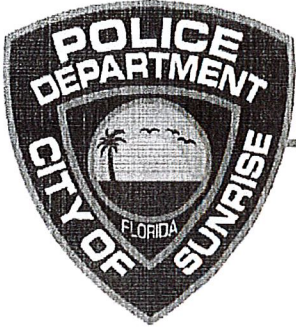

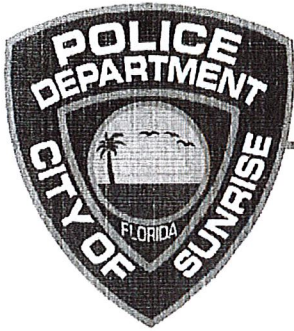

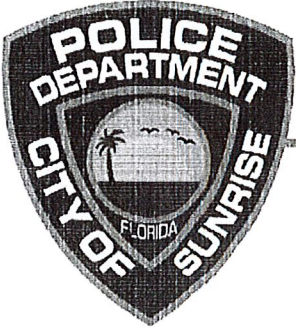

On 9/26/2022 at approximately 1640 hours, Brandsmart detail Officer M. Medina advised (via Sunrise PD radio transmission) that she was flagged down, by Brandsmart LP (IO) Mia Johnson, in reference to a male that was in the Avenue 4, public Men's restrooms, masturbating. It should be noted the LP was flagged down by, (VI / WI) [REDACTED]

While enroute to the area, Officers M. Medina and D. Williams advised that the suspect, later identified as (OF) Kevin Halvorsen (via FL DL) was apprehended. Upon my arrival to the scene, Officer Medina (in full class B uniforms with Sunrise PD insignia) advised that as she arrived Halvorsen took flight and ignored multiple lawful commands to stop. Please see Officers Medina and D. Williams' supplements for further.

[REDACTED] advised the following: At approximately 1625 hours, while sitting down to use the restroom, he observed Halvorsen stealthfully crouch down on his left knee, peak his head underneath the stall divider and make a masturbating motion. At no point did [REDACTED] see Halvorsen's actual penis [REDACTED] only witnessed the masturbating motion. After making eye contact, it appeared that Halvorsen realized and attempted flee the area [REDACTED] began to follow Halvorsen while trying to get in touch with Mall Security, until ultimately he was able to inform Johnson of what occurred [REDACTED] advised that at no point did Halvorsen touch him or speak to him nor did he see the use of any devices that may have recorded him. This indecent act took place with the obvious intent to secretly observe the victim's private areas as he used the restroom.

Officer St. Preux along with [REDACTED] walked back to the restrooms where the original incident occurred to capture the location via BWC. The restroom, when entered has a total of 4 individual stalls with dividers and doors; 2 regular use stalls and 2 handicap stalls. When you enter the restroom area, the 2 handicap stalls are to the right hand side. Halvorsen was in the last handicap stall, closest to the wall, as [REDACTED] was in the next stall over; the left of Halvorsen's stall.

[REDACTED] whom was also on scene during Halvorsen's apprehension positively identified him as the same person that was inside of the stalls.

[REDACTED] mother, (IO) Paola Barrera, whom responded to the mall to pick him up, confirmed she desires prosecution on behalf of her son [REDACTED] did also confirm he desires prosecution.

Search incident to arrest, a small clear baggie, containing small clear/white rock like substance was located in his right pants pocket. Also located was a clear pipe with a round end commonly used to smoke narcotics. The substance field tested positive for Methamphetamine with an approximate weight of 2.03 grams. These items were collected and submitted into SPD evidence by Officer D. Williams.

Halvorsen did sustain a facial laceration to his lip while being apprehended. Sunrise Fire Rescue 92 / run #11580 responded and transported him to Cleveland Clinic for medical clearance. Officer Jossfolk rode with SFR to the hospital. Please see his supplement for further.

While filling out the BSO inmate property receipt, a black pen was discovered which included a small camera lens. Inside the pen was an SD card, commonly used as storage for recording devices. Halvorsen's cellphone and camera pen were subsequently submitted directly to Detective Bautista for evidence submission, along with a Sunrise Property Receipt.

Halvorsen was ultimately admitted to Cleveland Clinic, RM 3T-21, for observation. BSO responded and relieved SPD officers.

Halvorsen was arrested for the listed charges and the PC affidavit was dropped off at BSO Main Jail. Please note a ADD CHARGE PC was dropped off to amend the resisting with violence, clerical error, to resisting WITHOUT violence. Also the Voyeurism charge was listed on the add charge PC as well.

Contact with Mall Security for additional CCTV footage was made and an Evidence.com link was provided.

Nothing further.

On 09/26/2022, I responded to 12801 W Sunrise Blvd, Brandsmart, in reference to an officer being in a physical altercation with a subject.

Upon arrival, the subject later identified as (OF) Kevin Halvorsen, was already detained. I assisted officers in keeping the subject subdued on the ground until Sunrise Fire Rescue arrived to transport Kevin to the hospital due to his injuries. I was selected to ride in rescue with Kevin due to his erratic and combative behavior when officers initially made contact with him as well as when he was detained.

