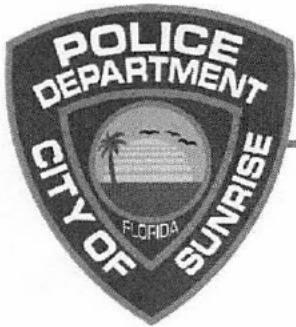


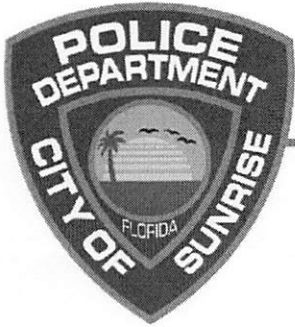

<p>On the above mentioned date and time, I responded to a battery call at La Quinta. The investigation resulted in the subject of the use of force not wanting to press charges in her battery case. She also refused rescue for an injury she sustained in during the altercation with her friend.</p>			
<p>Hotel manager Rafael Grullon also made the decision to trespass the subject from the property as she was not a registered hotel guest. Grullon explained to her that she had to leave which I reiterated several times. I attempted to explain to the subject that she needed to collect her belongings and leave the property. She refused several times to get up after being told she was trespassed. I then told her that she was under arrest and began to move in to physically detain her.</p>			
<p>In response, the subject stood up in an aggressive manner and said, "don't put your hands on me." Officers began to physically take the subject into custody when she threw a right uppercut connecting with my lower half of my face. The subject then began to brace and tense her arms in an effort to prevent being handcuffed. During the struggle and in an effort to break down the subject's resistance, I threw two quick left handed</p>

strikes. Both of the strikes were intended to strike the subjects upper right arm. The first strike glanced off the subjects upper right shoulder. I am unsure where the second strike landed and the bwc footage doesn't clarify as the subjects hair was covering the area of contact. It should be noted that while this is occurring, the subject is still tensing her right hand.

On 01/01/2023, Officers` responded to 13651 NW 2nd St, Sunrise, FL, 33325 (La Quinta Hotel) in reference to a delayed battery investigation. Upon arrival contact was made with the Roselise Gracia (OF) who advised she got into a physical altercation with an unknown male. Roselise alleged that a male by the name of Jerry Blaise struck her in the face multiple times and grabbed her by the throat. She was unable to provide a date of birth for Jerry. Rosalise described Jerry as a middle-aged black male with tattoos all over his body with a medium build and approximately six feet tall. Rosalie had a laceration on her lip as a result of the altercation. She denied treatment from Sunrise Fire Rescue multiple times.

Further Investigation revealed that Rosalise was not a registered guest at the hotel, at which point the on-duty manager, Rafael Grullon (IO) asked her to leave the property. Rosalise immediately became defensive and refused. [REDACTED] who was in a full police uniform with insignia then explained to Rosalise that she was being trespassed and needed to leave the property immediately. [REDACTED] then once again told Rosalise she needed to leave the property and explained that she would be subject to arrest if she failed to comply. Rosalise then proceeded to blatantly ignore [REDACTED] lawful order and made no attempt to move or exit the property.

At this point, [REDACTED] attempted to place Rosalise in handcuffs. During this process, Rosalise intentionally struck [REDACTED] with a closed fist on the lower portion of his chin (refer to Detective [REDACTED] supplement for further). Rosalise then knowingly and willfully resisted Officers from placing her in handcuffs by bracing, tensing and pulling her arms away. Once Officers sucessfully detained Rosalise, she continued to resist by purposefully dropping her body weight onto the floor, making it difficult for Officers to escort her to the patrol car. Rosalise was later taken to Broward General Medical Center for medical clearance, in which the doctor informed Rosalise that she had a fractured nose. Rosalise stated she did not wish to press charges for the battery. It should be noted that [REDACTED] did not sustain any visible injury as a result of being struck.

Based on the totality of the circumstances and Rosalise`s actions there was sufficient probable cause to charge her with the above listed offenses. Subsequently, she was taken to BSO Main Jail for processing.

On January 1, 2023, I responded to a battery call at La Quinta. Officer Pincus and I made contact with Roselise Gracia in room 315. Roselise declined to press charges against the other involved party and also declined rescue.

I accompanied hotel manager Rafael Grullon upstairs when he went to look at the status of the room. Rafael stated that he wanted her out. I explained to Rafael that he had to be the one to trespass her and that we would assist in getting her out.

Rafael explained to her that she had to leave which I reiterated several times. I attempted to explain to Roselise that she needed to collect her belongings and leave the property. Roselise refused to get up after being told she was trespassed. I warned her that if she did not leave property she would be placed under arrest. I counted to three like she was a child and then told Roselise that she was under arrest and began to move in to physically detain her.

In response, Roselise stood up in an aggressive manner and said, "don't put your hands on me." I attempted to grab Roselise's right hand which she pulled away and balled into a fist. At the same time, she balled her left hand into a fist. Officers Cubides was able to grab her left hand, however, her right hand remained unsecured allowing her to throw a right uppercut connecting with my lower half of my face (00:55:38 seconds of my BWC video). Roselise then began to brace and tense her arms in an effort to prevent being handcuffed. During the struggle and in an effort to break down the subject's resistance, I threw two quick left handed strikes. Both of the strikes were intended to strike the subjects upper right arm. The first strike glanced off Roselise's upper right shoulder. I am unsure where the second strike landed and the bwc footage doesn't clarify as Roselise's hair was covering the area of contact.

After the second strike and in an effort to prevent her from moving while officers secured her in handcuffs, I left my forearm laying across Roselise's right collar bone while the backside of my left wrist pressed against her right cheek. During this time, Roselise swung her head in my direction and began to yell at me. I then readjusted my left forearm against the right side of Roselise's face pushing her head away from me. This was done for two reasons: to help maintain control of her while handcuffs were being applied and to prevent her from inadvertently spitting blood in my face while she was yelling. I maintained this contact with very minimal pressure until Officer Cubides was able to secure Roselise's left arm. It should also be noted that during this time my right hand was maintaining control of Roselise's right hand which was still tensing up in an effort to prevent handcuffs from being applied. Officer Cubides continued to tell her to "stop fighting." After Officer Cubides secured her left arm, I removed my left arm off her head and we leaned her forward allowing for the handcuffs to be applied.

After Roselise was handcuffed, she decided to sit down on the ground preventing officers from easily escorting her to the patrol vehicle.
