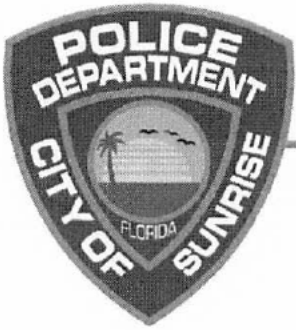




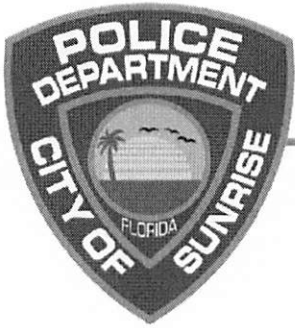

<p>On this date we responded to 1201 Sunset Strip in reference to a disturbance with a gun. When we arrived, we were told by the staff of the "Shop and Save" that there were multiple individuals inside of the store. These individuals were openly displaying firearms, one clerk stated the subject was carrying an AK47. During the time we were reviewing the CCTV footage the clerk motioned to a young, adult black male and a younger black male, stating those were two of the individuals that were involved in the earlier disturbance. At that time I did not observed any weapons. When Officer [REDACTED] and I started to acknowledge and focus on the suspects to determine their involvement, they both quickly exited the store and split up. I soon observed Officer [REDACTED] grab one of the subjects by the arm, which is when the subject began to actively resist [REDACTED] by tensing, bracing, and pulling away from [REDACTED]. I then assisted her by grabbing his other arm in order for Officer [REDACTED] to cuff him. He continued to resist, pulling away, and struggle with both of us, all while he was continually being given commands. During that time I lost my footing, and fell to the ground. After regaining my footing, I gave myself distance from the subject, removed my Taser 7 from its holster, directed it toward the subject, and gave commands to get to the ground. The subject refused to obey these commands, at which point I deployed my taser unsuccessfully, due to only one probe connecting with the subject. A second scuffle (Cont'd)</p>			

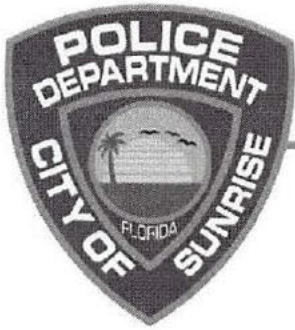

ensued after Officer [REDACTED] re-engaged with the subject. I then advised Officer [REDACTED] to separate from the subject, created distance between the subject and I, and deployed my second taser cartridge successfully. The subject fell to the ground, and was under full muscle incapacitation, at which point Officer [REDACTED] handcuffed the subject. The subject was immediately tended to after being detained by officers. He was then treated by Sunrise Fire Rescue 39 and transported to Florida Medical Center for further treatment and medical clearance.

Subject's Behavior

Subject passively resisted commands upon officers attempting to detain him. Officers then attempted to detain the subject in the parking lot of 1201 Sunset Strip where he actively resisted by tensing, bracing and pulling his arms away when Officer [redacted] tried to put him in handcuffs. Both Officer [redacted] and I then attempted to detain him and he continued to tense, brace, and pull his arms away in order to disrupt our attempt. The three of us engaged in a struggle, where I went to the ground. I soon gave myself distance from the subject, and gave multiple commands to get on the ground. After he refused I announced "Taser" multiple times and deployed the taser probes, however only one probe was successful in making contact. We then re-engaged in a struggle, at which point I separated again and successfully deployed the taser, achieving muscular incapacitation. The subject was immediately handcuffed, and provided aid. During that time he still exhibited agitation.

On 8/10/22 officers responded to Shop & Save convenience store (1201 Sunset Strip) in reference to a male subject with a gun that was arguing with someone inside the store and fled through the back door. Contact was made with the caller and owner of the convenience store [REDACTED] who advised that there were multiple B/M's inside the store carrying guns. Officers were working on reviewing camera footage with [REDACTED] and were able to see multiple B/M's wearing ski masks and the butt of a rifle being held by one B/M in the frame as well as a black handgun being tucked into the waistband of another B/M. While officers were reviewing the cameras the Offender (OF), identified as Christopher Holmes Wilson (B/M, 09/27/03), and his baby mother's brother, only known as "Quay," walked into the convenience store. Hossain pointed at the OF and said that he was the one who ran through the back of the store. Officers asked the OF and Quay to talk outside. Quay began to run away from officers and the OF ignored this officers loud verbal commands to stop and continued to resist by walking away. Officers grabbed the OF to detain him regarding the investigation and he began to brace and tense his arms further resisting officers attempts to detain him in handcuffs.

