<p>On 05/01/2022 at approximately 13:12 hours, I responded to 6125 W Sunrise Blvd in reference to a burglary / rim theft in progress. The victim described five suspects, two black females and three black males, one wearing a white shirt, one with no shirt and one with a black shirt that were damaging his vehicle, removing the rims and unlawfully entering his vehicle with the intent to remove property. Sunrise Dispatch stated that a white Maserati was involved in the burglary and a light blue Audi which I recalled as vehicles shooting at each other the day before in Lauderhill Case # 29-2204-005404. Prior to my arrival on scene, Officer Cook who was already on scene advised that a fight was in progress between the victim and the suspect.</p>			
<p>On Arrival I saw a black male wearing a white shirt, actively walking in the parking lot, away from Officer Vargas. I yelled for the suspect to stop and he began to walk toward Ofc. Vargas and the white Maserati in an aggressive manner. I unholstered my taser and believed that suspect was going to flee. The suspect disobeyed my direct command to stop, while next to Officer Vargas, prompting me to discharge my taser. The suspect fell to the ground after a successful taser engagement.</p>

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

The suspect complied after the first discharge and I then pointed my taser in the direction of Oneil Black and Nathyrick Parks. I ordered both of them to the ground, which they complied. I holstered my taser and all suspects were restrained in handcuffs. Joseph was treated by Sunrise Fire Rescue 39. The The suspect refused transport to the hospital and remained in custody with officers on scene. The suspect sustained a laceration on his upper back and upper left leg as a result of the taser prong hits.

On 05/01/2022, officers responded to an Auto theft (rim theft) in progress called in by [REDACTED] (VI). [REDACTED] advised dispatch of a vehicle burglary in progress on his light blue Audi (FL/DED1027) by three male subjects and two female subjects. While officers were heading to the incident location dispatch advised that the white Maserati was involved in a shooting the previous night.

It should be noted that my body worn camera (BWC) did not activate upon turning on my lights and sirens and due to officer safety concerns upon arrival my BWC was delayed being activated.

Upon officer arrival, all subjects, Joseph Reid (OF), Alexis Bohler (OF), Oneil Black (OF), and Nathyrick Parks (OF) were observed walking away from the Audi. Alexis entered back into her friend's, Theresa Wiah (IO), red Honda Civic (FL/17BLXP) and sat in the front passenger seat. Contact was made with the three male subjects walking away from the vehicle back towards their white Maserati (FL/PLLC42). Wiah was given commands to turn the vehicle off and step out of the car with Bohler. While attempting to get the scene under control, [REDACTED] who observed the incident occur from inside the Burger King ran behind Reid and pushed him into the driver door of the Maserati. Black and Parks remained on the passenger side of the vehicle while [REDACTED] was separated from Reid and told to wait with officers by the Burger King. Agitated from being pushed Reid began to yell at [REDACTED] and ignored commands to get on the ground. After several failed attempts, Reid began to walk back away from me towards Sunrise Blvd. where Ofc. Maristany was approaching from. Ofc. Maristany gave Reid several more commands which Reid did not adhere to. Reid turned away from Ofc. Maristany and began walking in my direction flailing his arms aggressively. Ofc. Maristany deployed his department issued Taser 7 at Reid allowing the opportunity to detain Reid. Ofc. Maristany and Ofc. McCarthy then detained Black and Parks who had complied with commands to get on the ground. See Ofc. Maristany and Ofc. McCarthy's supplement.

Reid was read his Miranda rights via prepared card. Reid stated he understood his rights and chose to speak with me.

[REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Parks and Black provided the same account as Reid. All three male subjects were detained and placed into separate marked police units.

Sunrise Fire Rescue responded to the scene to examine Reid. At the time of Fire Rescue's evaluation of Reid the taser prongs had fallen out. Reid denied transport at this time stating he was fine. Fire Rescue's evaluation showed no injuries to Reid. The taser prongs and taser prong wounds were documented via Sunrise issued tablet.

A NCIC/FCIC search of the Audi vin number (WAUAFAPLXEN005112) revealed the registered owner to be [REDACTED]. A search of the vehicle showed major damage to all four windows, hood, trunk, interior and two tires missing. A visual inspection inside the vehicle showed that the radio wires and a portion of the gas pedal had been removed.

Contact was then made with Bohler and Wiah. Bohler and Wiah were read their Miranda rights via prepared card and advised they understood. Bohler stated that [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] they did not know. Parks asked Wiah to open the trunk and then placed one of the Audi tires inside. Bohler and Wiah were both asked if at any time they approached the vehicle or removed tires [REDACTED]. It should be noted that all three subjects stated the tires are very expensive and provided estimates around \$5,000 for a set of four. A search for an accurate tire price was conducted and revealed the tires to be approximately \$500 each.

