Narrative			
<p>Subject was an involved party in a criminal investigation occurring at incident location regarding a physical confrontation that had occurred between Subject and a known family friend, prompting initial police response. Subject was detained (not handcuffed) while this investigation was occurring, sitting on a chair in the backyard of this residence. Subject was verbally aggressive towards officers on scene, making derogatory and threatening comments. In an attempt to deescalate Subject's aggressive state, conversation was initiated regarding Subject's service in the armed forces, prompting further aggression from Subject. Subject became confrontational stating that he has his "DD214" (honorable discharge paperwork) and began challenging officers on scene regarding military service. Subject then stated that he could "walk two steps and prove it" in regards to entering his residence / room to procure the honorable discharge paperwork from within. The room was within close proximity to Subject, with the door open. It had not been cleared of possible weapons inside, and was additionally a potential crime scene regarding the initial incident under investigation. The Subject made several additional statements that he could "take two steps inside" to get his paperwork, to which I replied "you are not going to make it three." Subject then replied "you gonna test me, wanna bet motherfucker, I'm allowed in there," at which time he angrily stood from his chair and aggressively walked into his room.</p>

Narrative - continued

Once Subject entered the room, he turned around in an aggressive manner, with a leashed pit bull dog in his right hand. Subject then began yelling at myself and Ofc [REDACTED] stating numerous times "I'm in. Back up, back up, back up." Subject was given clear verbal commands not to make his pit bull dog move, as it was being held in a manner and position with the means and opportunity to be released on myself and Ofc [REDACTED]. Despite loud verbal commands not to use the dog as a weapon, Subject refused to comply, and took an additional aggressive step towards Ofc [REDACTED], with the pit bull dog in the same position. Subject continued assertively commanding me and Ofc [REDACTED] to "back up." Due to lack of compliance with verbal commands, the aggressive and confrontational demeanor of Subject, and his active physical engagements towards officers despite being given numerous commands, I was fearful that Subject's intent was to release his pit bull dog on myself and Ofc [REDACTED] as a weapon. I then deployed my Taser, striking Subject in the chest. Due to the initial close proximity as a result the small room, coupled with Subject's aggressive step towards me, the successful / ideal range for a taser deployment was diminished. I could observe successful probe contact with Subject's bare torso, however the probe spread was not sufficient to incapacitate Subject or force compliance. For this reason, I then deployed the second cartridge, hoping that this would produce a more effective probe spread to either incapacitate the subject, or gain compliance. It appeared with the second deployment that one probe made contact close to the other two probes, and one probe struck Subject's left hand. Def was continuously given loud verbal commands to "get on the ground," refusing these commands. Ultimately, through the redeployment of additional Taser cycles, it appeared that the Subject was in physical discomfort resulting from the circuit between the Subject's torso and left hand. After numerous cycle redeployments, backed with constant loud verbal commands to "get on the ground," Subject ultimately complied. Subject then refused to provide his hands, tensing his arms underneath his body. I observed Ofc [REDACTED] and Ofc Weir, who was now assisting in handcuffing Subject, struggling to get his left arm out from underneath his chest, where he was holding it. Due to concern that the Taser was no longer effective (as it was only partially effective from the initial deployment) I continued to cycle it several times, pausing while I gave commands for the Subject to get his hand out. Verbal commands and physical attempts for Subject to get his hand out were ineffective, at which time I kicked Subject in his left shoulder / upper torso, trying to free his hand / arm from underneath. I then bent down to gain control of Subject's right arm / hand. With my left hand controlling Subject's right hand, I then issued verbal commands for Subject to get his other hand out from underneath him, while drive stunning the Subject in the upper part of his back for pain compliance purposes. After several drive stuns, Ofc Weir advised that he had gained control of Subject's hand at which time I disengaged the still cycling Taser from Subject's back, and then discontinued use. Subject was then successfully placed in handcuffs, where he immediately ceased any additional physical or verbal resistance. Subject was charged with two counts of Aggravated Assault - LEO, and for Resisting an Officer Without Violence (once the dog had run away). Incident captured on BWC.

