The Sunrise Small Business Academy (SSBA) is designed to help small businesses in Sunrise grow and thrive. SSBA sessions provide information about important business topics, including City and County resources, accounting/finance, hiring, and marketing.

SSBA Cohort 2 – our Summer 2022 session – will be conducted in person over the course of five sessions, each held from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm EST (90-minutes), with the exception of the finance session, which will take place from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm. A 10-minute orientation will be provided immediately prior to the first session.

The dates for **SSBA Cohort 2** are as follows:

Session 1: City Resources (Thursday, August 18, 2022) — Session will feature three City of Sunrise employees providing an overview of their department and how it relates to small businesses. Topics include:

- **Economic Development:** Overview of City's economic development/redevelopment activities and programs benefiting small businesses.
- Code Compliance, Business Tax Receipts, and Fire Inspections: Process for obtaining a business tax receipt, code compliance for business owners, and important safety issues.
- Community Development (zoning, permitting, building): Regulatory process related zoning, obtaining permits when opening a new business, and making improvements at their current business location.

Session 2: County/State Resources and Business Bites (Thursday, August 25, 2022) – Session will feature two to three speakers discussing County and State resources available for small businesses. Topics include:

- Broward County Office of Economic Development and Small Business (OESBD): Discuss the County certification process, which allows small businesses to bid on and have preference on County projects.
- SCORE and/or Small Business Development Center (SBDC): Discuss technical assistance available for a competitive bidding processes and funding resources for small businesses.

Session 3: Sustainability, Workforce and Business Bites (Tuesday, August 30, 2022) – Session will feature one to two subject matter experts in their field. Topics include:

- **Sustainability:** Session will go over steps a business can take in order to make their organization green/sustainable, with a cost-effective twist.
- Workforce Development: HR professional will discuss hiring the best people, professional development, retaining good employees, benefits/incentives, and other workforce-related topics.

Session 4: Finance - Accounting/Taxes/How to be Bankable (Thursday, September 1, 2022) — This two-hour session will feature two to three business professionals with tips on monitoring your business. Topics include:

- Checklist for searching for the proper business professional(s)
- Basic overview of bookkeeping software
- Reconciling bank statements and cash flow planning: Tracking Metrics/Expenses/Maintaining Daily Records
- Having enough capital to see your business through: Budget/Forecasting, Projected expenses, sales/revenue expectations, and contingency funds.

- Tracking Metrics/Expenses/Maintaining Daily Records: Account receivables, cash/asset management, payroll/benefits, and debt obligations.
- Budget/Forecasting: Projected expenses, sales/revenue expectations, and contingency funds.
- Company Structures: Partnerships and LLC vs Corporation
- Tax Deadlines/What is/What is Not Deductible: Quarterly and Yearly, Difference between expense/liability.
- What to write off within Industry: Food/dining, health/wellness, retail and professional services.

Session 5: Marketing Panel and Business Bites (Thursday, September 8, 2022) – This session will feature a panel of marketing professionals discussing various ways to help attract clients and promote/grow a business. Topics include:

- Social Media/Content: Branding, social media, management platforms, and analytics.
- Photo/Video: Boost engagement, photo/video editing apps, and concepts/production.
- Grassroots: Knowing your demographic, niche trends, and targeted campaigns.

SELECTION OVERVIEW

In order for an engaging experience, each cohort will be capped at **30 participants**. Under the **SSBA** guidelines participants must:

- Have an active City of Sunrise Business Tax Receipt (*with the exception of Start-ups);
- Complete the SSBA Cohort 2 enrollment application <u>prior to the deadline</u>;
- Be interested in effective small business tools/resources;
- Have 30 or less employees (including founder/owner/co-owner); and
- Commit to attending 4 out of the 5 sessions

APPLICATION EVALUATION

Applications will be accepted on a <u>first-come</u>, <u>first-qualified basis</u>. However, there will be some spaces that are prioritized for the following groups:

- Five spaces will be allocated for start-up business owners that reside in Sunrise; and
- Ten spaces will be prioritized for Sunrise businesses located east of University Drive (East Sunrise Improvements Master Plan Area).

Note: If by the end of the application period some spaces saved are not filled by priority groups, we will consider all other <u>complete applications</u> on a <u>first-come, first-qualified basis</u>. Additionally, <u>only one designated</u> <u>person</u> per business will be accepted for each cohort class.
