<p>While conducting routine patrol, I observed a white Honda accord bearing Florida tag 09AKHL parked in front of 3060 NW 60th Av, Brotherhood Market. A black male was observed walking up to the vehicle and sitting in the passenger seat of the vehicle while the driver walked inside the store. Shortly after, the passenger was observed exiting the passenger side while the driver was inside the store, appearing to have possibly conducted a narcotics sale with me present. A traffic stop was conducted on the white Honda, which was observed leaving the parking lot and not signaling a right-hand turn onto NW 60th Ave. Contact was made with the driver/defendant, who was identified as Vincent Keith Rozier Jr, who was informed of the reason for the stop and my suspicion of possible narcotics being sold. The defendant denied any narcotics in the vehicle and appeared extremely nervous, with his hands shaking and unclear speech.</p>

**Narrative - continued**

The defendant was asked to exit the vehicle, to which he complied while conducting a pat down for weapons. I felt an unknown object on the defendant's waist. The defendant proceeded to push away and attempt to flee the area on foot. A quick pursuit ensued through the parking lot, where I told the defendant numerous times to stop running, or he would be tased; the defendant continued to ignore my loud verbal command and, as a result, was tased. The defendant proceeded to roll on the ground causing the taser prongs to fall off, rendering the taser ineffective. The defendant then proceeded to get back up, reach into his waist area, remove numerous items from his waist, and throw them in an attempt to discard them while continuing to ignore my verbal commands. The defendant was ultimately placed into handcuffs after a brief struggle.

Upon search of the immediate area, a blue scale with a white powdery substance was observed on the ground, as well as a brown wallet with the defendant's credit cards. It is to be noted the white powdery substance resembled powdered cocaine but could not be tested at the time of the arrest.

Taser deployment results: On the first cartridge deployed one of the prong made contact with the defendant's upper back, while the other prong missed. In the second deployment, both prongs made contact with the defendant below the belt line, one on the subject's butt and the other lower thigh area. After the second deployment, the taser became effective, causing the subject to fall forward.

On Monday, August 22, 2022, the above defendant knowingly and intentionally committed the following offenses per Florida state statutes 843.02 and 918.13.

To wit: While conducting routine patrol, I observed a white Honda accord bearing Florida tag 09AKHL parked in front of 3060 NW 60th Av, Brotherhood Market. A black male was observed walking up to the vehicle and sitting in the passenger seat of the vehicle while the driver walked inside the store. Shortly after, the passenger was observed exiting the passenger side while the driver was inside the store, appearing to have possibly conducted a narcotics sale with me present.

A traffic stop was conducted on the white Honda, which was observed leaving the parking lot and not signaling a right-hand turn onto NW 60th Ave. Contact was made with the driver/defendant, who was identified as Vincent Keith Rozier Jr, who was informed of the reason for the stop and my suspicion of possible narcotics being sold. The defendant denied any narcotics in the vehicle and appeared extremely nervous, with his hands shaking and had unclear speech.

The defendant was asked to exit the vehicle, to which he complied, while conducting a pat down for weapons. I felt an unknown object on the defendant's waist. At that time, the defendant immediately proceeded to push away from me and attempted to flee the area on foot. A quick pursuit ensued through the parking lot, where I told the defendant numerous times to stop running, or he would be tased; the defendant continued to ignore my loud verbal command and as a result, was tased. The defendant proceeded to roll on the ground causing the taser prongs to fall off, rendering the taser ineffective. The defendant then proceeded to get back up, reach into his waist area, remove numerous items from his waist, and throw them in an attempt to discard them while continuing to ignore my verbal commands. The defendant was ultimately placed into handcuffs after a brief struggle.

During the interaction with the defendant, I was wearing my department-issued class B uniform with clear police badging and police insignia.

Upon search of the immediate area, a blue scale with a white powdery substance was observed on the ground, as well as a brown wallet with the defendant's credit cards. Its to be noted the white powdery substance resembled powdered cocaine but could not be tested at the time of the arrest.

Based on the facts and circumstances, the defendant was issued a Uniform Traffic Citation for failing to signal a righthand turn UTC number AG78EWE and was placed under arrest for resisting arrest and tampering with evidence. The defendant was transported to Florida Medical Center for Medical clearance and later transported to Broward County Main Jail.

The defendant's vehicle was towed from the scene by Westway Towing. The scale was collected and placed into Sunrise Police Property and Evidence pending lab results. It is to be noted the defendant had an extremely high blood pressure reading while at the hospital, indicating he may have ingested narcotics per the nurse at Florida Medical Center.
