<p>At 2125 hrs on 3/8/23 units responded to 3000 NW 60 Ave in reference to a report of a heavysset black male who was possibly intoxicated, causing a disturbance in front of the convenience store at this location. The initial caller advised that the subject pulled out a gun and knife and was waving it at people and threatening people in front of the store. The caller additionally advised that the disturbance had been going on for an hour. The caller advised that they were no longer on scene but provided a full description of the subject.</p>			
<p>Prior to arriving on scene, contact was attempted with the caller however the phone was "busy" and contact could not be established. The first two arriving units staged at 2600 NW 60 Ave, awaiting the response of myself and one additional unit. While I was still enroute, another call was received that stated the subject still had a weapon in his hand, and another caller stated that the subject was still armed and was fighting in the parking lot.</p>			
<p>All units converged at this time and upon approach I observed the subject, later identified as Jeffrey Wright, standing face to face with another individual in a confrontational manner.</p>			








<p>While approaching both subjects I provided loud verbal commands for both of them to get on the ground, not knowing who the other subject was at the time, if he was also armed, or what his intentions were. This subject, later identified as an employee who was trying to deescalate Wright, immediately complied with commands, however Wright did not, and continued to stand while I continued to clearly yell verbal commands for him to get on the ground.</p>	
<p>Wright refused to comply with commands and I told him that if he did not, he would "be tased." The extent of the movement that Wright made was to casually place the drink that he was holding, on the ground. At this time, recognizing an opportunity to strike Wright while he was off balance / in a compromised position, I moved towards Wright and struck him with my right foot in the mid / upper part of his torso on his right side. This caused Wright to fall forward onto the ground. This technique was effective and although Wright continued to tense his arms afterwards, he was placed in custody.</p>	
<p>A loaded / chambered Glock handgun and a 3-4 inch folding knife were in Wright's possession.</p>	
<p>Wright made no complaint of injury at this time. After Wright was placed in handcuffs, he was escorted to the rear of a marked Sunrise Police patrol vehicle. After a secondary search prior to placing Wright in the vehicle, Wright tensed his body and shifted his weight backwards away from the vehicle in a resistant manner, while stating "I'm not going in the back of the car." Based on Wright's statement and his physical actions to not be placed in the patrol vehicle, it was necessary to forcefully push Wright into the back seat of the vehicle. Again, Wright made no complaint of injury, however I then immediately requested that Sunrise Fire/Rescue respond, due to his intoxicated / incoherent state.</p>	
<p>Wright was charged with 2 counts of resisting an officer without violence, disorderly intoxication and improper exhibition of dangerous weapons.</p>

On 3/8/2023, I responded to the listed address in reference to a disturbance with a weapon. The initial complainant stated that a male was observed with a weapon in hand in the parking lot of the listed address and fighting him. The initial complainant declined to provide BSO dispatch with his name and refused to answer his phone when dispatch attempted to make contact. Additional attempts were made to reach the initial callers or any citizens on scene who may have felt threatened by Wright with the knife, which met with negative results.

Initial contact upon arrival by responding back up officers was made with a male who was intoxicated and later identified as Jeffrey Wright (DOB 08/01/1996) at the front of the establishment. Wright was observed causing a disturbance and yelling at other patrons outside in the parking lot and appeared visibly intoxicated as he was sweating profusely and had the strong, obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his body. Due to his aggressive attitude caused by his intoxication, he disrupted the normal flow of business as witnessed by Daryl Robinson (DOB 12/23/1974) who is an employee at the listed address.

Wright's actions prevented the normal flow of patrons inside and out of the business. Wright arrived at the listed business and parked his dark blue in color Lexus sedan on the west side of the business. Robinson stated that Wright had a physical altercation with an unknown black male moments prior to police arrival. Robinson witnessed Wright display a knife multiple times while Wright remained outside of the business interrupting and causing fear to other patrons from entering the business.

Robinson further stated that Wright was in possession of a gun, due to the weapon being displayed on Wright's person when his shirt was caught on the handle of the gun. The unknown black male departed the area after the physical altercation and did not return to speak with police. Wright, then began arguing and yelling while intimidating other patrons who were afraid to walk towards his hostile direction. Responding officers, Sergeant Zinn, Officer Cubides, Officer Jones, B. and Officer Coello approached Wright and attempted to calm him down and commanded him to get on the ground which he refused.

Due to Wright's aggressive demeanor and his resistance from complying with police commands, Sergeant Zinn approached Wright with his agency issued weapon drawn in order to disarm him. Wright actively resisted by disobeying police commands, which caused Sergeant Zinn to expedite apprehending Wright by kicking him to subdue him. Wright was then taken to the ground and safely placed in handcuffs (See Supplement). Wright continued to resist police by pulling his arms away and tensing as Officers tried to control his arms. Wright continued to yell and further resist Officers by stating that he wasn't getting in the (Police) car when officers attempted to get him into a marked police vehicle.

I spoke with Muhi Staih (RP), owner of the listed business and he stated that the altercation that took place prior to police arrival was captured via CCTV. Muhi was provided with an Evidence.com link to upload the video of the incident. Muhi stated that Wright was visibly upset upon his arrival at the listed address and immediately began taunting the unknown black male. As Wright taunted the unknown black male, Muhi stated that he is not aware of the reasons that caused the altercation to start. The altercation did not last long and that the other unknown male quickly departed the scene when he observed a weapon on Wright's person.

A black in color folding knife with an approximate 4" inch blade and a black in color Glock 19 was removed from Wright's waistband. It should be noted that the listed Glock was chambered with a round and the remaining ammunitions were loaded in the magazine and inserted in the hand gun. I arrived on scene and attempted to read Wright his Miranda rights multiple times and was unsuccessful. I trespassed Wright from the listed business as the business is a part of the Sunrise Police Trespass Program. The black handgun, 15 rounds of hollow point ammunition, the knife and a FL DL belonging to Wright's wife were entered into evidence by me. Wright was charged with Disorderly Intoxication, Resisting Officer without Violence to his person (2x) and Improper Exhibition of Dangerous Weapons. Sunrise Fire Rescue responded and transported Wright to FMC for medical clearance due to his injuries during the apprehension and he was subsequently transported to BSO Main Jail for processing.

Prior to arriving on scene, contact was attempted with the caller however the phone was "busy" and contact could not be established. Ofc's Coello and B Jones staged at 2600 NW 60 Ave while awaiting additional units arrival before making contact with the subject. While I was still enroute, another call was received that stated the subject still had a weapon in his hand, and another caller stated that the subject was still armed and was fighting in the parking lot. Despite initial attempts and follow-up attempts to make contact with any caller or potential victim, no contact could be made. After receiving this update, I instructed all responding units to proceed to the incident location.

Ofc Cubides and I approached the business from W Oakland Park Blvd, Ofc's Coello and Jones approached from NW 60 Ave, south of the business. Upon arriving in the parking lot, I observed an individual matching the description of the subject, later identified as Jeffrey Wright, standing face to face with another individual in a confrontational manner. I was the closest responding unit to both subjects upon arrival on scene, and immediately initiated verbal contact upon exiting my marked Sunrise Police vehicle.
