IV. Open Discussion: Updates/Announcements Regarding Schools

- Village Elementary: Aldett F. connected with Ms. Haynes (Principal) and reported that the school letter grade went up, which removed Village Elementary School from probation list. Ms. Haynes inquired about the City setting up a table at Open House and Meet + Greet. Additionally, Village Elementary School has a new Assistant Principal (Ms. Kizzy N. Dailey).
- Natalia A.: Broward County Public Libraries are offering free in-person/virtual tutoring for students wanting to participate in chess.