Subject was verbally aggressive and confrontational with Officers. Subject entered his room, which was part of an active investigation and which had not been cleared for threats / weapons. Subject was armed with a pit bull dog, who he was holding in an aggressive manner while loudly yelling at myself and Ofc [Redacted] to "back up." Subject continued yelling this, and appeared to become angrier, ultimately stepping aggressively towards officers while still holding the dog in a position that appeared as if he intended to use the dog as a weapon. Subject refused to comply with verbal commands prior to, or after deployment of Taser.

Initial redeployment due to noticeable insufficient initial contact, although probe contact was successful, due to close proximity the probe spread was insufficient. Second cartridge deployed resulted in similar outcome, however appeared to have contact with Subject's hand as well. Subject was not incapacitated and would not comply with commands. I continued to cycle / re-energize until Subject complied, hoping that Subject movement may provide a more effective circuit.

On stated date and time I was dispatched to the incident location in reference to a burglary with a battery. The reporter (defendant's mother), Alice-Marie Ford, [REDACTED] advising a family friend, [REDACTED] came into the residence without invitation and that her son, (defendant) Manuel E. Hernandez, hit him. [REDACTED] now needed medical attention.

Upon arrival, officers met with Manuel at the side gate. He was extremely irate toward police officers and stated that he did not need us, that he needed the paramedics. At Manuel's side, was a large mixed-breed dog. We eventually convinced Manuel that the paramedics won't come to assist [REDACTED] as long as he is this irate. We also asked him to the secure the dog so that we could enter to render aid to [REDACTED]

Once we were able to enter, we found [REDACTED] sitting in a chair in the screen-in rear patio of the home. [REDACTED]'s head and face area was covered in blood and he appeared to have several abrasions and lacerations to the face and the head area (top and back of). Ofc. Parnfielo and I assisted [REDACTED] to the front of the home where he was taken to Broward Hospital by Sunrise Rescue.

I then spoke to Alice-Marie and her husband, Melvin Mawhinney, about the incident. They informed me that they had brought the dog inside and closed up the house for the night and went to bed. All the lights were turned off except the dining room light. Manuel was not at home at this time. A little while later, they awoke to commotion in the patio area. They went outside and saw [REDACTED] on the floor and Manuel distraught that he had just attacked his friend by mistake.

I then spoke to Manuel. He informed me that he was at Lombardi's with [REDACTED] having a few drinks. They had a discussion of current events, which led to a disagreement. Manuel told [REDACTED] that he did not want to see him at his mother's home anymore. The men paid their bill and left. Manuel was dropped off at the home by an acquaintance. When he walked around the back to patio where he stays, he saw a dark figure standing inside the patio. Startled, Manuel reacted to the unknown figure and struck the person several times. Not until after the lights came on, did Manuel realize that the person he attacked was his friend, [REDACTED]. Manuel assured me that if h had known who it was, he never would have struck [REDACTED]. Manuel further informed me that [REDACTED] did not have access to the home (e.g. a key), was not supposed to be there, and is usually never there late at night.

I then spoke to the mother and step-father again to confirm this information. While I was speaking to them, I heard commotion in the back yard and subsequently discovered that Manuel had been exposed to a taser. See supplement by [REDACTED]. Manuel was subsequently arrested for Aggravated Assault on a law enforcement officer and resisting without violence. He was medically cleared at FL Medical Center, brought the Sunrise PD while paperwork was completed before being transported to BSO Main Jail.

See supplement by [REDACTED]. CID responded and continued the investigation for the initial incident. Crime Scene operator Robison responded and took pictures of Manuel's taser probe hits. Said probes were placed into evidence by Ofc. Ellis.

I responded to the incident location as an additional backup officer reference the report of an Occupied Residential Burglary. Upon my arrival there were several officers already on scene who were communicating with a bald white male, later identified as Manuel E. Hernandez d.o.b. (02/12/1968), who was standing inside the chain link fence located on the west side of the residence. Hernandez was very agitated and belligerent with officers on scene and was holding a large, tan in color dog (approx. the size of a German Shepherd).

