Plantation Police was working an incident in their city in the area of 1300 NW 108th Ave. in which multiple auto burglaries took place. During that call, the suspect vehicle, a grey Honda Civic fled from Plantation Police officers who had their flashing emergency lights and siren activated. The Civic continued to travel while fleeing officers, and ultimately stopped at 4800 N Pine Island Rd. Sunrise. As the vehicle stopped, four subjects bailed from the vehicle and began to flee from officers on foot. All 4 subjects were suspected of multiple burglaries. Sunrise Police Road Patrol responded to the scene and assisted in establishing a perimeter around the neighborhood.
