

Natural Gas Benefits



The City of Sunrise Utilities Department provides natural gas service to nearly 10,000 local homes and businesses. As the only City-owned gas utility in south Florida, we're excited to share the benefits of natural gas. For example, natural gas is:

- **Green.** Natural gas is the cleanest-burning fuel. Homes that rely on natural gas emit less carbon than homes that use electricity.
- **Reliable.** Because natural gas reaches your home through an underground pipeline, loss of service is extremely rare. You can enjoy hot showers and home-cooked meals even when the electricity goes out.
- **A Great Value.** Natural gas appliances mean endless hot water, gourmet-quality cooking precision, and faster-drying laundry. They typically have a longer life span than electric appliances, and can cost only half as much to operate.

Best of all, the City of Sunrise offers **Energy Conservation Rebates** that can make gas appliances even more cost effective. For new residential customers, this can mean savings of up to \$525 on the cost of a gas water heater, and up to \$100 each on the purchase of a gas-powered clothes dryer and kitchen range.*