Hernandez, after being asked several times to secure his large dog, walked to the rear of the residence and sat on a patio chair while continuing to hold said dog. Hernandez began a verbal onslaught of vulgarity directed toward officers, which continued for several minutes. During said tirade Hernandez stated, "I'll take two steps and go inside to get my DD214." After [Redacted] responded, indicating that would not happen, Hernandez stated, "You gonna test me?" It was at this time that Hernandez abruptly rose from his chair and briskly walked with his dog to the patio door entrance of the residence. With [Redacted] I hastily made my way to that location but Hernandez had already made entry into the aforementioned open door, not knowing of any possible weapons that may be located in this space. Hernandez then abruptly turned and faced [Redacted] and I (who were both standing in the doorway at the time) while holding the collar of his large dog in an aggressive manner or what I perceived as that of someone who was preparing to have his dog attack. The dog's attention was focused on [Redacted] and I with his ears erect. I pulled my department issued sidearm and pointed same at the dog while giving verbal commands to Hernandez to secure the dog or the dog would be shot. Hernandez did not comply and it was at this time that [Redacted] deployed his department issued Taser to the torso area of Hernandez. Hernandez was not subdued by this and a second Taser deployment was made striking Hernandez's torso area as well. Hernandez released his dog, which ran and hid deeper in the room before ultimately running out of the patio area. It was at this time that I holstered my sidearm and retrieved my department issued OC spray. I gave several loud, repetitive, verbal commands to Hernandez to get on the ground. Reluctantly, Hernandez complied and I approached him, securing his legs and hip area while additional officers secured him in handcuffs.

I assisted in escorting Hernandez to the front of the residence to await Sunrise Fire / Rescue for treatment regarding the aforementioned Taser deployment.

On April 12, 2021, I responded to 11910 Nw 39th Street as a back up officer. Upon arrival, the subject was hostile and extremely aggressive toward Police Officers- including myself. The subject was irate, and was directed by [redacted] to remain on the outside patio while Officer Schmidt conducts his investigation. The subject stood up, said, "what, you want to test me Mother Fucker, I'm allowed in there", and advanced toward the enclosed patio, dragging his dog behind him. [redacted] and [redacted] followed closed behind the subject, meeting at the door opening of the patio. I, standing to the right of [redacted] just outside the door frame, observed the subject turn around, tense his body, bowed out his chest, grabbed his dog and advanced toward [redacted] and [redacted]. [redacted] gave loud and clear commands, to which the subject did not comply. [redacted] then tased the subject. Even after being tased, the subject was still not complying. [redacted] tased the subject for a second time. The subject still not complying right away, was ultimately escorted to the ground and was detained in handcuffs. The subject was escorted from the patio to the driveway at the front of the house for Rescue/medical attention. I took pictures of the taser prong placement, and any injuries on the subject and submitted via AvailWeb.

Once the scene was safe to enter, Rescue 48 responded to treat one of the individuals on scene who was identified as [REDACTED]. Rescue 48 advised that they were treating [REDACTED] as a level 2 trauma where he would be transported to Broward General. At that time, I followed rescue to Broward General.

Once at Broward General I took pictures of [REDACTED]'s injuries which were uploaded to evidence. [REDACTED] was treated by the trauma team at Broward General. After receiving a CAT Scan, it was determined that [REDACTED] suffered a fractured nose, bleeding on the left side of the brain, and 2 broken ribs. The team at Broward General advised that [REDACTED]'s injuries were not life threatening but that he would be transferred to ICU.

I stayed with [REDACTED] until Detective Burstein and Detective Haggard arrived to take a statement. I also waited for Crime Scene Tech Robison who also photographed [REDACTED] and took the clothes he was wearing.

On 4/12/21 I responded to 11910 NW 39 St to assist in a possible burglary / battery investigation. On scene I observed one of the involved parties, a 74 year old man, awaiting Sunrise Rescue transport due to head injuries that he received from a fight with another individual, later identified as Manuel Hernandez, at the listed location.

To the rear of the residence I could hear a disturbance, with one individual loudly yelling at officers who were in contact with him. I responded to the rear of the residence and observed a white male, identified as Manuel Hernandez, sitting in a chair in the middle of the back yard. At Hernandez's side was a tan in color pit bull dog.

