Open Discussion: Updates/Announcements Regarding Schools

Dr. Stewart: Discovery Elementary – (a) DE is preparing the building for the return of students. (b) City of Sunrise Summer Camp is taking place at DE. (c) The school will begin screening incoming Kindergarten students on July 25 - 26.

City Events

Speaker - Armando Arana, BCPS Government Affairs Coordinator

Mr. Arana is the new Broward County Schools Government Affairs Coordinator. Mr. Arana introduced himself to the EAB and provided updates regarding Broward County Schools. Mr. Arana informed the EAB the new superintendent (Dr. Peter B. Licata) his official start date will be July 11, 2023.

Broward County Schools updates:

- 1. Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FASFA): Broward students performed better than neighboring districts (Miami-Dade and Palm Beach). In the English category, students scored 52% [Florida State average 50%; In the math category, students scored 57% (Florida State average 56%)].
- 2. School Choice Application (May 1 Sept 1): Status results are not provided over the phone. Mr. Arana encouraged parents to check their emails for a response or by the online portal.
- 3. Back to School Career Fair was held on July 2 from 8am 2pm. The event had about 1300 positions available and interviews held on the spot.
- 4. Impact Teen Drivers: Impact Teen Drivers is a leading traffic safety education drivers education course for students in high school. Broward Sheriff's Office is leading the program.
- 5. Mental Health Support Service information is accessible on the Broward County School District website.
- 6. The Smart Program Team has an opportunity to coordinate a future presentation for the Board to provide more information.
- 7. An email/memo was sent out to Broward County School Principals to update each schools website.

Carolyn Hudson explained that she was able to check the status of her volunteer application and received approval in 10 minutes and the process was very smooth.
