Jaheim, I noticed that he was not fully sedated as he somewhat awoke and started mumbling. I noticed Jaheim
removed his spit mask when the Woodmont Staff was attempting to remove his clothing and place him in a
hospital gown. As I reentered the room, I could see that Jaheim was coming more alert and was giving
Woodmont Staff issues with changing his clothes.
Jaheim was placed sitting in a chair, and I put the spit mask back over his face to prevent him from spitting o
us again. While telling him not to remove it, Jaheim immediately tried pulling the spit mask off of him and
ignored my command to keep it on. As I pulled the spit mask back down, Jaheim swatted at my hands and
started resisting Officers again. I grabbed both of Jaheim's hands in an attempt to control him, while telling him
to calm down. As the Woodmont Staff started taking off Jaheim's pants, he started twisting his body in an
attempt to break my control of his hands and started kicking at the Woodmont Staff with his feet. Jaheim again
attempted to take his spit mask off and was warned by me that if he didn't stop his aggressive actions, he would
be punched; I was attempting to verbally deescalate Jaheim's aggressive behavior towards us. Jaheim ignored
my verbal commands for him to stop and kept kicking, at which time I delivered several closed fist punches
using my right hand to the side of his face to stop his active resistance towards us.
As I attempted to cuff Jaheim's hands again to control them better, he again attempted to pull his face mask
off. Jaheim ignored my verbal commands to stop and as I reached to pull the mask down, I could feel Jaheim's
teeth scraping the top of my right hand as if he was attempting to grab onto my skin and bite me. I told Jaheim
stop but he ignored my verbal commands, at which time I again delivered several closed fist punches using my
right hand to the side of his face to stop Jaheim from biting me. Jaheim again was given several commands by
me to stop but he ignored them, at which time I again punched the side of his face using closed fist from both
my right and left hand. Once Jaheim was somewhat complaint, he was moved from the chair to the floor.
While on the floor, Jaheim again resisted my verbal commands to comply with my orders. Jaheim physically
resisted my attempts to roll his hands to his back and cuff them. I was able to overpower Jaheim and roll his
hands to his back and cuff him. I maintained control of Jaheim by holding him as he was acting erratic and
violent towards us and the Woodmont Staff. While holding him, I felt Jaheim grab for my groin area at which
time I told him to stop and when he refused, I delivered several closed fist punches using my left hand to the side of his face. Jaheim was eventually sedated again and secured to a medical bed.

On 11/15/2022, I observed a Silver Honda Civic (FL Tag 25AYBS) traveling northbound on Flamingo Road at a high rate of speed, a speed greater than that of the current flow of traffic. As a result, the vehicle made a number of quick lane changes. These lane changes were done in an abrupt manner with little room between vehicles and without the use of the silver vehicle's directional signal. I pulled my marked patrol unit behind the vehicle, which was now traveling in the inside lane, heading eastbound on W. Oakland Park Blvd. While behind the vehicle I observed the vehicle jerk abruptly from one side of the lane to the other. This movement caused the tires of the vehicle, which was later determined to be driven by (OF) Jaheim Reuben (3/11/2005), to travel on or over the marked lane line four different times.

After observing the described infractions, I activated my vehicle's overhead lights and conducted a traffic stop at the 10800 block of W. Oakland Park Blvd. Reuben immediately stopped his vehicle in the far inside lane of traffic, still in the flow of traffic. As I exited my vehicle, Reuben began to climb out of the open driver-side window. When his body was out up to his waist he looked at me and stated, "Why are your lights on?" He then slid back into his vehicle and fled eastbound on W. Oakland Park Blvd.

I advised over the radio that the vehicle had fled from the stop. I then reentered my marked patrol vehicle, began eastbound, while keeping visual on the vehicle. I continued to give updates as to the location of Reuben's vehicle until it was stopped in traffic at the 8200 block of W Oakland Park Blvd. I again activated my overhead lights and initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle at which time I advised over the radio that I had the subject stopped. I exited my vehicle and gave loud verbal commands for the driver to put the vehicle in park. Reuben, who again slid his body outside the driver's window looked directly at me and stated, "Don't make me pull my gun out, bro!" He repeated this statement a second time before saying, "Don't get me mad, bro!" The defendant's attention then briefly turned to my backup officer, Ofc.

