<p>A be on the lookout was disseminated by Detective Haggard for a black male who committed a lewd act on a female inside of the Primark retail store. Based on the description (Pirates hat, Grey shirt, Khaki pants) given by Detective Haggard, I remained alert and observant of the suspect's presence. I located a subject who matched the exact description and requested he speak with me. I told the suspect that officers were conducting an investigation and asked for his name, which he refused to give after multiple requests. I told the suspect he was not free to leave.</p> <p>-The suspect ignored my commands, pushed my extended arm away from his chest, and started to run away.</p> <p>-A very short foot pursuit took place. I caught the suspect and took him to the ground, so he could no longer flee, using body positioning.</p> <p>-Once on the ground, the subject continued pulling and bracing his arms to keep me from gaining physical control</p> <p>-Ultimately, I was able to handcuff the suspect and gain physical compliance without further incident</p>

On 08/26/2022 at 1847 hours I responded to a call put out by BSO dispatch as Lewd and Lascivious acts at the location of 12801 W Sunrise Blvd- Primark. Given the victim's age the call was later reclassified as a battery. I arrived to the scene after an arrest was made of the suspect in question.

Upon arrival I spoke with OFC D. Schwab who advised the following: (S1) Devon Samaroo entered the Primark store located at 12801 W Sunrise Blvd. While walking in the store Devon approached (V1) [REDACTED] who was shopping in the lingerie section of the store. Devon walked in close proximity to [REDACTED] and proceeded to intentionally touch [REDACTED]'s right butt cheek with his left hand. Devon with an open hand slid his hand across her buttocks, caressing her right buttocks cheek as he walked past her. [REDACTED] became startled when this occurred and immediately looked up at the defendant. Devon at that point threw his hands up and walked around [REDACTED] once more before walking out of the store. [REDACTED] was then approached by two other individuals who stated that they saw Devon taking pictures of them. [REDACTED] then began to take a video of Devon as he walked out of the store. [REDACTED] then contacted Primark Management who in turn notified Mall Security and the Sunrise Police. Det. Haggard responded to Primark and spoke with [REDACTED]. He was given a description of Devon and issued a BOLO (Black male wearing Khaki pants, Black shirt, Black hat with the letter P, Blue mask and glasses).

[REDACTED] who was working an off-duty detail at the Sawgrass Mills Mall was able to locate Devon, who exactly matched the BOLO given [REDACTED], who was in full Class B uniform with Sunrise Insignia, then made contact with Devon. [REDACTED] informed Devon that he was not free to leave and that an investigation was being conducted. When he asked the defendant to identify himself, Devon refused to do so. Devon then turned and attempted to flee from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was able to grab hold of Devon's shirt. Devon began to struggle with [REDACTED] at which time he was escorted to the ground so that better control could be achieved. Ultimately other officers responded and took Devon into custody.

After Devon had been taken into custody, a show up was conducted with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] positively identified Devon as the subject that had touched her.

I then spoke with Detective Haggard who advised the following: Det. Haggard advised he reviewed CCTV footage of the incident from Primark. In the footage Devon was observed passing by [REDACTED] in close proximity. As Devon passed by [REDACTED] is seen immediately looking at Devon. Devon was then observed walking around the victim once more prior to leaving the area.

[REDACTED] provided a full taped statement to Det. Haggard in regards to the incident. [REDACTED] stated that she did wish to pursue charges for the Battery.

I then spoke Devon. Devon was read Miranda warnings from a prepared text card. Post Miranda Devon advised the [REDACTED]

While in custody, I began to notice Devon Moving awkwardly in the backseat of the patrol car. I asked Devon if he was alright, to which Devon advised he was having trouble breathing. Devon also advised when he is in stressful situations his epileptic seizures occur. Fire rescue was called to our location and Devon was transported by rescue 92, to Cleveland Clinic for medical issues. I rode with Devon in the fire rescue truck, while Ofc. Dewese followed. Devon was medically cleared by hospital staff, and he was ultimately transported to BSO main jail.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

On August 26, 2022, at approximately 1847 hours, Detective Haggard disseminated a be on the lookout (BOLO) for a black male. The BOLO was regarding the male battering a female at the Primark retail store. I observed a male suspect who matched the description (Pirates hat, grey shirt, khaki pants) given in the BOLO and stopped him. I asked the suspect for his name multiple times and told him he was not free to go. The suspect attempted to flee from me by running a short distance, but I quickly gained control of him and escorted him to the ground to prevent him from trying to flee again. Assisting officers responded and took custody of the suspect. The suspect, later identified as Devon Samaroo, claimed no injury from my response to his resistance. I completed a Response to Resistance Report for the incident. See the original incident report, body-worn camera, and mall surveillance footage for further on the incident.
