Upon arrival, units on scene overheard a loud bang consistent with the discharge of a firearm. Contact was made with a female occupant of the residence who exited and advised that the subject was barricaded inside of the master bedroom and had, in fact, discharged a firearm. A contact team was assembled and made entry to the residence. Contact was made with the subject in the master bedroom. Lawful commands were provided stating, "Come here. We want to help you." The subject responded, "shoot me now!". Commands were reiterated expressing that officers wished to help the subject. The subject refused lawful commands to exit the bedroom and submit to officers. The subject was positioned as such that the firearm could have been concealed and readily accessible. Due to the totality of the circumstances coupled with the fact that a firearm was present inside of the bedroom, I displayed my Taser 7, advised "Taser! Taser!", and discharged the device. The subject was struck with both Taser 7 prongs on the left side of his torso and was detained without further incident. Sunrise Fire Rescue 39 responded to treat and transport the subject.

BWC ACTIVATED

On 04/20/2023, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to suicidal threats being made and the apparent sound of a gunshot being fired within the residence. Upon arrival, we made contact with Lourdes Mendez (RP) who was in the residence and alleged having heard a gun shot fired in the suicidal subject's room. While Sunrise Officers were on scene, an additional gun shot was fired from the residence. Lourdes identified the shooter as [REDACTED] [REDACTED], who made suicidal remarks to [REDACTED] Gloria Pena. Gloria advised she recieved a text message from [REDACTED] at approximately 0443 where he stated in spanish, "I'm sorry I can't continue, I'm depressed and am leaving the accounting books to you."

Gloria elaborated [REDACTED] just filed for bankruptcy the week prior, and is an investor in the stock market where he routinely loses up to \$2000 a week. Sunrise Officers were unable to make contact with [REDACTED] as he barricaded himself within the northeast bedroom of the residence. Officers were able to make entry where [REDACTED] was detained subsequent to a taser deployment by Sgt Morlock (SEE SGT. MORLOCK'S SUPPLEMENT FOR FURTHER) and transported by Fire Rescue Engine 59. Two bullet holes were found on the southeast wall of the bedroom close to the floor.

It was evident [REDACTED] was going through a mental crisis due to monetary reasons. Without care or treatment, [REDACTED] is likely to cause harm to himself or others. It is not apparent that such harm may be avoided through the help of willing family members or the provision of other services. There is a substantial likelihood that without care or treatment, [REDACTED] will cause serious bodily harm to himself in the near future, as evidenced by his recent behavior.

It should be noted, Roberto Medina (IO), [REDACTED] took his firearm 3 days ago due to [REDACTED] advising he felt suicidal, however, returned the firearm to [REDACTED] possession the following day.

[REDACTED] was ultimately Baker Acted and transported to HCA Woodmont hospital to undergo mental evaluation and treatment.

Gloria signed a consent form to enter and search the residence. A black Taurus 40 Cal. firearm was recovered bearing SN: SZL54316. The firearm yielded negative results for being stolen and was submitted into evidence for safekeeping by Ofc. Bampoe-Addo. It should be noted Detective A. McMahon is currently in possession of the consent to enter and search form.

Due to the circumstances of the incident, a Risk Protection Order packet was submitted for review.

Under penalties of perjury, I declare that I have read the foregoing and that the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

A contact team was assembled and made entry to the residence. Contact was made with [Redacted] in the master bedroom. Lawful commands were provided stating, "Come here. We want to help you." [Redacted] responded, "Shoot me, now!" Commands were reiterated expressing that officers wished to help and did not anyone to be harmed. Due to the totality of the circumstances coupled with the fact that a firearm was present inside of the bedroom, I displayed my Taser 7, advised "Taser! Taser!", and discharged the device. [Redacted] was struck with both Taser 7 prongs on the left side of his torso and was detained without further incident. Sunrise Fire Rescue 39 responded to treat [Redacted] who was transported to Woodmont Hospital for further care and evaluation.