Hernandez was verbally aggressive towards officers on scene, making derogatory and threatening comments. During the course of his tirade, Hernandez made numerous references to having been in the military, and having been "honorably discharged." Without any particular engagement by officers on scene, Hernandez would repeatedly become irate and would pick different topics to begin insulting officers about.

In an attempt to de-escalate Hernandez's aggressive state, I initiated conversation with Hernandez regarding service in the armed forces, specifically asking him which war he fought in. Rather than have the desired effect of providing Hernandez with something that he was proud of to talk about, this prompted further aggression from Hernandez, to which he replied "your mamas war." Hernandez then continued to fixate on the fact that had had been honorably discharged, and that he had his "DD214" form to prove this. Hernandez then stated that he could "walk two steps and prove it" in regards to entering his residence / room to procure honorable discharge paperwork from within.

The initial investigation regarding the burglary allegations was ongoing at this time. It was not known if the battery committed against the other involved party, a known family friend, was in defense, or a criminal attack, therefore the bedroom was an active crime scene. Additionally, the rooms contents were unknown. Due to Hernandez's apparent instability, aggressive and irate manner and his repeated mention of the fact that he had served in the military, there was concern of what Hernandez may equip himself with, should he be able to enter the room.

After repeating several times that he could "take two steps and prove it," I explained to Hernandez that he "wouldn't make it three," indicating that he would not be allowed into his room, and would be stopped if he made an attempt. To this, Hernandez replied "you gonna test me? Wanna bet motherfucker, I'm allowed in there," at which time he angrily stood from his chair and aggressively walked into his room, with the leashed pit bull dog following him. Once Hernandez entered the room, he turned around in an aggressive manner, with the leashed pit bull dog in his right hand. Hernandez then began yelling at me and [Redacted] stating numerous times

in an increasingly aggressive tone "I'm in. Back up, back up, back up."

Hernandez was given clear verbal commands by [REDACTED] not to make his pit bull dog move, as it was being held in a manner and position with the means and opportunity to be released on me and [REDACTED]. Despite loud verbal commands, Hernandez refused to comply, and took an additional aggressive step towards me and [REDACTED] with the pit bull dog in the same position. Due to lack of compliance with verbal commands, the aggressive and confrontational demeanor of Hernandez, and his active physical engagements towards officers despite being given numerous commands, I was fearful that Hernandez's intent was to release his pit bull dog on me and [REDACTED] as a weapon.

I then deployed my department issued Taser, striking Hernandez in the chest. Due to the close proximity, further decreased by Hernandez's final "lunge" towards me and [REDACTED] the probe spread from this deployment was not far enough apart to cause incapacitation, striking Hernandez with approximately a one foot spread from his upper chest to his abdomen. Recognizing this, I deployed the second cartridge from my Taser, which appeared to have more of a physical effect on Hernandez, but also failed to achieve a desired probe spread and therefore failed to achieve incapacitation.

Although these deployments did not achieve physical incapacitation, the situation did frighten the pit bull dog into hiding in the room. This also caused Hernandez to back further into the room. Hernandez was continuously given loud verbal commands to "get on the ground," refusing these commands. Ultimately, through the redeployment of additional Taser cycles, Hernandez complied with commands to get on the ground, but refused to provide his hands, tensing his arms underneath his body. I was able to get a hold of Hernandez's right arm and get his hand behind his back, however he would not release his left hand from underneath his chest. While continuing to provide verbal commands, I then administered several drive stuns to the upper left shoulder / back area of Hernandez in an attempt to gain compliance. Ultimately, [REDACTED] and Ofc Weir were able to get Hernandez's hand out from underneath him, and place him in handcuffs.

Hernandez was placed under arrest for Aggravated Assault LEO (X2) and Resisting an Officer Without Violence.

Hernandez was medically cleared for Taser contact and released to the custody of BSO Corrections Deputies.

See Ofc Schmidt's report for additional details.

Two of the Taser probes were removed by staff at Westside Regional Hospital and transferred to Ofc Ellis' custody. Ofc Ellis placed these probes in Sunrise Evidence. The other two probes did strike Hernandez, however it appeared that he ripped them out during his resistance. These probes were located by Det Gindlesperger on scene and placed into Sunrise Evidence.

