<p>Officers were dispatched to 2650 NW 64th Avenue in reference to a domestic disturbance. The victim relayed via text to dispatch that her ex-boyfriend who she has a restraining order against was at her home and threatening her and her children. Upon arrival to the residence, the subject was observed leaving the parking lot area. Ofc. Parks attempted to make contact with the subject just east of the residence and the subject ran southbound into a residential complex.</p> <p>The subject was able to evade officers and a perimeter was established. Upon canvassing the area, I located the subject at the canal bank just east of 5951 NW 25th Street. As I approached the subject, he began to walk away from me (northbound). Ofc. T. Parks intersected him and he just stood between myself and Ofc. Parks. Multiple commands were given for the subject to "get on the ground" but he ignored our commands. It should be noted that Ofc. Parks and I were in full police uniform with badge, gun and agency patch. As Ofc. Parks and I moved closer to the subject, he placed his right hand in his waistband. Due to the subject's actions, I deployed my department issued Taser 7 (SN: X400HMY2). Subject was subsequently placed in handcuffs and he received medical treatment from Rescue 39 and FMC staff (medically cleared for jail).</p>

On 12/12/22, I was dispatched to the listed address in reference to a domestic dispute.

[REDACTED] (VI) stated that Tristan Coakley (OF) was asked to leave the residence several times, which he refused. Once [REDACTED] noticed Coakley was not going to leave, she called law enforcement. As officers arrived, they observed Coakley running eastbound from the apartment complex's parking lot toward NW 60th Av.

Officers were able to locate Coakley at the rear of the housing development located at the 2500 block of NW 60th av, and he was given lawful commands to stop. It should be noted that Officers were in Sunrise PD uniform with insignia clearly displayed. Coakley disobeyed the commands and fled from officers southbound on NW 60th between residences. Officers were able to locate Coakley to the rear of the apartments located at the 2400 block of NW 60th Av, along the canal bank. Coakley was given commands to get on the ground before reaching toward his waistband, resulting in Coakley being tasered. See Ofc Martin's supplement for further information.

A routine database check of Coakley revealed that he has two active injunctions non-expiring against him, which were served (07/08/22, 08/25/22), with the protected person being [REDACTED]. Let it be known [REDACTED] is the [REDACTED] of Coakley [REDACTED]. Coakley was arrested on 07/07/2022 for "VIOL INJUNCTION PROTECTION DOM" and again on 08/24/2022 for "VIOL INJUNCTION PROTECTION DOM" (see Sunrise PD cases: 42-2207-028647 and 42-2208-036916). The injunctions were confirmed as active by Sunrise Police Teletype.

Coakley was read his Miranda Rights, which he invoked. Coakley was transported to Florida Medical Center for medical attention. The taser prongs were removed by Florida Medical Center staff. Coakley is charged with aggravated stalking, resisting without violence, and violation of an active injunction. Coakley was subsequently transported to BSO Main Jail for further processing.

## BWC Worn

I responded to 2650 NW 64th Avenue in reference to a domestic disturbance. The caller [REDACTED] texted dispatch that her [REDACTED] was at the home threatening to harm her and the child. Upon arrival, I observed a male who is known to me as Tristan Coakley walking east from the south exit of the complex (within 500 ft of the victim). I made contact with [REDACTED] who advised that "it's Tristan again" and pointed to him as he left the complex. It should be noted that I have previous knowledge of [REDACTED] having a non-expiring restraining order against Tristan. Ofc. Parks attempted to make contact with Tristan, but Tristan ran southbound and fled through the residential complex. I also have prior knowledge that Tristan was wanted for a business burglary in our city (Alert flyer read via department email). A perimeter was established and officers canvassed the area.

While canvassing the canal bank east of 5951 NW 25th Street, I located Tristan sitting on the canal bank. Before making contact, I instructed back-up officers to go one street north in case Tristan attempted to flee again. Once officers were set up on the north, I approached Tristan from the south. Tristan looked at me, stood up and started to move north. It should be noted that I was in full police uniform with gun, badge and agency patches. As Tristan attempted to flee north, he was intercepted by Ofc. Parks who was approaching from the north side. Tristan disregarded several commands to "get down on the ground". Tristan then reached into his waistband with his right hand while we approached him. Due to Tristan's active resistance (fleeing from officers) and overt movement with his right hand (reaching into waistband), I deployed my department issued Taser 7 (SN: X400HMY2). The Taser was effective and Tristan was placed in handcuffs. Tristan suffered puncture wounds from the Taser prongs. Rescue 39 responded and treated Tristan on scene and transported him to Florida Medical Center for medical clearance. Ofc. M. Ryan took this call as primary (see original report for further details).

Photographs of the injury were taken and placed into Evidence.com. Ofc. M. Ryan placed the Taser prongs into evidence. I placed the used Taser cartridge into Evidence locker 13. CEM and RRR reports completed and enclosed with this report.
