F. OLD BUSINESS

Event Representation

The City Liaison recognized that on June 3rd, 2023 there was a ribbon cutting and community bike ride event held in partnership with the FDOT, City of Sunrise and City of Weston in commemoration of the completion of the Weston Road Improvements Project. The Board Members acknowledged the event was well attended and recognized the Board as the project involved the addition of the bike lanes along the roadway.

Way-Finding Signs

The City Liaison informed the Board due to the move to the new City Hall location there is no update regarding the Way-Finding Signs at this time. Once further information becomes available the City Liaison will update the Board.

Atrium Way Bus Route Loop

The City Liaison is still looking if the City's Shuttle Service is offered at this location. The City Liaison informed the Board he also inquired with Broward County if there are any services offered at this location. Once further information becomes available the City Liaison will update the Board.

Bicycle & Pedestrian, Greenways & Trails Master Plan Update

The City Liaison reiterated the City Commission voted to progress with the update of the Master Plan. The Bid process is currently on-going. There will be community outreach meetings to gather feedback from the public. Once further information becomes available the City Liaison will update the Board.

G. NEW BUSINESS

Future Board Meeting Location

H. Board Forum

The Board expressed their concerns regarding the roadway along NW 94th Ave from NW 44th Street heading south. The City Liaison informed the Board roadway restoration is to begin immediately. The Board inquired if the 'Share The Roadway' signs along Oakland Park Blvd from NW 115th Terr to Nob Hill Rd were new. The City Liaison will provide an

update during the next Board Meeting. The Board inquired if they can purchase shirts or pins showing they are representing the Board. Once further information becomes available the City Liaison will update the Board. The Board inquired if there were any completed Bike Bingo cards submitted. The City Liaison informed the Board he received feedback that the Bike Bingo cards looked nice but did not receive any competed Bike Bingo cards. The Board inquired about the detectable warning mats that were installed at Nob Hill Rd. The City Liaison will look into this and provide further information when it becomes available. The Board inquired about the evaluation of traffic calming measures for both private and public projects. The City Liaison informed the Board it is brought up during the review process and is accounted for in design. The Board inquired if the City has any plans to repaint the green areas in the Bike Lanes. The City Liaison will coordinate with the Citys Public Works Department and will provide further information when it becomes available.

Having no more items to discuss, the Board confirmed the next meeting would be held on Thursday, July 13, 2023 at 6:30 PM.
