Fence Application Checklist

Application Requirements

- **A. Licensed Contractors.** State of Florida or Broward County licensed contractors properly registered in the Community Development Building Division. Contractors shall provide all required applications properly signed and notarized.
- **B.** Owner/Builder (only applicable for single family homes, townhomes, and duplexes). Permit can be issued to owner/builder as per the following requirements:
 - Proof of ownership (Recorded warranty deed, tax statement, settlement statement).
 - Completed Owner Builder Affidavit. This must be completed in the presence of the Building Division Staff and must be notarized by a Permit Service Specialist.

Required Documents

Completed Broward County Uniform Building Permit Application and City of Sunrise Structural Addendum. Please make sure the application and City of Sunrise Addendum are completely filled out, including the job description (include fence type, height, and total length) and total estimated value.
Owner / Builder Affidavit . The owner must be present with this form to allow staff to witness and notarize the owner's signature. (Only required if application is by owner)
Two (2) Sets of a Boundary Survey or Site Plan indicating the location and dimensions of the fence. Draw a series of X's to indicate each run of fence. Label each run of fence with a length and indicate any gates along with the size of each gate.
Two (2) Sets of a Fence Detail . Fences other than Florida Building Code prescriptive wood or chain link fences will require engineered drawings. The Florida Building Code prescriptive details can be provided by the Building Division.
Notice of Commencement: As per Florida Statutes 713.13, a Recorded Notice of Commencement is required when construction, renovation, alterations values exceed \$2,500. This subsection does not apply to a direct contract to repair or replace an existing heating or air-conditioning system in an amount less than \$7,500. Construction cost (Including labor & material) will be based on contract signed by both parties (owner & contractor) and/or as determined by the Building Official (FBC 109.3).

Fence Permit Application Requirements

Submit completed Building Permit Application and Addendum with all of the following attached:

- Contact U.N.C.L.E. at 1-800-432-4770 for ticket number
- o Include U.N.C.L.E. ticket number on application

Completed Homeowner Affidavit

• Two (2) copies of the survey with the following information included:

- o Fence Location State and highlight the location of the fence on each copy of the survey.
- Fence Design State the design of the fence on each copy of the survey.
- o Fence Gates State the location of the fence gates on each copy of the survey.
- o Fence Height State the height of the fence at each location on each copy of the survey.
- Fence Length State the total length of the fence and the length of each fence segment on each copy of the survey.
- o State if a pool and/or spa is on the property on each copy of the survey.

• Chain Link Fence Requirements

Show compliance with the Chain Link Fence minimum requirements as set forth in Table 2224 of the Florida Building Code on each copy of the survey, or attach a copy of the table to each copy of the survey and highlight the items that apply to your job.

Wood Fence Requirements

- Show compliance with each of the following on each copy of the survey:
 - Wood Fence Post Hole The wood pressure treated post shall be embedded in a 2-foot-deep by 10 in diameter hole.
 - Wood Fence Post Size and Spacing The post for a wood fence shall be 4" x4" pressure treated posts spaced no more than 4 feet apart for a 6' high fence, 5 feet apart for a 5' high fence, or 6 feet apart for a 4' high fence.
 - Wood Fence Rails For a 6' high wood fence, there shall be three horizontal 2" x 4" pressure treated rails between each post.

Product other than Chain Link or Wood Requirements

 Attach two (2) copies of the Product Approval or two (2) copies of signed and sealed engineered construction detail(s).