Reuben's statements, coupled with the action of concealing his left hand in the vehicle and refusing to show it despite numerous verbal commands to do so, caused me to fear that there was a likelihood that Reuben was armed with a firearm and intended to use it on me. After another few verbal exchanges between Reuben and he again slid back into his vehicle and sped off eastbound on W. Oakland Park Blvd.

An NCIC/ FCIC search was conducted and it was determined that the registered owner of the vehicle, Shernet Waugh lived at 2750 NW 56th Ave Apt 301 in the City of Lauderhill. This information was BOLO out to Sunrise and Lauderhill officers. Moments later the vehicle was observed still traveling eastbound at the 6800 Block of W. Oakland Park Blvd. Sunrise K-9 unit M White followed Reuben's vehicle until he lost sight of it at the 2700 block of NW 56th Ave. Responding units then conducted a canvass of the parking lots surrounding the building where the registered owner was believed to live. The vehicle was quickly located. The vehicle was backed into a parking spot

on the northeast side of the complex. After a search of the area was completed, Lauderhill officers attempted to make contact with the vehicle's owner at the listed address. Lauderhill officers made contact with Waugh and Reuben. Based on the description tfrom the BOLO, Reuben was detained. I quickly responded to the residence where I visually confirmed that the detained subject (Reuben) was the same subject that I initially stopped, who threatened to pull out a firearm while I conducted my lawful traffic stop, and who fled from me.

I then took Reuben into custody and transported him to Woodmont Hospital for medical clearance. While enroute to Woodmont Hospital Reuben continued to make random statements which did not make sense. Statements included, "You can't see the light, but I can and that is what is wrong with you.", he would also yell as loud as possible for no apparent reason. Once we arrived at Woodmont, Reuben was escorted into the building and toward the triage area. While being walked through the emergency room Reuben made a threatening statement when he looked at me and said, "It's okay because you are going to die!" Reuben then began to brace and tense while stating that he did not want to walk. Suddenly, without warning or provocation, Reuben reared up with his right leg and kicked (VI) nurse who was standing off to the side of the hallway. Reuben's kick struck in the left arm and stomach.
As soon as the battery of took place, Ofc. and I guided Reuben to the ground to assert control before moving him to a secure holding area. While moving Reuben to the holding area, which was located within the secured facility of Woodmont Hospital, Reuben again threatened the lives of officers when he stating, "Once this door opens I will shoot you!" Reuben was then placed inside a room within the hospital's secure facility. Ofc. maintained a visual observation of Reuben from inside the facility while I made contact with stated she did want to press charges in this case. I then returned to my vehicle to complete the Probable Cause Affidavit.
While Ofc. maintained a visual, Reuben walked to the unlocked door of the small room he was placed in to and pushed it open. Ofc. instructed Reuben to move back and sit down. Reuben began to verbally badger Ofc. before stepping up to him and intentionally striking / headbutting Ofc. in the face with his forehead. Ofc. then guided Reuben back into the room. Upon being forced back into the room and being made to sit down, Rueben intentionally spat on the face and uniform of Ofc. The actions of Rueben forced Ofc. request a spit hood and additional officers to assist with handling Rueben. (See Ofc. supplement for additional details).
Upon hearing the request of Ofc. Ofc. responded to assist and provide a spit mask and leg restraints. With Ofc. present I again returned to my vehicle to complete all required paperwork. During this time Rueben appeared to have gone to sleep as a result of sedation which was administered by hospital staff. However, when Ofc. removed the restraints from Rueben he stood up and took an aggressive posture. To regain control of Reuben and reapply handcuffs and leg restraints, Ofc. pushed Rueben into a seated position and held him while Ofc. secured his legs. While Ofc. worked to gain and then maintain control of Rueben, Rueben knowingly and intentionally bit Ofc. on the hand, which possibly resulted in a fracture to Ofc s right hand. (See Ofc. supplement for additional details)
Reuben was given additional sedation by hospital staff and secured to a bed with leg and arm restraints. At this point, it was determined by hospital staff that for the safety and medical treatment of Rueben that he should be admitted under a law and law instructed by hospital staff to complete a admission form. I also completed a return to law enforcement custody form and provided staff with instructions for contacting Sunrise PD prior to Reuben's discharge.

