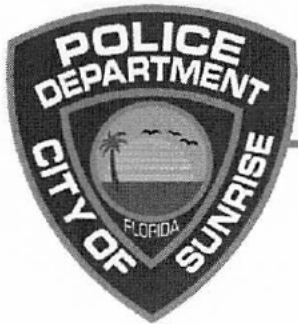




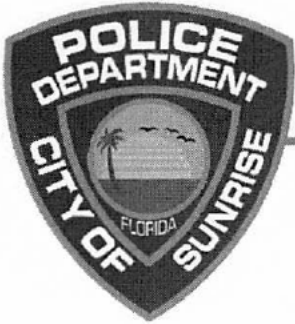

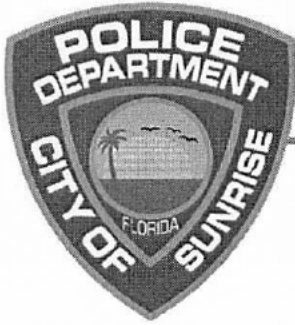

The subject threw punches and pull away from detectives as he resisted our lawful commands to stop resisting. Once the subject was brought to the ground, he refused to put his right hand behind his back. I deployed an elbow strike to the subjects back causing him to comply and place his hands behind his back.

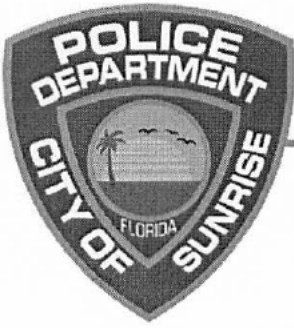

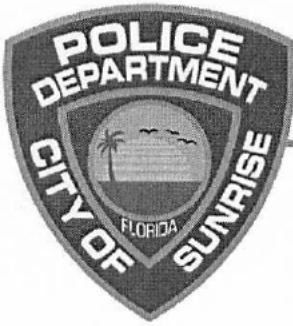

Narrative - continued

I entered the Dunkin Donuts lobby to detain an identified suspect in a vehicle burglary. The suspect was standing just a few feet inside the door when I entered. I was wearing my tactical body armor with police markings, clearly identifying me as a police officer. I immediately grabbed the suspect's left wrist in an attempt to physically detain him. The suspect pulled away and then physically swiped his arms toward me in an attempt to prevent his detainment. I then struck the suspect in the face and took him to the ground. The suspect continued to physically resist as I and other officers attempted to gain control of his arms to place him in handcuffs.

I was sitting on the suspects rear end preventing him from continuing to squirm and possibly kick as handcuffs were placed on him. Without warning, the suspect then turned his face up toward me and spit at me striking my face and mouth. I immediately struck the suspect in the face one time redirecting his face away from mine. The suspect was then lifted off the ground by backup officers and escorted off the premise without further incident.

On May 9, 2023, Sunrise Police Department received a call regarding a vehicle burglary which just occurred. A witness observed a black male (later identified as Dayne Luton 3/10/1994) wearing a blue tank top, gray shorts, and black/white sneakers enter a coworker's vehicle through its open window, then walk south toward Sunrise Blvd. The witness advised Luton was last seen entering the Dunkin Donuts at 6299 W Sunrise Blvd.

Sunrise Road Patrol officers responded to the incident location and observed a black Mercedes SUV with the windows down and the glove box open due to Luton rummaging through the interior. Officers made contact with the registered owner of the vehicle which stated she wished to press charges on the suspect for unlawfully entering her vehicle and stealing money from her cup holders.

While canvassing the area for Luton, Sunrise Strategic Investigation Sections (SIS) detectives observed Luton inside Dunkin Donuts. As detectives made contact with Luton, he quickly pulled away and took a fighting stance. It should be noted Det [REDACTED] was in uniform with his department issued vest with badge attached and other SIS detectives had badges visible in plain view. Luton continued to throw punches and pull away from detectives as he resisted our lawful commands and actions. Once Luton was brought to the ground and eventually placed in handcuffs, he turned and launched spit in Det. [REDACTED] face. The spittle hit Det. [REDACTED] on and in his mouth and chin region. Subsequently, Detectives were able to gain physical control of Luton.

When Luton was taken into custody he had the Mercedes Benz manual holder and approximately \$2.00 in loose change inside of it.

The witness was transported to the scene to conduct a show-up which yielded positive results.

Luton was then placed in a marked patrol vehicle with no further incident. Luton was read his Miranda Rights by Ofc. McCarthy which he stated he understood and wished to speak about the incident. See Ofc McCarthy's supplement reference Luton's statement.

Luton knowingly and willfully entered the victims open vehicle window to gain entry into the vehicle to deprive the victim of their property. Once unlawfully inside the vehicle, Luton stole the victims above mentioned property which had a total approximate value of \$5.00. Luton has at least two previous theft charges/convictions which makes this petit theft a 3rd or more offense. Luton knowingly and willfully resisted officers with violence and struck officers and spit on officers while resisting arrest.

Luton refused rescue due to no injuries sustained during the incident. Luton was transported to BSO main with no incident.

Det. Gindlesperger met with the victim and took a statement from her via BWC. The victim once again stated she

On May 9, 2023, Sunrise Police Department received a call regarding a vehicle burglary which just occurred. A witness observed a black male wearing a blue tank top, gray shorts, and black/white sneakers enter a coworker's vehicle through its open window, then walk south toward Sunrise Blvd. The witness advised the suspect was last seen entering the Dunkin Donuts at 6299 W Sunrise Blvd.

Sunrise Road Patrol officers responded to the incident location and observed a black Mercedes SUV with the windows down and the glove box open due to the suspect rummaging through the interior. Officers made contact with the registered owner of the vehicle which stated they wished to press charges on the suspect for unlawfully entering her vehicle and stealing money from her cup holders.

While canvassing the area for the suspect, Sunrise Strategic Investigation Sections (SIS) detectives observed the suspect inside Dunkin Donuts. As I approached to make contact with the suspected individual, he immediately and without hesitation, pulled away from my grasp and took a fighting stance. I with a closed fist struck the individual in his facial area. The subject continued to throw punches and pull away from detectives as he resisted our lawful commands to stop resisting. Once the subject was brought to the ground and eventually placed in handcuffs, I began removing a bag from the neck area of the subject. As the bag was being removed, the subject turned his head and launched spittle into my face (see BWC footage at approximately 08:44:30). The subject's spit made complete unwanted contact with my chin, cheek, and upper eye area. I immediately without hesitation with a closed fist struck the individual in his facial area successfully redirecting his head from continuously spitting on me.