Contact was made with witnesses Kyandra Dorleans (WI) and Malaik Bruts (WI). Both witnesses provided statements that Reid, Black, Parks, and Bohler were damaging the vehicle, removing the two passenger side tires, and entering the vehicle. Dorleans was able to provide two photographs which showed the subjects damaging the Audi and entering the vehicle. Reid was witnessed by [REDACTED] entering the vehicle driver side and removing a speaker cord. Parks was witnessed by [REDACTED] and witnesses holding a three-foot-long silver pole and opening and closing the hood of the vehicle and entering the backseat compartment. Black was witnessed going into the backseat and the trunk of the vehicle and then walking to the trunk of the Maserati. Bohler was witnessed going into the backseat. After exiting she closes the door and wiped her fingerprints off. It should be noted that Wiah was not witnessed near the vehicle at this time.

An initial search conducted search incident to arrest of the white Maserati led to the discovery of a small backpack containing a black Glock 9mm semiautomatic pistol (BTMZ320). The firearm was made safe and secured in a marked police unit. A NCIC/FCIC search of the firearm revealed that it was not stolen. Due to all the doors being open on the red Honda the Audi tire as well as the Audi vehicle registration and temporary tag were in plain view for officers to see. Officers entered the vehicle to secure the items seen. The registration and tag belong to the Audi and show [REDACTED] as the registered owner. All vehicles were photographed and the photos were uploaded to evidence.com.

Bohler was separated from Wiah and a sworn taped statement was taken via BWC. Bohler stated [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Due to the finding of the tag and registration located on the passenger seat where Bohler was witnessed sitting upon officer arrival and witness statements stating Bohler actively entered and damaged the vehicle, Bohler was detained and placed in a marked police unit.

Wiah was separated from the scene and a sworn taped statement was taken via BWC. Wiah stated that she was driving with Bohler when they received a call to come to the location to help move the tires. Wiah advised that when they arrived the vehicle was already damaged and two tires removed. Wiah stated that Bohler exited the vehicle and Parks gave her the vehicle registration and tag which she then placed on the passenger seat. Wiah advised to officers she never left the vehicle until officers arrived on scene and was ordered out. Given the fact no one witnessed Wiah near the vehicle and upon officer arrival she was sitting in the vehicle she was released.

Reid, Parks, Black, and Bohler were transported to the PSB where they were interviewed by Sunrise Det. K. Norwood and Det. M. Ginglesperger.

Crime scene responded to the scene to process the vehicles. A secondary search of the Maserati while being processed led to the discovery of two laptops, one tablet, and one keyboard located in the trunk along with the other Audi tire. [REDACTED] advised to officers on scene that the property belonged to him and was located in his vehicle at the

Due to [REDACTED] not being able to provided proof that the items belonged to him all the items were entered in Sunrise Police evidence by Ofc. Cook. See Ofc Cook's supplement for further.

The firearm was entered into Sunrise Police evidence. See Ofc. Jossfolk's supplement.

Copies of the photos were taken via police issued tablet an uploaded to evidence.com. A signed affidavit with the desire to press charges was submitted to Sunrise Teletype.

Due to witness statements of the subjects damaging and entering the vehicle as well as removing the vehicles tires all four subjects were charged with burglary conveyance and grand theft. Reid was additionally charged with resisting arrest without violence. A NCIC/FCIC search conducted of all parties showed Parks with a possible warrant for driving with a suspended license (WC2022-1219770). The warrant was confirmed through Sunrise teletype and Parks received the additional charge.

Reid was transported to FMC per City of Sunrise policy to be medically cleared. Black, Parks, and Bohler were transported to BSO main Jail. Once medically cleared Reid was transported to BSO main jail.

On 05/01/2022 at approximately 13:12 hours, I responded to 6125 W Sunrise Blvd in reference to rim theft in progress. The victim described four suspects, one black female wearing a blue top and and three black males, one wearing a white shirt, one with no shirt and one with a black shirt that were removing the rims and unlawfully entering his vehicle with the intent to deprive the victim of property. While en-route, Sunrise Dispatch stated that a white Maserati was involved in the incident and I recalled a white Maserati shooting at a vehicle the day before in Lauderhill Case # 29-2204-005404. Prior to my arrival on scene, Officer Cook who was already on scene advised that a fight was in progress between the victim and the suspect.

