<p>I responded as a backup officer to Officer Jossfolk's traffic stop in which the driver bailed out and I assisted in clearing the vehicle. After clearing the Blue in color BMW which was involved in the incident, I observed a black male wearing a black hoodie and red pants, which matched the suspect BOLO, running from the front of the Chevron located at the 5600 block of W Sunrise Blvd. I asked dispatch to repeat the description of the male which matched the description of the male in front of me. The male immediately began running West on W Sunrise Blvd and I immediately gave him verbal commands to stop running. I then presented my taser and gave the male commands to stop in which he ran North toward a plaza which was at 5701 W Sunrise Blvd. I deployed my taser the first time which was ineffective and the second time the taser probes appeared to attach to the males thick hoodie which failed to make full contact as he attempted to jump the fence. The male was subsequently detained on the other side of the fence by back-up officers.</p> <p>No injuries were obtained by the male suspect during this incident or the taser deployment.</p>

On 02/04/2023, at approximately 1516 hours, I was conducting routine patrol at 1400 Sunset Strip which is located in the City of Sunrise, County of Broward, State of Florida when I observed a Blue BMW X4 M40I (bearing FL Tag# 43BCWN) driving with a front windshield tint exceeding the AS1 line as well as driving in the bike path.

Upon initiating the traffic stop in my Sunrise Police marked vehicle with Sunrise Insignia attached, I activated my LED overhead lights. Once I activated my overhead lights, the vehicle began to accelerate and make the first U-turn at NW 15th Ct and Sunset Strip. As the vehicle made the U-turn, I activated my patrol vehicle sirens in addition to my overhead lights to notify the driver I was initiating a traffic stop. While my lights and sirens were activated, the vehicle began to accelerate even more while deliberately and willfully failing to stop and disobeying any and all orders to comply with the traffic stop. As the vehicle continued to flee and elude and accelerate through traffic at a high rate of speed, I terminated my traffic stop but I was still able to observe the vehicle from a distance. I observed the vehicle turn eastbound onto W Sunrise Blvd as I continued to drive in a routine manner in the same direction of travel. As I approached the traffic light at W Sunrise Blvd and Sunset Strip, I had my driver-side window lowered and heard a vehicle skidding down the street and a loud bang, which are all sounds consistent with a vehicle crash. After I heard what seemed to be a vehicle crash, I drove eastbound on W Sunrise Blvd to investigate. I then observed at the intersection of NW 56th Ave and W Sunrise Blvd the same Blue BMW X4 stopped in the middle of the intersection.

I then initiated another traffic stop on the vehicle. As I approached the vehicle, I observed heavy damage to the front right bumper and along the right side of the vehicle. The vehicle has extremely dark window tints and I was unable to verify if any occupants of the vehicle remained. I then realized the vehicle was unoccupied due to a patron sitting on the guardrail along the sidewalk directly next to the vehicle who stated the driver exited the vehicle and fled northbound on NW 56th Av. At this point, a perimeter was established. As I was running northbound to locate the subject, three additional patrons stated they saw a black male wearing a black hoodie and red pants running past them. Finally, a fourth additional patron driving on NW 56th Av advised officers a subject matching the same description ran westbound back toward where the unoccupied vehicle was located.

While Ofc. Larin was standing by with the vehicle, she observed the subject matching the provided description and later identified as, JORDAN YLTEUS (Defendant), run out from in front of the Chevron gas station located at 5601 W Sunrise Blvd and attempt to get into a White Mercedes to flee. Once Ylteus noticed Ofc. Larin approaching him, he ran back northbound while disobeying all of her verbal commands and refused to stop. Ylteus then ran behind the business "Life Storage" located at 5605 W Sunrise Blvd through an alleyway while continuing to disobey officers' commands and orders. While Ofc. Larin was in foot pursuit of the Ylteus, she deployed her taser two times making no positive connection with him. Det. Douglas came around the business from the south end and at which point he was able to apprehend and detained Ylteus. (See ofc. Larin's Supp)

A routine database check of Ylteus revealed he is on Felony Probation for Flee/LEO with NO Regard (Case# K41673). The defendant's special conditions are no driving and license revoked. A DAVID check of Ylteus

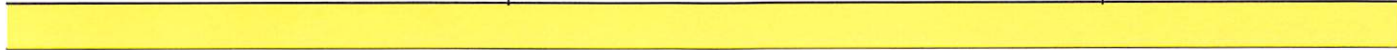

revealed his license to be revoked since 09/21/2022.

I read Ylteus his Miranda Warning via pretext card which he did not invoke. I asked Ylteus why he did not stop which he stated "Why did you light me up". I also asked Ylteus why he ran if I stopped and terminated my traffic stop which he responded "Some lady pointed at me".

