Narrative

On the above date and time I responded to the area of 4600 N Pine Island Rd in response to Plantation Police

Department requesting assistance. Plantation Police was working an incident in their city in the area of 1300

NW 108th Ave. in which multiple auto burglaries took place. During that call, the suspect vehicle, a grey Honda

Civic fled from Plantation Police officers who had their flashing emergency lights and siren activated. The Civic

continued to travel while fleeing officers, and ultimately stopped at 4800 N Pine Island Rd. Sunrise. As the

vehicle stopped, four subjects bailed from the vehicle and began to flee from officers on foot. All 4 subjects

were suspected of multiple burglaries. Sunrise Police Road Patrol responded to the scene and assisted in

establishing a perimeter around the neighborhood. Plantation Police K9 apprehended one fleeing suspect soon

after the suspect fled from the vehicle, the other 3 were suspected to be actively hiding within the perimeter.

I responded to the scene to assist Plantation Police K9 search for the remaining outstanding burglary suspects.

Based on the felony offense committed, coupled with the active resistance demonstrated by the fleeing suspects,

I deployed K9 Rendor utilizing a tracking harness and 15' lead in an effort to locate the hidden suspects. Prior to beginning my search with K9 Rendor I gave two very loud K9 announcements at the beginning of my search at

4691 N Pine Island Rd. I began my search with K9 Rendor and began to check the immediate area and front porches of the townhouse building. While completing my search I continued to give intermittent K9 warnings to any suspects that might be hiding nearby.

K9 Rendor and I entered into the front porch of 4709 N Pine Island Rd. while searching for the hidden suspects. I initially did not notice anything out of the ordinary and began to leave the front porch. As I was leaving I noticed that K9 Rendor began to demonstrate a strong change of behavior, and began to show heightened interest to the area of two nearby trashcans. I began to inspect the trashcans and began to tip each one to test the weight of the cans. While inspecting the second can, the trashcan tipped over in a direction away from me and the can lid opened. As the lid opened, I observed a subject actively concealing himself within the base of the can remaining motionless. I gave the subject three orders to come out and the subject did not comply.

Fearing that the hidden burglary subject could possibly be armed, and based on the subject's continued resistance by actively concealing himself, I ordered K9 Rendor to apprehend the suspect. K9 Rendor made contact with the suspects left bicep area and held the suspect in place, safely and effectively apprehending the suspect and preventing any further attempts to resist arrest. K9 Rendor was immediately removed from the point of contact as soon as I was able to see the suspect's hands and the suspect was detained in handcuffs by Ofc.

Jossfolk without further incident. It should be noted that the suspect was located only 3 doors away from where I gave my initial K9 announcements at the beginning of my search.

It should be noted that during this time the suspect was armed with a black folding knife which was concealed within the suspects waistband. The knife was recovered and given to Plantation Police for evidence. The suspect was then identified as Jacob Shermett (09/12/2006). I also located a multicolored bag within the trashcan that contained Cannabis paraphernalia. The bag belonged to the suspect and it was entered into SPD Evidence.

Sunrise Fire Rescue 72 responded to the scene and transported the suspect to Coral Springs Medical Center for a small puncture and abrasions sustained during the apprehension. The suspect was treated by Dr. Berrios at the hospital and medically cleared for jail.

The defendant was subsequently charged with six (6) counts of Burglary, Resisting Arrest without Violence,
Loitering and Prowling, and Petit Theft by Plantation Police. Ultimately, the remaining suspects were also
located and placed under arrest for the charges of Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding, multiple counts of Burglary,
