Storm Season Is Here: Stay Informed, Sunrise!

During hurricane season (and year 'round), it's important to stay connected to reliable sources of information. We encourage you to use these communication tools to receive updates from the City of Sunrise:

The City uses the high speed CodeRED notification system to alert residents in the event of a boil water order, storm, or other emergency. The only way to be sure you're in our phone number database – especially if you've traded your land line for a cell phone – is to register. It's simple to do online, and takes only minutes.