Ofc. [REDACTED] gave multiple loud verbal commands to get on the ground and the OF continued to resist and ignore the commands. Ofc. [REDACTED] deployed [REDACTED] taser unsuccessfully and officers again attempted to take the OF to the ground where he braced and tensed his arms preventing officers from placing him in handcuffs a second time. Ofc. [REDACTED] deployed [REDACTED] taser a second time which was successful and the OF was taken to the ground where he was ultimately placed in handcuffs. Please see Ofc. [REDACTED] supplement for further. The prongs hit the OF in the right buttocks area and right side mid-back. The OF was placed under arrest and transported to Florida Medical Center for prong removal and medical clearance.

The OF was read his Miranda Rights via prepared card. Post Miranda, the OF advised [REDACTED] The OF said [REDACTED] The OF advised [REDACTED] The OF advised [REDACTED] The OF further advised [REDACTED] The OF [REDACTED] The OF said [REDACTED]

After medical clearance, the OF was transported to BSO Main Jail.

Ofc. [REDACTED] sent [REDACTED] an Evidence.com link to upload the full video for officers to view. Officers were only able to see small parts of the video on scene due to [REDACTED] having trouble playing it. However, from what the officers viewed coupled with [REDACTED] pointing to the OF as the male running through the back of the store, officers had reasonable suspicion to detain the OF pending the investigation. Due to the OF's actions the investigation was not able to be further conducted. The CCTV of the convenience store needs to be reviewed and further follow up is needed with the OF and Quay to determine who the individuals are that are openly carrying firearms in the convenience store.

It should also be noted that during the course of taking the OF into custody my BWC was damaged and is malfunctioning. This was reported to my supervisor.

On August 10, 2022 Officer [REDACTED] and I responded to 1201 Sunset Strip (Shop and Save) in reference to a disturbance involving a weapon. When we arrived it appeared to be business as usual, foot traffic going in and out of the business, and no sign of any disturbance actively occurring.

One of the clerks, (RP2) [REDACTED] advised that there were multiple males inside the store, and there was a gun that was displayed by one of the men. One of the males exited through the back, and the rest through main door located at the front of the business.

It was determined that the incident was delayed at which point we were inspecting the interior CCTV recording. The clerk was having a hard time locating the segment where the disturbance took place. During that time two black males, a younger looking adult, and a juvenile walked in. The clerk then motioned and stated that was two of them.

Officer [REDACTED] and I instantly focused on the two subjects at which point they instantly made their way outside of the business and did not want to engage with us. The two subjects instantly split up, with Officer [REDACTED] attempting to detain the adult male subject that was heading North, and I attempting to detain the juvenile heading East.

I then observed Officer [REDACTED] attempt to restrain the adult male subject, and I redirected to assist [REDACTED] due to the subject thwarting her efforts. I then assisted Ofc. [REDACTED] with detaining the subject, trying to restrain the subjects arms so Ofc. [REDACTED] could apply [REDACTED] handcuffs to the subject. The subject continued to tense up, brace himself, and pull away. This resulted in a "knock-down, drag-out fight". I then lost my footing, and went to the ground.

After re-gaining my footing I removed my Taser 7 from my holster, turned it on, directed it toward the subject, and gave multiple loud commands to get on the ground. After the subject failed to comply, I deployed one set of probes. One probe remained in the back side of the subject and the other went to the ground.

Officer [REDACTED] then engaged the subject again, where another fight to detain the subject ensued. After a short time, I separated from the subject, had Ofc. [REDACTED] disengage, at which point I gained a better tactical position to deploy the taser. I gave the subject another command to get on the ground, and after the command was ignored, fired the second set of probes, both striking the subject.

The subject immediately was incapacitated, went to the ground, and Officer [REDACTED] attempted to handcuff the subject. The subject continued to resist on the ground, not complying with Officer [REDACTED]'s attempts to apply the handcuffs. He was ultimately detained and stopped resisting.

I then tended to the subject, trying to get him into a more comfortable position until fire-rescue responded. He

was very argumentative and did not want to move from where he was, even after I advised him that the ground was hot and I wanted to get him to a place that was cooler.

Sunrise Fire Rescue 39 responded and placed him on the stretcher. One of the probes was still entangled around the suspect and other people at which point I cut the singular probe and placed it into an evidence bag. Officer Luly rode with Sunrise Fire Rescue 39 to Florida Medical Center, and Officer [Redacted] followed. (See Officer [Redacted] Report and Officer Luly's Supplement for probe recovery / documentation of suspect)

I then met with the on scene supervisor (Sgt. Berryman), and explained the events that occurred. I then went back inside the convenience store, and provided [Redacted] an Evidence.com link (via email) to provide the camera footage that we were trying to view.