Photographs were taken of Hernandez's injuries. See supplements / report for details.

On April 12, 2021, Sunrise Police responded to 11910 NW 39th St. in reference to a call for medical attention. The caller advised that a family friend (redacted) unknowingly came into the residence, was mistaken for an intruder, and beaten up by Manuel Hernandez. (redacted) was transported to Broward General Hospital.

While officers were on scene conducting an investigation, Manuel became combative, was tased, and ultimately arrested.

I was contacted by Detective Sgt. Reardon in reference to possible felony battery against (redacted). I responded to Broward General Hospital and met with (redacted) to discuss the incident. On a sworn-taped statement (redacted) stated that the following:

He was with Manuel at Lombardi's Pizza when Manuel became upset with him and left. (redacted) went on to say that Manuel lives in the back of his parents house and has his own rear entrance. (redacted) has always had permission to come and go as he pleases at Manuel's house.

(redacted) arrived at Manuel's house but Manuel was not there. He decided to wait in Manuel's room for him to return. When Manuel came home, he immediately attacked (redacted)

(redacted) sustained a broken nose, several lacerations, and small brain bleed from the attack.

(redacted) stated that he does not want to press any charges for the felony battery.

I have reviewed the report and supplements from the responding officers, charges related to Manuel's arrest (aggravated assault and resisting without violence) will be filed with the SAO. This case is cleared by arrest.

The defendant was arrested and booked. A review of the UCR guidelines pertaining to this case reveals that the offender has been arrested and charged with the offense. This case will be presented to the State's Attorney Office for final disposition.

On Tuesday, April 13, 2021, Sergeant R. Reardon of the Sunrise Police Criminal Investigation Section contacted me in reference to an aggravated assault investigation. Sergeant Reardon requested that I respond to 11910 NW 39 Street in Sunrise, Florida, to assist in the investigation.

I responded to 11910 NW 39 Street and met with Sergeant M. Hudson, Sergeant Reardon, Detective C. Campanelli and Detective M. Bulzone. Sergeant Hudson advised that Manuel Hernandez, 2/12/1968 came home and found [redacted] in his bedroom. A physical altercation took place between Hernandez and [redacted] resulting in Sunrise Fire/Rescue transporting [redacted] to Broward Health Medical Center. It was reported that after the incident took place [redacted] deployed his taser, striking Hernandez in the chest. Sergeant Reardon requested that I document and search Hernandez's bedroom (back patio).

Using a Nikon D750 digital camera, I photographed the scene as I found it. The scene was described as the back patio on the south side of the residence, which was being used as a bedroom. A search of the scene revealed the following:

In an effort to obtain DNA, I used sterile cotton swabs to collect a sample from suspected blood stains on the floor mat (item #6), PVC pipe (item #7) and TV stand (item #8).

I cleared the scene and responded to 10440 W. Oakland Park Blvd. (Sunrise Public Safety Building Sally Port) and met with Detective Campanelli and Manuel Hernandez. I photographed Hernandez as I found him. I observed three band-aids on Hernandez's chest and one band-aid on Hernandez's stomach, which reportedly was from the taser contact. Hernandez advised that he had no other injuries.

I cleared the Sally Port and responded to Broward Health Medical Center and met [redacted] I photographed [redacted] and the injuries he reportedly sustained during the incident. I observed a red contusion on the left side of [redacted] face, which covered his eye, cheek, forehead and nose. I observed a laceration on [redacted] s left cheek, which was approximately one and a half centimeters in length. I observed two staples in the top back of [redacted] s head. I observed an abrasion on [redacted] right elbow that was approximately one centimeter wide by one and a half centimeters long. I collected the following items from the hospital, which belonged to [redacted]



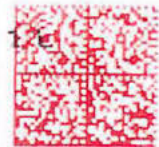

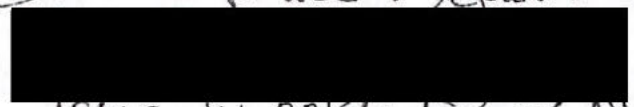
