget available to the Board for activities/prizes. The City Liaison then presented available options for prizes (water bottles, stickers, etc.) to be awarded through Bike Bingo and received recommendations for prizes to be awarded in the future. The Board suggested to limit the number of persons that would receive a prize to manage resources. The City Liaison noted that a limit can be evaluated after the inaugural Bike Bingo. The Board also discussed the possibility of different prize levels based upon activities completed. The Board then inquired as to how the Bike Bingo activity would be marketed. The City Liaison noted it is intended to be promoted at City facilities and schools, but additional marketing would be determined by the City's Marketing & Communications Office.

The City Liaison informed the Board that they were invited to attend the grand openings for Sunrise Athletic Complex (SAC) Park on July 16th and Welleby Park on July 30th by City Management. The Board was notified to confirm via email which event they would like to attend, if any.

The City Liaison informed the Board that there is no update regarding the information flyer, and reiterated that the Board would have to prepare a draft of the flyer which would be provided to the City's Marketing & Communications Office for review and update.

G. NEW BUSINESS

The Board inquired if there were any plans for constructing a sidewalk on the South West corner of Oakland Park Blvd and Flamingo Road. The City Liaison noted that there were no plans at the moment and he would investigate and follow-up with the Board. The City Liaison informed the Board that Broward County is undergoing a project along Commercial Blvd, from the Sawgrass Expressway to Nob Hill Road, which includes the addition of bike lanes. The City Liaison also informed the Board about the bike lanes improvements along Weston Road from NW 14th St to State Road 84. The Board inquired if guardrails will be installed along NW 12th St and Silver Palm Blvd, to which the City Liaison noted he is not aware of any projects for such. The Board inquired if the City has investigated installing dog waste stations throughout the City, to which the City Liaison noted he will follow-up with the City's Public Works Division and update the Board.

H. BOARD FORUM

Having no more items to discuss, the Board confirmed the next meeting would be held on Thursday, June 9, 2022 at 6:30 PM.
