At 1526 hours on 05/20/2022, Officers responded to the Adidas store (12801 West Sunrise Blvd, Sunrise FL. 33323) in reference to a male actively concealing merchandise inside his luggage while walking throughout the store.

Upon arrival, contact was made with Loss Prevention Agent (LPA) E. Castro. Castro advised a Latin male wearing a black adidas jacket and black hat with a blue suitcase was using an Adidas article of clothing to cover the top zipper area of his luggage. He was then concealing merchandise from various parts of the store inside the luggage. Castro advised he actively watched the male select and conceal the merchandise via floor surveillance and that the other staff were also keeping an eye on the suspect while he came outside to speak with Officers. Officers stood by outside the store as the suspect passed all points of sale and made no attempt to pay for the selected and concealed merchandise.

As the suspect exited the store, Castro pointed him out to Officers. The subject looked directly at me, pushed the luggage in between us, and took off running into the mall. I gave out a loud verbal command to "Stop!" and yelled "Police" and "Taser." I then deployed two Taser cartridges from approximately 7-10 feet. The probes struck the suspect in the back, upper thigh, and right butt cheek. He then fell to the floor and surrendered. He was safely taken into custody and Fire Rescue was requested in order to transport the male to the hospital to have the probes removed. The subject was now under arrest for Resisting Law Enforcement without Violence for actively fleeing from Officers who attempted to stop him for allegedly shoplifting. It should be noted that both Officers on scene were in our Class B uniforms with visible badge and department patches and insignia. The subject was given verbal commands to stop and did obstruct and resist law enforcement as he fled.

The suspect was now identified as (OF) Edrihan Nodarse Horta (Latin male, DOB: 02/16/1989). Search incident to arrest revealed a high-powered magnet inside his front left pants pocket and a metal hook inside the right interior jacket pocket. It should be noted that the magnet and hook device are solely used to defeat security sensors on clothing. The hook and magnet were immediately recognized by Officers as a shoplifting countermeasure device based on the experience of the Officers working in the Sawgrass Mall and the Officers past work history in an apparel store. Edrihan was now charged with two counts of possession of anti-shoplifting countermeasure devices.

The investigation into the theft from Adidas revealed that twenty-seven (27) articles of stolen clothing (valued at \$1388.89) were found in the luggage that Edrihan had left behind as he fled from Officers. Castro collected the stolen merchandise from inside the luggage and returned it to the store. He spoke on behalf of Adidas and desires prosecution for the theft.

Officer J. Garcia (3750) read Edrihan his Miranda Warnings in spanish from a pretext card. Post miranda, Edrihan

Sunrise Fire Rescue #92 responded to Avenue 3 and Edrihan was transported to Cleveland Clinic to have the Taser probes removed. Officer Garcia rode with Fire Rescue and Edrihan while I followed them to the hospital. Sergeant Calvano (3591) also responded to the Hospital to speak with Edrihan. Edrihan was medically cleared to be taken to jail and I transported him to BSO main jail for processing.

Inside Edrihan's luggage was also merchandise from Burlington Coat Factory. The store manager responded to the Sunrise Police sub-station and took possession of the stolen merchandise. A property receipt outlining what was found in Edrihan's possession from Burlington was signed and turned over to the Sunrise Records Unit. Also turned over to the Sunrise Records Unit was a receipt from Adidas outlining what was stolen and now recovered, an affidavit stating they desire prosecution, and a shoplifter apprehension report.

Edrihan was indefinitely trespassed from the Sawgrass Mills Mall due to the fact that he committed a grand theft, was found in possession of two anti-shoplifting countermeasure devices, and resisted law enforcement officers. The trespass was explained in Spanish to Edrihan by Officer Garcia which he stated he understood. An F.I.C. was completed further outlining the trespass. Edrihan's vehicle was found in the area of the Oasis and towed from the property with the authorization of Sawgrass Mills Security. The vehicle was towed since Edrihan was now trespassed from the mall indefinitely. The vehicle was towed to Westway and a tow slip was completed.

Placed into the Sunrise Evidence lockers were the two anti-shoplifting countermeasure devices, Edrihan's oversized luggage with personal belongings, and the Taser probes and cartridges. Pictures of Edrihan and the Taser probes were taken and submitted to evidence.com. I spoke to the Security Director, J. Leach, who advised the mall CCTV cameras were angeled in a way that did not capture the taser deployment. A canvas of the area also revealed no businesses with cameras pointing in the direction of the incident.

A Response to Resistance report and C.E.W. Use Form were submitted for the Taser deployment to Sergeant Calvano. Sergeant T. McGovern issued me two new Taser cartridges and the issuance form was forwarded to the Training Unit.

On 5/20/2022 at approximately 1530 hours, Ofc. Douglass and I responded to Adidas in reference to theft in progress. The Loss Prevention Officer met us just outside the front of the store. The LP advised the shoplifter, a Hispanic male wearing an all-black Adidas tracksuit, is currently selecting items. The male has a large blue suitcase with a jacket draped over the top zipper which is open. The male would select items and then conceal the items under his jacket effectively dropping the selected items into the suitcase. The LP advised he would follow the male out and point him out to officers. As Ofc. Douglass and I were waiting just outside of the store, I observed a male exiting matching the same description given by the LP. The LP quickly followed and pointed the male out as the shoplifter. As the male walks passed Ofc. Douglass, he sees Ofc. Douglass walk toward him. Ofc. Douglass goes to take possession of the suitcase when the male pushes it in front of Ofc. Douglass and runs away. Ofc. Douglass runs after the male and the two run around the corner leaving my line of vision. As I was running around the corner, I could hear Ofc. Douglass yell different commands, "Police!", "Stop!" When the male did not stop, I heard Ofc. Douglass yell, "Taser! Taser! Taser!" Ofc. Douglass deployed a successful taser deployment and the male quickly falls to the ground in a complete full body lock up. I quickly run to the male and detain him in handcuffs. Ofc. Douglass and I put the male in the recovery position and quickly sit him on his rear end. Ofc. Douglass then advises over the radio for rescue to respond reference a taser deployment. Rescue responds and transports the male to Cleveland Clinic, which ends my involvement with the call.
