D. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES – February 9, 2023

E. OPEN DISCUSSION

The Public Observer informed the Board about an accident that involved a pedestrian that occurred at the intersection of University Drive and Oakland Park Blvd. The City Liaison documented the intersection and emphasized that one of the Board's purpose is to bring awareness of safety practices to drivers, pedestrians and bicyclists alike. The City Liaison informed the Board that complaints or recommendations regarding non-City ROW are forwarded to the appropriate agency (FDOT, Broward County, etc.). The City Liaison also informed the Board of a past project at the same intersection by FDOT & Broward County to improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety. The Board inquired about pedestrian access to the Atrium plaza along Oakland Park Blvd. The City Liaison will look into this and provide information at the next board meeting. The Board thanked the City Liaison and City Staff for quickly repairing an open utility box along SW 120th Way.
