<p>The subject was actively masturbating in view of the public and myself as he laid on the ground of a public bathroom.</p>			
<p>I ordered the subject out of the stall and unholstered my taser. As he exited the stall, he walked toward me. I ordered him to place his hands in the air and drop his belongings. After multiple commands, he complied. The subject was clearly agitated and argumentative.</p>			
<p>The subject was passively resisting by selectively following commands and dictating when he would respond to the lawful commands. At this point, I activated my taser as a show-of-force to the non-compliant subject. Once the Taser was activated (laser display), the subject bladed his body toward me in what I perceived was a fighting stance. He also began to partially clench his fists as he stood there in his bladed stance. The level of resisting had now escalated to active-resistance due to his physical movements. After a minute of trying to gain verbal compliance of the subject, he again dropped his hands down and was blading his stance toward me.</p>			
<p>We were within 5 feet of each other in a small, enclosed bathroom, and I was between the subject and the sole exit.</p>			








<p>I was the only Officer on scene at this point and the radio was unavailable due to emergency radio traffic regarding another call. The subject's belongings were also within arms reach of him and at the time, it was not known to me whether he had a weapon or not inside his bag.</p>	
<p>I ordered the subject to drop down to his knees so I could have a physical advantage when placing him in handcuffs. It should be noted that I had probable cause to detain and arrest the subject for the charges of exposure of sexual organs and resisting law enforcement without violence.</p>	
<p>He dropped his hands down to his waist and again bladed his stance. Again, it was not known if he possessed a weapon in his waistband and his hands were not visible at all times to me. The subject was still clearly agitated and argumentative as I gave him lawful commands.</p>	
<p>For my safety, since I was the only Officer on scene, the radio was not able to be communicated on, and the close quarters for which this non-compliant subject and I were in, I determined the most effective and safe way to gain compliance from the subject was to deploy one taser cartridge at the subject.</p>	
<p>A single taser probe struck him in his right bicep. He reached over with his left hand to rip the probe out of his arm, which caused his body to lock-up from the shock. After the Taser deployment, he immediately began complying with my commands to lay down on his stomach and place his hands behind his back.</p>	
<p>After a few more moments, a back-up Officer arrived and placed the subject in handcuffs.</p>	
<p>At the conclusion of the investigation, Anthony was charged with exposure of sexual organs, trespass after warning, possession of cannabis (under 20 grams), and resisting law enforcement without violence.</p>	
<p>My BWC was active during the events that transpired.</p>

At 1036 hours on 06/02/2022, I responded to 2600 Sawgrass Mills Circle (Sunrise FL. 33323) in reference to a male in the bathroom possibly having a seizure. Upon arrival to the area, I spoke to another male (later found to be a witness) who advised there was a male in the locked stall who was "doing something weird" or "having a seizure." I entered the bathroom and observed a male laying on the ground of the stall. He could be seen from the outside of the stall because of the opening under the stall. I could see the male laying on the ground moving his hand in an up and down motion and shaking his foot, with his pants down to his shins, exposing his flaccid penis. I asked the male if he needed help and did not get a response. I entered the adjoining stall and looked over the top of the stall to try and make entry should this be a medical emergency. I ended up observing the male actively masturbating. He had his genitals exposed, hand on his penis, and was stroking himself. The male was ordered to exit the stall and after a few moments, opened his eyes, stood up, and exited the stall.

As the male exited the stall, he walked toward me to exit the bathroom. He was given lawful commands to turn around and put his hands in the air so I could detain him and investigate the incident. The male was clearly agitated and selectively refused commands as I ordered him to the ground. He bladed his body in what I believed was a fighting stance and partially clenched his fists. He had now gone from passively resisting to actively resisting my lawful efforts to detain him. He was then tased as he continued resisting my attempts to safely detain him. After the taser deployment, compliance by the male was obtained and he was placed in handcuffs by Officer J. Garcia (3750) who arrived on scene. He was then escorted out of the mall. The male refused to give his information or speak to officers, thus further obstructing and interfering with our investigation. He was placed under arrest for resisting law enforcement without violence and exposure of sexual organs.

A search of the male incident to arrest revealed two plastic baggies with a green leafy substance inside of them, consistent with the look of unburned cannabis. Later, a field test was completed and the substance tested positive for cannabis. The cannabis weighed 1.55 grams. The male was then charged with possession of cannabis under '20 grams.

Sunrise Fire Rescue (R92, Run #6521) responded to transport the male to the hospital as a result of the Taser deployment. Officer Garcia rode with Fire Rescue and the male to Cleveland Clinic to have him medically cleared for booking and to have the Taser probe removed from his arm.

Utilizing police databases, I found the males name and date-of-birth. The male was identified as (OF) Anthony M. Peat (B/M, DOB: 03/29/1986). Anthony has an extensive criminal history with charges that include battery on law enforcement and other various misdemeanor and felony offenses. A database check revealed he had been previously trespassed from the Sawgrass Mills Mall twice, under case numbers 42-1308-051704 and 42-1105-022030. Anthony was then charged with trespassing in an occupied structure after being previously warned. I spoke to the Assistant Security Director J. Fernandez who spoke on behalf of Sawgrass Mills Mall and desires prosecution for the trespassing charge.

I called the initial 911 caller and gathered additional information on the incident. The caller advised they wished to remain anonymous. They work for a business in the mall and a guest came up to them advising someone was possibly having a seizure in the bathroom. He went to the men's bathroom to investigate and could see a male clearly

laying on the ground, visible to the public, but laying inside the stall close to the stall door. He could see the males hand moving and foot shaking. He tried to enter the stall since the male was not replying to his questions about if he needed help. He could see the males exposed genitals and hand around his exposed penis. He too observed the male stroking his penis. He then exited the bathroom and called the police.

As witnessed by me and the 911 caller, Anthony did expose his sexual organs in a public establishment (visible to the public). He intended to expose his sexual organs in a vulgar, indecent, lewd, and lascivious manner as he actively masturbated in view of the public and on the floor of a public bathroom. Such exposure was in a vulgar and lewd manner when his pants were down by his shins, exposing himself, while having his hand on his penis, actively stroking himself. Anthony resisted and obstructed law enforcement as he disregarded commands and then later refused to identify himself as law enforcement was investigating his unlawful behavior. Anthony was found in possession of 1.55 grams of cannabis and also, based on a database search, was found to have been trespassing at the mall after being warned on two separate occasions.

Anthony refused to speak to law enforcement and was not read his Miranda Warnings. He was not questioned about the incident. After being medically cleared, Anthony was transported to BSO Main Jail for processing.

A Response to Resistance Report and accompanying paperwork was completed.

Anthony's property, the Taser cartridge, the taser probe, and the cannabis were all submitted to the Sunrise Property and Evidence Unit. Pictures from my BWC were collected and uploaded to Evidence.com for preservation.

The specific questions and statements made during this incident can be obtained from the uploaded body-worn camera footage. All statements listed above are summaries of what was said during the interviews and conversations with the involved parties.

The call was cleared by arrest.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief based on the information provided to me by the involved parties.
