Bike Bingo

The City Liaison provided the Board with the final version of the Bike Bingo activity prepared by the City's Marketing team and informed the Board that a dedicated webpage was created on the City's website to market the activity. The Board discussed the final version of the bike bingo activity card, website and how those that successfully completed the activity would be awarded. The Board decided that awards would be presented at the monthly Board meetings. Ms. Molina-Kelly motioned to approve Bike Bingo going live. Seconded by Mr. Mora. There was no further discussion. Omnibus Bill

The City Liaison informed the Board about the intent and status of the omnibus bill.

Event Representation

Atrium Way Bus Route Loop

The City Liaison noted that an update will be provided at the next board meeting related to the bus route loop. The Board inquired if the Sunrise Freebee (Free On-Demand Transportation) service will be expanded to other areas throughout the City. The City Liaison acknowledged that the City is investigating the potential to expand the service and will follow-up at next meeting on status.

Bicyclist/Pedestrian Access to City Parks

The City Liaison informed the Board that public access to all City parks are evaluated during plan review, as well as on a continuous basis and that their concerns have been forwarded to the appropriate City personnel to investigate and resolve their concerns. Once further information becomes available the City Liaison will update the Board.

G. NEW BUSINESS

Bicycle & Pedestrian, Greenways & Trails Master Plan Update

The City Liaison informed the Board that the City Commission approved the commencement of the update to the City's Bicycle & Pedestrian, Greenways & Trails Master Plan during the April 11, 2023 Commission meeting. Once further information becomes available the City Liaison will update the Board.

H. BOARD FORUM

The City Liaison provided a status update for various projects throughout the City. The Board inquired if the City has considered adding rumble strips on the exterior edge of the Bike Lane closest to traffic. The City Liaison noted potential concerns related to the rumble strips but will investigate and follow-up. The Board inquired if there were any updates regarding the way-finding signs. The City Liaison noted that now the Bike Bingo activity

launch is complete, the focus now will shift back to the way-finding signs and an update will be provided during the next Board Meeting.

Having no more items to discuss, the Board confirmed the next meeting would be held on Thursday, June 8, 2023 at 6:30 PM.