During the course of the ride with Fire Rescue to Cleveland Clinic, Kevin spontaneously uttered multiple times to fire Rescue that his shoulder injury was pre-existing since approximately 2 months ago. Kevin stated his lips were the only injury he received from being in contact with officers.

Upon arrival at Cleveland Clinic, I overlooked Kevin in case of a sudden burst of erratic behavior and I also read Kevin his Miranda Warning. Kevin waived his rights but did not want to speak at the moment due to him being in severe pain. As time went on and Kevin relaxed due to the medications provided by the hospital staff and nurses, I attempted to ask Kevin questions in reference to the incident. At this point, Kevin refused to talk to me which halted my questioning for the entirety of my involvement with the case.

I then requested Kevin to explain to me specifically on BWC what injuries he suffered from being in contact with officers. Kevin stated his shoulder injury was pre-existing and that his lip injury was the only other pain he was feeling. Kevin pointed at his lips for the BWC to further show the extent to which his lips were damaged.

I overlooked Kevin at the hospital until I was relieved by an alpha shift officer. This will conclude my involvement in the case.

Regarding the above-listed case, I responded to the scene in reference to a subject running from Officer Medina (IBM-3769) after actively committing a lewd and lascivious act.

Prior to my arrival on the scene, Officer Medina (IBM-3769) advised that the suspect was running from her in an attempt at fleeing from law enforcement. Upon contact with the subject, he actively started bracing, tensing, and pulling from officers while attempting to detain him in handcuffs. I utilized a straight arm take down, resulting in the subject hitting his facial area on the pavement, causing a minor laceration to his lip. Having ultimately gained control of the subject, he was safely detained pending further investigation.

Having established probable cause and conducting a search incident to arrest, located in the subject's smaller right pants pocket was a manila envelope containing a clear plastic baggie with a white crystal substance (Field tested Positive for Meth, utilizing a department-issued test kit and weighing approximately 2.03 grams packaged). Also located in the pocket was a clear glass pipe containing residue of the crystal substance (Residue also field tested positive for Meth).

The subject was transported by Sunrise Fire Rescue to Cleveland Clinic for on-scene injury treatment and medical clearance, I submitted the following evidence into Sunrise Police Evidence Locker #18:

- 2 Small brown bottles containing unknown liquids (to be destroyed)
-1 Glass pipe containing white crystal residue (Tested positive for Meth)
-1 Clear plastic baggie containing 2.03grams of white crystal substance (tested positive for Meth)

At this time, I took no further action in this case.

On September 26, 2022, at approximately 1630hrs, while working an off-duty detail at BrandsMart located at Sawgrass Mills Mall, 12801 W Sunrise Blvd, I was contacted by BrandsMart Loss Prevention Officer (IO) Mia Michelle Johnson. Johnson advised the following: She was notified by an employee that a juvenile patron saw an unknown male masturbating inside the one of the mall's nearby men's restrooms. Johnson then made contact with the juvenile, (WI) [redacted] advised that while he was using the men's public restroom inside of the mall, he saw a male masturbating. [redacted] then saw the male leave the bathroom and go inside BrandsMart. [redacted] pointed out the individual to Johnson and she was able to locate him; however, once he saw they were attempting to make contact with him, he fled on foot and she lost visual. Nothing further.

I then made contact with [redacted] advised while using the men's restroom inside of the mall he saw a white male kneeling masturbating in the stall next to him. The male realized [redacted] saw him and quickly exited the restroom. While [redacted] was attempting to locate security, he saw the male walk inside Brandsmart. [redacted] then advised a Brandsmart employee of what he saw and requested for him to contact security.

While answering my investigative questions, [redacted] quickly stopped providing a statement and pointed out a tall, white male and advised that he was the subject openly masturbating in the restroom. The suspect, who was later identified as Kevin Michael Halvorsen, was at a short distance away. When Halvorsen saw [redacted] he began walking at a fast pace toward Target. Halvorson then looked back, directly at me, and began running out of the mall entrance near Target.

While in full uniform with police insignias, I gave loud verbal commands for Halvorson to stop running, which he ignored and continued to flee. A short foot pursuit ensued from the incident location. I was able to catch up to Halvorson, while continuously giving him commands to stop and comply, which he yelled "No!". I managed to grab Halvorson by the arm at which point he began to pull, brace, tense his arms, and yelled for me to let him go. Officer D. Williams arrived a short while later to provide assistance. Officer Williams took Halvorson down to the ground as we continued our attempts to detain him. Shortly after, Halvorson was subsequently detained and placed under arrest. While conducting a search of Halvorson's person, drugs and paraphernalia were found in his pants pockets (Refer to Officer Williams supplement for further).

I remained on scene to assist Officer Malave, who assumed the investigation as primary. I did not take any further action.