It should be noted that at no time did I question Reuben and he made no statements regarding his actions.

After leaving the hospital I made contact with Reuben's mother, Shernet Waugh, and updated her as to the nature of the charges and Rueben's medical status. She stated she understood and would await contact from the Juvenile Assessment Center.

Lastly, I placed a copy of my Probable Cause Affidavit charging Jaheim Reuben (3/11/2005) with Aggravated Assault on a Police Officer, Battery on Officer Firefighter EMT etc. (4 Counts), Corruption by Threat, Flee/Elude Police, Careless Driving (AH93F5E), and Failure to maintain lane (AH93F6E) in Sunrise Records, copies of the traffic citations where attached. Then all body-worn camera footage was uploaded to the Axon server.

No further action was taken in this case at this time.

Jaheim remained on the floor in handcuffs and shackles until Woodmont Staff would be able to administer a sedative to calm his erratic behavior. Eventually the Staff administered the sedative and after some time, Jaheim started to calm down. Once the Woodmont Staff advised Jaheim appeared sedated, they advised for us to remove the handcuffs and shackles. A second sedative was to be given to Jaheim, but the Woodmont Staff advised they would not be administering it; claiming Jaheim was sedated enough. As we started to remove the restraint devices from Jaheim, I noticed that he was not fully sedated as he somewhat awoke and started mumbling. I noticed Jaheim removed his spit mask when the Woodmont Staff was attempting to remove his clothing and place him in a hospital gown. As I reentered the room, I could see that Jaheim was coming more alert and was giving Woodmont Staff issues with changing his clothes. Jaheim was placed sitting in a chair, and I put the spit mask back over his face to prevent him from spitting on us again. While telling him not to remove it, Jaheim immediately tried pulling the spit mask off of him and ignored my command to keep it on. As I pulled the spit mask back down, Jaheim swatted at my hands and started resisting Officers again. I grabbed both of Jaheim's hands in an attempt to control him, while telling him to calm down. As the Woodmont Staff started taking off Jaheim's pants, he started twisting his body in an attempt to break my control of his hands and started kicking at the Woodmont Staff with his feet. Jaheim again attempted to take his spit mask off and was warned by me that if he didn't stop his aggressive actions, he would be punched; I was attempting to verbally deescalate Jaheim's aggressive behavior towards us. Jaheim ignored my verbal commands for him to stop and kept kicking, at which time I delivered several closed fist punches using my right hand to the side of his face to stop his active resistance towards us.

As I attempted to cuff Jaheim's hands again to control them better, he again attempted to pull his face mask off. Jaheim ignored my verbal commands to stop and as I reached to pull the mask down, I could feel Jaheim's teeth scraping the top of my right hand as if he was attempting to grab onto my skin and bite me. I told Jaheim to stop but he ignored my verbal commands, at which time I again delivered several closed fist punches using my right hand to the side of his face to stop Jaheim from biting me. Jaheim again was given several commands by me to stop but he ignored them, at which time I again punched the side of his face using closed fist from both my right and left hand. Once Jaheim was somewhat complaint, he was moved from the chair to the floor.

While on the floor, Jaheim again resisted my verbal commands to comply with my orders. Jaheim physically resisted my attempts to roll his hands to his back and cuff them. I was able to overpower Jaheim and roll his hands to his back and cuff him. I maintained control of Jaheim by holding him as he was acting erratic and violent towards us and the Woodmont Staff. While holding him, I felt Jaheim grab for my groin area at which time I told him to stop and when he refused, I delivered several closed fist punches using my left hand to the side of his face. Jaheim was eventually sedated again and secured to a medical bed.

After the strike, Jaheim calmed down and the Woodmont Staff was able to administer a second sedative. Once the second sedative was delivered and Jaheim calmed down even, he was transferred to a medical bed and secured by Woodmont Staff.

After securing Jaheim, I sought medical treatment for an injury sustained from the physical altercation with him.

A Response to Resistance Report was completed by mc for this incident.