On Arrival I saw a black male wearing a white shirt, actively walking in the parking lot, away from Officer Vargas not complying with commands. I yelled for the suspect to stop and he began to walk toward Officer Vargas and the white Maserati. I unholstered my taser and yelled for the male to stop again which he refused, prompting me to discharge my taser. The suspect fell to the ground after a successful taser engagement. Once the subject was detained, I pointed my taser at Oneil Black and Nathyrick Parks who were sitting inside of a white Maserati. I ordered them to exit the vehicle which they complied. I holstered my taser and detained Oneil Black.

Sunrise Rescue 39 arrived on scene and treated Joseph Reid for two lacerations as a result from the taser prongs. Joseph refused to be transported to the hospital and remained on scene with officers. Officer Jossfolk read Joseph his miranda right which he understood and waived.





On 5/1/22 officers responded to the parking lot of Burger King for a possible vehicle burglary in progress. I responded with multiple officers and made contact with victim [REDACTED] who was irate and being held back by other Burger King employees. I took [REDACTED] back inside Burger King where [REDACTED] advised the following:

He purchased the teal blue Audi (FL/DED1027) the day prior on 4/30/22 from Karzilla dealership (4020 NE 6th Ave., Oakland Park, FL 33334). [REDACTED] was driving in Lauderhill on the same date at the corner of NW 49th Ave/NW 20th St. when a white Infiniti Q50 with black rims and a black BMW attempted to carjack him. [REDACTED] was able to drive away and made a left on NW 19th St. when he heard seven (7) gunshots as he was driving away. Later that night [REDACTED] left his mother's house and was going to the laundromat next to Burger King [REDACTED] when he noticed a red Honda Civic in front of him on W. Sunrise Blvd. at the 6100 block. [REDACTED] advised he slowed down to turn by Dunkin Donuts and saw the Honda slow down in front of him so he immediately merged left and began driving away and the red Honda followed him. [REDACTED] twice that evening and Plantation Police were able to stop the red Honda. [REDACTED] was able to ultimately get away from the vehicle both times. On today's date 5/1/22 [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] Burger King at 08:00 hours. He parked his teal blue Audi in front of the business on the east side. At 08:30-09:00 hours [REDACTED] then moved his car into another parking lot still giving him a view of it while he was inside [REDACTED]. Around 13:10 hours one of the other employees told him that someone was messing with his car. [REDACTED] walked over and observed a B/M wearing a white shirt with his speaker cord and was in the driver's side of the car. [REDACTED] also observed a slim petite "redskin" B/F with braids who was on the driver's side of his car. She then closed the door and wiped the prints off the top. This female was also on the phone. [REDACTED] also witnessed a B/M with a "rough afro" wearing a black shirt who had a long pole approximately three feet in his hand. He was under the hood of his Audi and in the back of the car. [REDACTED] observed the B/M close the hood of his car. [REDACTED] also saw another B/M with dreads tied back and had a limp. This male went in the trunk of his car and the backseat. He also observed the male go into the trunk and right door of the Maserati on scene. [REDACTED] advised he was on the phone with police dispatch while this was occurring. There was another B/F on scene that [REDACTED] did not see until officers arrived. [REDACTED] could tell that two tires and rims of his Audi were missing because of how the car was leaning. I responded to a call of tire/rim theft in progress. I arrived on scene first with Officer Vargas. I observed a red Honda, white Maserati, and a teal Audi in the corner of the Walgreens parking lot. The teal audi was heavily damaged (side mirrors hanging down, windows smashed, and missing 2 rims).

I ordered all occupants to move away and get out of the vehicles. I made contact with the 2 females and ordered them to sit on the curb. The females were later identified as Alexis Bohler and Theresa Wiah.

I observed 1 large rim/tire in the trunk of the red Honda that the females were occupying. The tire was in plain view due to the trunk being open.

I read Miranda to Alexis and Theresa who both stated they wished to talk. Alexis and Theresa were both interviewed by Officer Vargas separately.

Three doors of the Maserati were opened where I was able to observe a long metal bar (part that attaches to a jack) in the back seat. I searched the Maserati and also discovered a cross wrench type of tool in the back seat floorboard, a jack in the trunk along with several electronics. I also observed a black Steve Madden small backpack on the rear drivers side seat. Inside of the backpack was a loaded firearm 9mm Glock17 Serial # BTMZ320 with approximately 25 rounds in the magazine. The gun was not listed as stolen in FCIC/NCIC. The trunk contained 2 laptops (1 small with cracked screen and 1 large, a tablet, a keyboard, and an equalizer.

I spoke with the victim [REDACTED] who stated he had 2 computers, a tablet, and a keyboard in a bin in his trunk. And an equalizer that was located on the side of driver's seat. The electronics were placed into evidence for safekeeping and return to [REDACTED]

I gave the firearm to Officer Jossfolk to submit into SPD Evidence.