Ylteus was subsequently charged with Fleeing and Eluding/ Fail to obey LEO order to stop, Felony Violation of Probation, Resisting officer without violence, Driving while license suspended or revoked with knowledge, driving upon a sidewalk or bicycle path, and driving with a front windshield tint exceeding the AS1 line.

The vehicle the Ylteus was driving was a rental and the registered owner was (IO) Adrienne Hills. Hills was notified of the incident and advised her vehicle had been in an accident. Hills advised officers that she rented the vehicle to a subject (IO) Cedrick Beauzil. I attempted to make contact with Beauzil via landline but he hung up the phone as soon as I announced I was a police officer. No further contact was made with Beauzil.

The vehicle was towed by Westway towing with no hold.

Ylteus was later processed and transported to BSO main jail.

A follow-up investigation was conducted at the Chevron to review CCTV footage of the incident and if it was captured. Officers met with the manager (IO) Lilia Segura. The CCTV footage revealed at 1520 hours on cameras 4,12, and 14, Ylteus as only subject running from the exact location where the vehicle was crashed and left unoccupied, northbound cutting across the Chevron parking lot. Ylteus was wearing the exact same clothing (Black hoodie and red pants) as described by multiple patrons who witnessed the incident. The footage was captured on Ofc. Deleon and I BWC because the system needed a USB drive in order to download the footage and none were available at the time.

Another follow-up at Chevron may be conducted to gather further information if need be. Supplemental reports will be submitted accordingly.

I responded as a back-up officer to the location of 5600 W Sunrise Blvd for a traffic stop where the driver of the vehicle bailed out and fled on foot. I arrived to the location and observed officers on foot canvassing the area. A BOLO was given for a black male wearing a black hoodie and red pants. I returned to the vehicle and conducted a search of the vehicle to ensure no other person was inside. After clearing the vehicle, I observed a black male matching the description given across the street from my location at the Chevron gas station located at 5605 W Sunrise Blvd. The male was seen initially trying to hide behind the bus stop and then ran onto W Sunrise Blvd in the middle of the road attempting to get into a Gray Mercedes sedan. I immediately engaged into a foot pursuit after the subject attempting to stop and detain him. I presented my taser and gave the subject loud verbal commands to stop and he began running North into a plaza which was located at 5701 W Sunrise Blvd.

The subject continued running refusing commands which I then deployed my taser, it was not effective due to the black hoodie the male was wearing. The male continued running toward a fence as I continued to give him commands, he began attempting to climb over the fence when I tased him again and taser probes did not make contact. The subject jumped over the fence and continued running north bound along the fence line, still giving the male verbal commands to stop running and continued refusing. He was detained shortly after by Detective Douglass.

The subject was taken into custody.

On 02/04/2023, I had completed a neighborhood canvas for an unrelated criminal case being investigated by the Sunrise Police Department. I began driving home at approximately 1510 hours because my canvas had concluded. While approaching the area of Sunset Strip and West Sunrise Blvd, I heard Officer Jossfolk advise over the police radio of a bailout from an attempted traffic stop at 5600 West Sunrise Blvd.

I heard various radio transmissions from officers and specifically heard the description of a black male wearing a black hoodie and red pants running behind the U-Haul storage building from the crashed vehicle involved in the attempted traffic stop. I was now at West Sunrise Blvd and NW 56th Avenue.

Being that I was in the immediate area, I drove my unmarked police car behind the storage facility in an attempt to assist officers with the apprehension of the suspect. Before I could even get out of my car to obtain my vest (with BWC attached), I saw the suspect run from behind a wall and make eye-contact with me. I immediately put my vehicle in park and engaged in a short foot pursuit with him. I lost visual of the subject for a brief moment since he had run back behind the wall I first saw him appear from.


I heard Officer Larin yell out that the subject had something in his hands. I unholstered my firearm and chased the suspect who I also visibly saw have an unknown item in his hand. After the brief foot chase, the subject complied with my commands and I safely took him into custody. No physical force was used in the apprehension of this subject. Officer Jossfolk and Brooks came up quickly behind me and we walked the subject to a marked police vehicle. Once the suspect was placed in the vehicle, I cleared the scene and continued to drive home since my shift had concluded.

It should be noted that I was in my department issued Criminal Investigations Section uniform which consists of a black polo short (badge and name stitched on the front of the shirt) and khaki pants. I had my badge, department issued firearm, extra ammo magazine, and handcuffs on my belt. I was also wearing my department issued cold-weather jacket (badge and name stitched on the front of the jacket) due to the temperature that day.

Due to my immediate involvement in this case, I did not have time to get out of my vehicle, go to my trunk, grab my vest, and then engage in the foot pursuit of this suspect. Due to this immediate action, no BWC footage is available on my behalf.

Sergeant White was notified about my involvement and the reason for not having my BWC on my person and activated for this incident.
